



## ONCE Foundation and GLS Spain join forces to promote the employment of people with disabilities

- Through the signing of the Inserta Agreement

**Madrid, February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2024 -** GLS Group Region MD for Iberia & Ireland, Luis Doncel, and the General Secretary of ONCE Foundation and Inserta Empleo, and Director of Transformation, Excellence and Equality at ONCE Foundation, Virginia Carcedo, have today signed a three-year Inserta Agreement to promote hiring people with disabilities at the express transport company.

"GLS Spain is committed to inclusion and diversity. We firmly believe in the value that each individual brings to the company, because instead of disability, we see capacity. We believe that everyone deserves to develop their talent", says Luis Doncel.

Virginia Carcedo expressed how this agreement allows ONCE Foundation to collaborate with a leading company in its sector, which "will incorporate the talent of people with disabilities into its workforce". In addition, she pointed out that people with disabilities and their families are an important niche consumer market, and as such, "this agreement also provides GLS Spain with a competitive advantage and enhances its reputation".

GLS Spain will work with Inserta Empleo, ONCE Foundation's training and employment organisation, to fill new positions opened by the company, pre-select candidates who best fit the job's criteria, and provide tailored training to help these new employees perform the assigned tasks.

Inserta Empleo's work forms part of Spain's national programmes FSE+ 'Youth Employment' (CCI 2021ES05SFPR001), 'Social Inclusion, Child Guarantee and Fight Against Poverty' (2021ES05SFPR003), and the Autonomous Community of the Canary Islands' FSE+ programme, InclUEmpleo Atlántida (CCI2021ES05SFPR009), developed by ONCE Foundation through Inserta Empleo, and co-financed by the European Union to increase the training and employment offered to people with disabilities.

Through this agreement, GLS Spain will join the Inserta Responsable Forum, a networking and social innovation platform for sharing practices, tools and experiences that facilitate the effective development of policies to help integrate talented individuals with disabilities into the labour market.
