It is a great pleasure to welcome all of you to the ICPC Asia Yokohama Regional Contest.

Keio University is proud to host the Asia Regional Contest for the fifth consecutive year, sixth time overall. We are especially happy to host the regional contest onsite for the first time in three years. I am sure that all the contestants are also happy to participate in an onsite contest.

On July 8, 298 teams from 79 colleges and universities all over Japan competed in the Japan Online Contest. Although the number of teams was far less than the record 495 teams in 2019, the competition was held at a very high level. 43 teams from 30 colleges and universities advanced to this ICPC Asia Yokohama Regional Contest. They will vie for the rights to go to the World Finals. Details of the World Finals have not been announced as of the time of the preparation of this program.

We believe that this contest will be a great opportunity for participating students to demonstrate their programming skills acquired through their daily studies. We also believe that participation in this contest will be a wonderful opportunity for students of varying backgrounds to interact and exchange ideas with each other.


