

Base Assembly

1	1	20.44" x 3.00" x 0.25" FLAT
2	2	30.00" X 1.00" X 0.08" SQUARE TUBE
3	1	4.00" x 1.50" x 0.25" ANGLE
4	1	5.00" x 1.5" x 0.25" ANGLE
5	2	2.0" CARRIAGE BOLT
6	2	1/2" SPLIT-LOCK WASHER
7	2	1/2"-13 NUT




1. Orient the legs (2) inside the flat base (1) and set

the base on top of the legs, lining up the bolt holes.

- 2. The angle pieces (3&4) come pre-welded on the base.
- 3. Install the carriage bolts (5) through the base and then the legs.
- 4. Place the split-lock washer (6) over the bolt.
- 5. Tighten the nuts (7) onto the bolt.




Silhouette Assembly

Part List:

PART NUMBER	QTY.	DESCRIPTION
5	2	2.0" CARRIAGE BOLT
6	2	1/2" SPLIT-LOCK WASHER
7	2	1/2"-13 NUT
8	1	56" x 1.50" x 0.25" ANGLE (POST)
9	1	HEAD
10	1	SILHOUETTE TARGET
11	1	TWO BOLT ADAPTER




- 1. Install the carriage bolts (5) through the front of the silhouette target (10).
- 2. Lay the silhouette target face down with the bolts protruding through.
- 3. Lay the flat side of the head (9) against the silhouette in-between the two bolts.
 - a. The piece that holds the silhouette target to the post is referred to as the "head" in these instructions.
- 4. Install the two bolt adapter (11) over the two protruding bolts. The flat of the head should be sandwiched between the silhouette and the two bolt adapter.
- 5. Install the split-lock washers (6) over the bolts.
- 6. Tighten the nuts (7) onto the bolts so it secures the head between the adapter and silhouette.
- 7. Take the post (8) and install it between the angled iron pieces of the base.
- 8. Take the assembled silhouette piece and slide the post between the two angled iron pieces of the head.



Round Target Assembly

Part List:

PART NO.	QTY.	DESCRIPTION
5	1	2.0" CARRIAGE BOLT
6	1	1/2" SPLIT-LOCK WASHER
7	1	1/2" - 13 NUT
8	1	56" X 1.50" X 0.25" ANGLE (POST)
9	1	HEAD
12	1	ROUND TARGET



- 1. Install the carriage bolt (5) through the front of the round target (12).
- 2. Lay the round target face down with the bolt protruding through.
- 3. Lay the flat side of the head (9) against the round target with the bolt going through the hole in the head.
 - a. The piece that holds the round target to the post is referred to as the "head" in these instructions.
- 4. Install the split-lock washer (6) over the bolt.
- 5. Tighten the nut (7) onto the bolt so it secures the head to the round target.
- 6. Take the post (8) and install it between the angled iron pieces of the base.
- Take the assembled round target piece and slide the post between the two angled iron pieces of the head.
