## OFFICE OF THE UTAH STATE AUDITOR RELEASES NEW TRANSPARENT UTAH TOOL CONSOLIDATING MIDA INFORMATION

### **Auditor Cannon Will Have Media Availability Today at 4 PM In The Capitol Board Room To Answer Questions**

SALT LAKE CITY—The Office of the Utah State Auditor (the Office) today announced the launch of a new Transparent Utah website that has gathered publicly available information regarding the Military Installation Development Authority (MIDA). The [MIDA dashboard within Transparent.Utah.gov](#) organizes and summarizes public information surrounding MIDA legislation, projects, financial activity, and source materials from 2007 through 2026.

In the past few weeks, the Office has received a number of requests regarding MIDA. In response, the Office has developed this Transparent Utah tool to provide a centralized, easy-to-navigate resource of this information. The new interactive dashboard is designed to provide publicly available information to help the public better understand MIDA: what it is, what it does, what authority it has, and how that authority has changed over time.

Compiling nearly 20 years of public information and complex data into an accessible interface, all in one place, this tool empowers Utahns to find information about MIDA's history, scope, projects, and financial operations. It will continue to be updated and expanded as additional information becomes available.

Optimized for an interactive timeline view, the new Transparent Utah tool allows people to explore MIDA's operations from its legislative beginnings in 2007 through projected developments in 2026. Key features of the new dashboard include:

- **Legislative History and Key Powers:** A plain-language inventory of MIDA's statutory authority, municipal-type powers, public-private partnership capabilities, and property tax allocation authority.
- **Project Summaries and Map:** Interactive details and a map of the MIDA areas, including Falcon Hill, the Military Recreation Facility (Deer Valley East Village), the Utah Data Center, the Mountain Veterans Program at Sundance, and the newly announced Stratos Project Area.

- **Source Documents and Meeting Materials:** Centralized access to hundreds of source documents, including project area plans, board member histories, entity relationship charts, and Open Public Meeting materials.
- **Financial Activity Trendline:** A summary and visualization of MIDA's Financial Statements data, detailing total revenues, expenditures, assets, liabilities, and debt service through 2025. Additionally, items reported to [transparent.utah.gov](https://transparent.utah.gov) can be found on the Government > Entity Overview > Military Installation Development Authority.

Auditor Cannon will have media availability today in the Capitol Board Room (Capitol Building Second Floor, Suite 240) beginning at 4 PM. At that time, Auditor Cannon will give a brief overview of this new tool and will be available for questions regarding this or other additional items of interest.

The Office of the Utah State Auditor explicitly notes that this is an informational tool that serves as a public data repository and background summary created from a thorough review of submitted financial statements, legislation, project reports, and other publicly available resources.
