### Explaining European Waste Catalogue (EWC) Codes

Codes marked with an asterisk \* are classified as Hazardous Waste. Where a waste is not listed in the EWC Catalogue with an asterisk it is classified as non-hazardous.

The majority of the wastes listed on this poster relate to wastes from the photographic industry (chapter 09) and municipal wastes [household and similar commercial, industrial and institutional wastes] (chapter 20).
