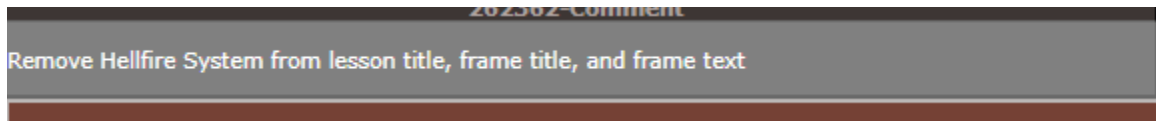


When addressing a comment in meld for Frame Title/Text/Lesson Title changes:

With the “Old Frame title” for example, this is what the original title of the frame was called before being addressed by Troy’s comment. Afterwards the “New Frame title” is what the title is called after addressing Troy’s comment for removal

When it comes to body text, in this case it’s called “old text/new Text” you can copy and paste the old text right out of the meld Edit content/Content tab, just make sure you removed any meld mark up code: /@F /@R (Block:2), ect to make it clean and easily understandable.

The note will look like this after it’s all said and done:

Old question/new Question followed by the old distractors/New distractors

Old Question: What is the capital of the United states?

Old Distractors:

New Question: Name the Allies of the United nations in WW2.

- A. Japan, Korea, Oceania, and United Kingdom

- D. United States, Canada, Oceania, and France

FRAME REMOVAL SHOULD BE DONE BEFORE ANY OTHER COMMENTS ARE ADDRESSED IN MELD

For Frame Removal:

The Removal of a frame **MUST BE DONE** before addressing comments. If comments are addressed first and frames removed afterwards it will mess up the order of the comments when they are exported for FDO review.

When removing a frame in meld you will leave a comment on the first frame of the lesson, typically the distribution statement.

Stating what frame was removed:

Removed Frame 29

In the notes section you will detailed the frame removed again, followed by the title of the frame and why it was removed. For example:

Removed Frame 29

Title: Summary 2

Removed due to no-go items – Hellfire

It will look like this after all information has been added:

What to do if a frame requires extensive revisions that will not fit in the note:

Sometimes a frame in Meld will require extensive revisions that cannot all fit in one note:

In this case you will add the old text, if it will all fit into the original comment. You will then make an second comment titled "Continuation of Comment made by ----"

For that comment for example you would make a new comment like this:
