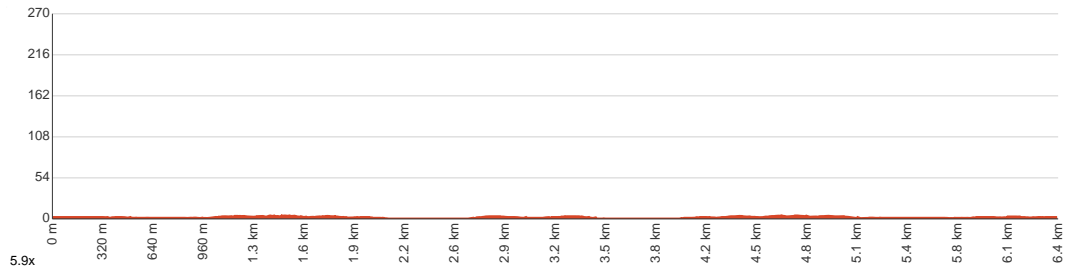
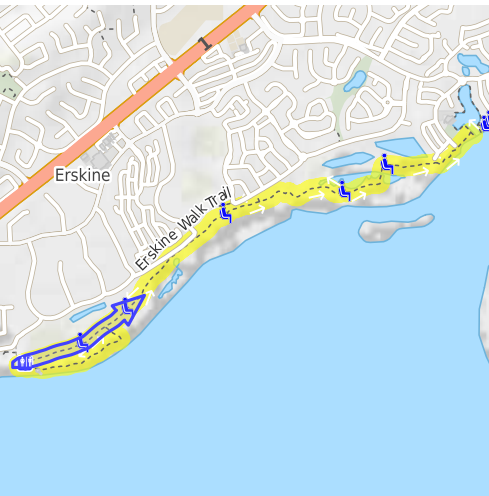

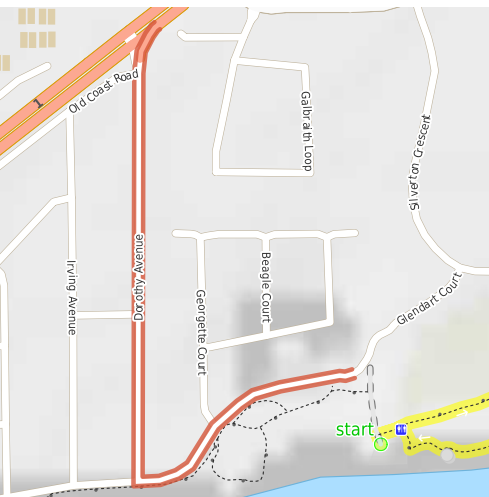
Starting from the car park off Dampier Avenue, Erskine, this walk takes you on a circuit in Len Howard Conservation Park. The park is known for the wide variety of wildlife and the tranquillity it offers while being close to the urban setting. You can observe the insects, kangaroos and quendas along with the birdlife; special migratory waders visiting during summer. As you walk around the freshwater pools, you will see that the plantation in the area is remarkable as well, varying from wildflowers to fungi. It is suitable for all family members and dog friendly (on leash). There are seats provided along the trail and a toilet at the car park. Let us begin by acknowledging the Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.

- Turn on to then drive for 700 m
- Turn left onto Dampier Avenue and drive for another 390 m



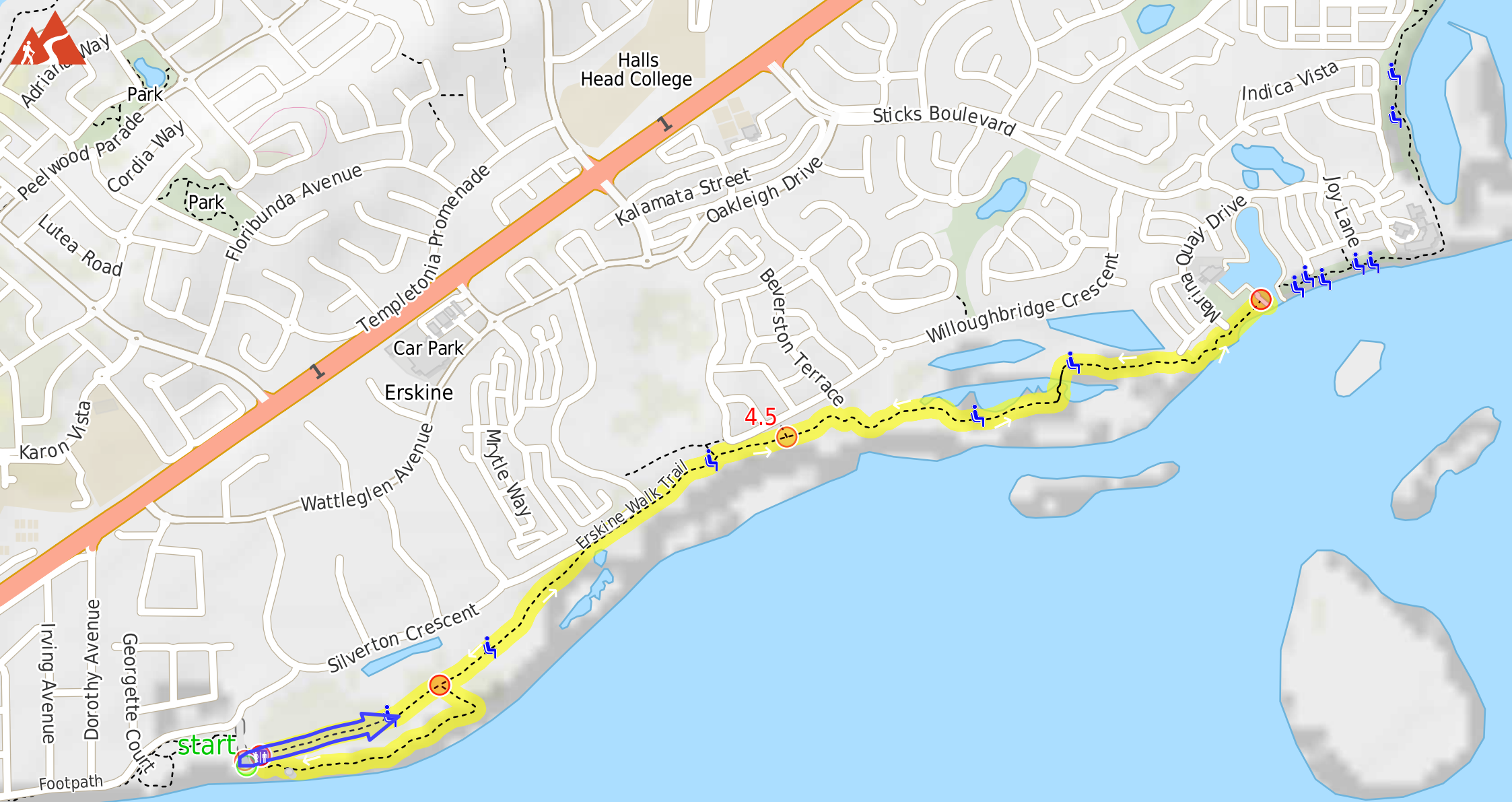
Before you start any journey ensure you;

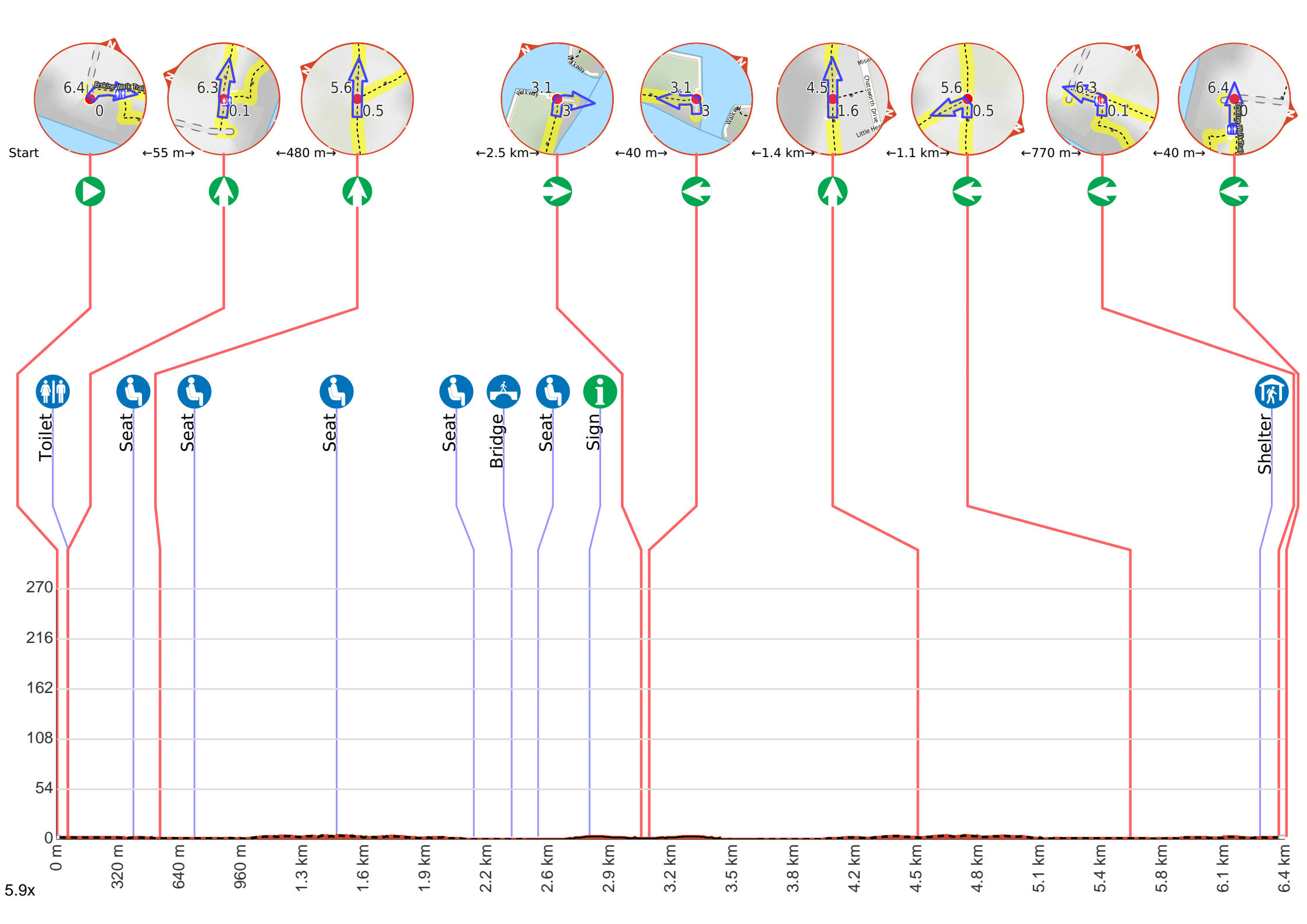
- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning

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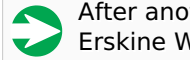








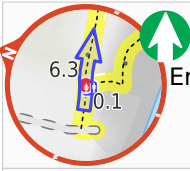
Start.



After another 15 m **turn right**, to head along Erskine Walk Trail.



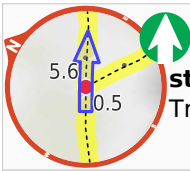
After another 45 m pass the toilet (on your right). This toilet is male and female.



Continue straight, to head along Erskine Walk Trail.



After another 340 m pass a seat (5 m on your left).



After another 140 m **continue straight**, to head along Erskine Walk Trail.



After another 180 m pass a seat (5 m on your left).



After another 740 m pass a seat (7 m on your left).



After another 6 m **continue straight**, to head along Erskine Walk Trail.



After another 180 m **continue straight**, to head along Erskine Walk Trail.



After another 530 m pass a seat (9 m on your left).



After another 195 m cross the bridge (about 90 m long)



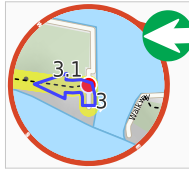
After another 45 m pass a seat (4 m on your left).



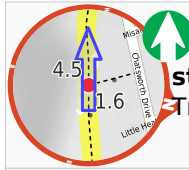
After another 265 m pass the "Erskine Walk Trail (Start)".



After another 270 m **turn right**, to head along Walkway.



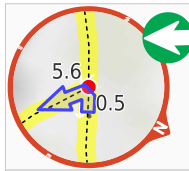
After another 40 m **turn left**.



After another 1.4 km **continue straight**, to head along Erskine Walk Trail.



After another 180 m **continue straight**, to head along Erskine Walk Trail.



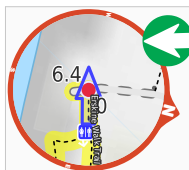
After another 920 m **turn left**.

After another 95 m **turn left**, to head along Erskine Walk Trail.



After another 40 m **turn left**.
