

## Plunkett and Wickham Circuit









Starting from the end of Flesser Road, Tamborine, this walk takes you on a circuit in the woodlands of Plunkett Conservation Park and Wickham National Park, optionally visiting the Grass Tree Lookout with a side trip. Embark on a pleasant journey in the open eucalypt forest that is richened by the grass trees and colourful wildflowers sprinkled throughout the track. The lively forest is home to koalas and southern greater gliders, so keep an eye on treetops to have a chance of spotting one. Rare bird species such as the white-throated needletail and Albert's lyrebird reside in the park as well. Dogs are allowed to join you on this track considering they're on leash. Let us begin by acknowledging the Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.



Class 4 of 6 Rough track, where fallen trees and other obstacles are likely	
Quality of track	Clear and well formed track or trail (2/6)
Gradient	Very steep (4/6)
Signage	Directional signs along the way (3/6)
Infrastructure	Generally useful facilities (such as fenced cliffs and seats) (2/6)
Experience Required	Some bushwalking experience recommended (3/6)
Weather	Weather generally has little impact on safety (2/6)

Getting to the start: From Pacific Motorway, M1

- Turn on to then drive for 420 m
- At roundabout, take exit 5 onto Computer Road and drive for another 370 m
- At roundabout, take exit 3 onto Cuthbert Drive and drive for another 910 m
- Turn left onto Darlington Drive and drive for another 1.9 km
- At roundabout, take exit 1 onto Stanmore Road and drive for another 1.1 km
- At roundabout, take exit 2 onto Stanmore Road and drive for another 3.8 km
- Keep left onto Stanmore Road and drive for another 45 m
  Turn slight left onto Beaudesert Beenleigh Road, 92 and drive for another 6.6 km
- Turn right onto Chardon Bridge Road and drive for another 390 m
- Turn left onto Plunkett Road and drive for another 510 m
- Turn right onto Flesser Road and drive for another 580 m


## Before you start any journey ensure you;


- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- · Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- Are healthy and fit enough for this journey


If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.











Getting started: From the end of Flesser Road, Tamborine, head towards the metal gate near the green "Plunkett Conservation Park" sign along the dirt road. Head over/around the said gate and join the Flesser Break track as you pass by a green signpost to your right. After about 445 metres, turn right at the T intersection and cross the creek via the Main Break. Shortly after crossing the creek, turn left at the 3-way intersection and join Brays Break to continue along Plunkett and Wickham Circuit(counterclockwise).




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After 20 m head through/around the gate.



After another 75 m (at the intersection of Flesser Break & Point Break) **continue straight**, to head along Flesser Break.





After another 20 m cross the ford.

After another 30 m (at the intersection of Main Break & Brays Break) **turn left**, to head along Brays Break.




After another 215 m (at the intersection of Highpoint Break & Brays Break) **turn left**, to head along Brays Break.



After another 50 m cross the ford (about 15 m long)



After another 640 m (at the intersection of Powerlink Break & Brays Break) **turn right**, to head along Powerlink Break.





After another 220 m (at the intersection of Vics Break & Scree Break) **continue straight**, to head along Vics Break.



After another 270 m (from the Vics Break) **turn right**.





After another 890 m (at the intersection of Tower Break & Drovers Break) **continue straight**, to head along Drovers Break.

After another 390 m (at the intersection of Drovers Break & Wallys Access) **turn right**, to head along Drovers Break.



After another 90 m (at the intersection of Black Rock Break & Drovers Break)

veer right, to head along Black Rock
Break.



After another 370 m (from the Black Rock Break) **continue straight**, to head along Black Rock Break.

**Start of an optional side trip**: This optional side trip takes you to the Glass Tree Lookout via the Grass Tree Beak track, providing you with great northeasterly views. Keep in mind that this side trip will add around 40 minutes to your hike out & back.



To start this optional side trip turn left here. at the intersection of Black Rock Break & Grass Tree Break **Start** heading along *Grass Tree Break* (a vehicle track).



After another 460 m (from the Grass Tree Break) **turn right**, to head along Grass Tree Break.



After another 370 m (at the intersection of Grass Tree Break & Allys Break) **continue straight**, to head along Grass Tree Break.



After another 510 m (from the Grass Tree Break) **turn right**.



After another 205 m come to a seat., has a backrest.



"Grass Tree Lookout".



The end.



Turn around and retrace your steps back the 1.5 km to the main route.




Back at the main route turn sharp right and follow on from the 4.1 km waypoint.





After another 90 m (at the intersection of Black Rock Break & Grass Tree Break) **turn right**, to head along Black Rock Break.




After another 105 m (from the Black Rock Break) **continue straight**.

















After another 730 m (at the intersection of Brays Break & Main Break) **continue straight**, to head along Main Break.

After another 55 m (at the intersection of Main Break & Flesser Break) **turn left**, to head along Flesser Break.

After another 345 m (at the intersection of Flesser Break & Point Break) **continue straight**, to head along Flesser Break.



After another 95 m come to the end.
