to operate an incinerator (AD-Maximiser 1-ABP low capacity incinerator) on the premises to incinerate Category 1 (dead pets only, no ruminants shall be incinerated) animal by-products.

- 2. The incinerator shall be located at the agreed place dedicated shed.
- 3. For at least 10% of burn cycles the temperature reading (for secondary chamber) shall be manually recorded every 2 hours during the burn cycle.
- The incinerator must be operated in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- 5. The incinerator must be subject to an annual service by the manufacturer or an independent service engineer who should be able to confirm that the incinerator is still capable of meeting the requirements of Regulation (EC) No. 142/2011.

This approval is valid from 27 April 2017.
