Roseway is the flagship platform for World Ocean School, a 501(c)(3) organization delivering an authentic method of experiential education at sea to underserved school-aged children.

Built in Massachusetts in 1925, Roseway is one of only six remaining Essex-built Grand Banks fishing schooners. She has held a long and distinguished career, including serving as a fishing schooner, a racing yacht, and a pilot ship in Boston guiding Allied vessels through minefields and submarine nets during World War II.
