Including - fixer only.



Including - paper correspondence, receipts, invoices, customer records and other confidential documentation.

Including - fluorescent tubes, sodium lamps and discharge lamps.

x-ray film

Including - negatives, transparancies and photographic film.

EWC Code = 09 01 07



Explaining European Waste Catalogue (EWC) Codes

Codes marked with an asterisk * are classified as Hazardous Waste. Where a waste is not listed in the EWC Catalogue with an asterisk it is classified as non-hazardous.

The majority of the wastes listed on this poster relate to wastes from the photographic industry (chapter 09) and municiple wastes [household and similar commercial, industrial and institutional wastes] (chapter 20).
