Built in Massachusetts in 1925, *Roseway* is one of the six remaining Essex-built Grant Banks fishing schooners. She has held a long and distinguished career, including serving as a fishing schooner, a racing yacht, and a pilot ship in Boston guiding Allied vessels through minefields and submarine nets during World War II.
