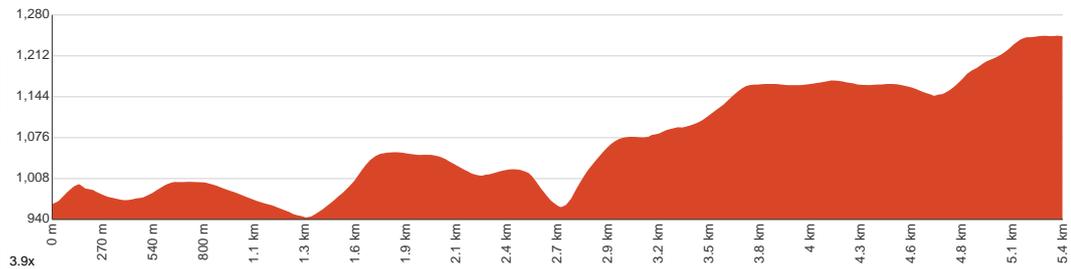
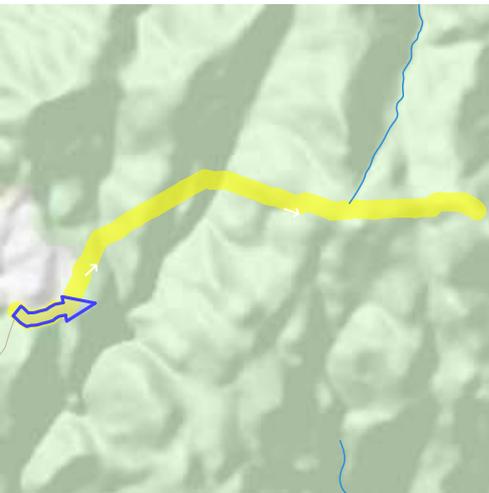

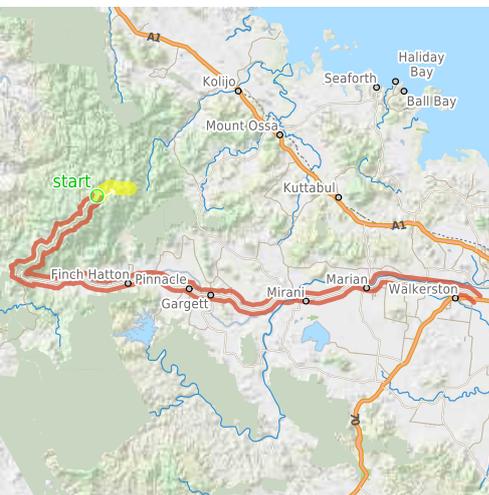

Hard track

Starting near the end of Dalrymple Road, Dalrymple Heights, this walk takes you to the summit of Mount Dalrymple via a singular track, crossing multiple creeks along the way. You can expect a truly panoramic view over the whole hinterland around you that will make this journey worthwhile. Hike through a forest that looks so ancient you may lose your sense of time and feel like you'll run into a velociraptor as you turn a corner. Strangler figs and all kinds of majestic plants add to the scenery as well. There are heaps of leeches in the area due to the humidity, so cover yourself well and bring insect repellent. Take lots of water and also consider wearing hiking boots with ankle support. Let us begin by acknowledging the Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.



Class 4 of 6 Rough track, where fallen trees and other obstacles are likely	
Quality of track	Formed track, with some branches and other obstacles (3/6)
Gradient	Very steep (4/6)
Signage	Minimal directional signs (4/6)
Infrastructure	Limited facilities, not all cliffs are fenced (3/6)
Experience Required	Some bushwalking experience recommended (3/6)
Weather	Storms may impact on navigation and safety (3/6)



Getting to the start: From Peak Downs Highway, 70

- Turn on to then drive for 69.7 km
- Turn right onto Bee Creek Road and drive for another 45 m
- Continue onto Cummings Street and drive for another 20.5 km

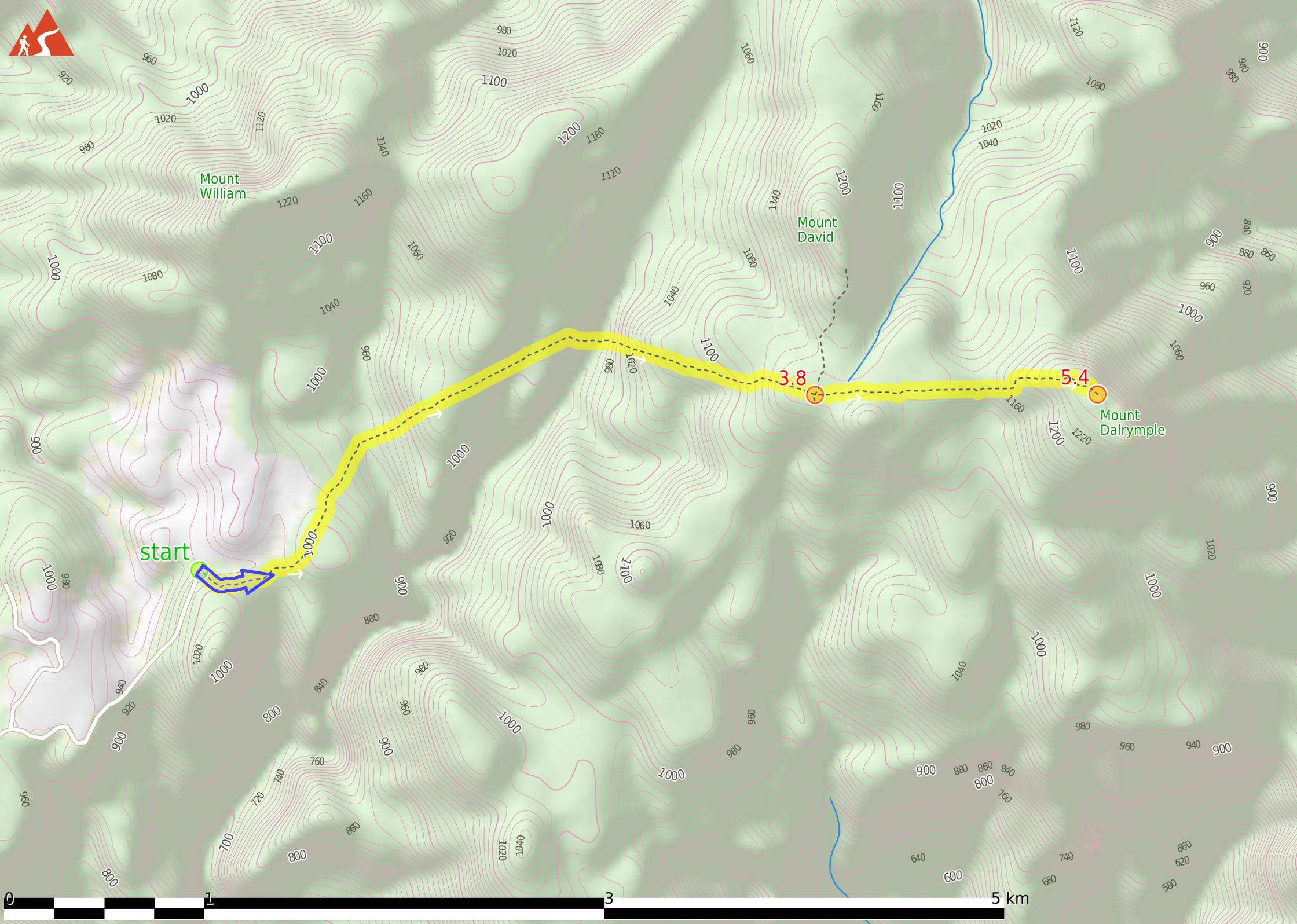
Before you start any journey ensure you;

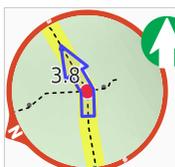


Getting started: From the intersection near the end of Dalrymple Road (across Fredricksons Farm), head southeast along the dirt track, moving almost perpendicularly away from Dalrymple Road. After about 140 metres, follow the track as it veers left to continue along the Mount Dalrymple Track. Keep an eye out for pink ribbons/tape and spray paint on trees, retrace your steps if you don't see them for a while.



Start.

-  After 1.4 km cross the ford.
-  After another 940 m cross the ford.
-  After another 410 m cross the ford.
-  After another 750 m cross the ford.
-  After another 430 m come to the viewpoint (35 m on your right).



Continue straight.

-  After another 820 m cross the ford.
-  After another 700 m come to "Mount Dalrymple".
