build a sustainable future. Just as these homes will shield the body, education is equally important to empower the mind. Emaan Relief continues to provide educational opportunities for underprivileged people in Bangladesh through our Emaan Relief Foundation, where 150 students have been housed,

While providing secure housing and intellectual tools is vital, we recognise that immediate needs also require attention. By offering financial assistance to the most vulnerable, whether through zakat or voluntary donations, we can ensure access to necessities like food, healthcare, and clothing. This tangible support alleviates immediate hardship, fostering a sense of security and allowing individuals to focus on the future.

We have provided these three pillars of support to **thousands** of suffering families around the world. Hospitals are grappling with the immense challenge of tending to survivors, while severe restrictions on movement and access to basic necessities to sustain life, such as food, fuel, and electricity have left over 2 million Palestinian children, elderly, women and men constantly life in a state of hunger, fear, insecurity and vulnerability.

Chronic scarcity of water resources is increasingly becoming a source of conflict between provinces in Pakistan. Climate change, uneven distribution, lack of infrastructure, and inefficient standards have caused the country to further plunge into a severe water crisis.





Through your support, we have been able to alleviate the hardships faced by those affected by the water shortage in the Sindh Province of Pakistan. These wells play a pivotal role in relieving the water burden on communities in need. The handpumps and tube wells significantly benefit multiple households, enabling them to fulfill their water requirements for both domestic use and agricultural activities. The installation of solar wells has proven instrumental in sustaining numerous villages. These solar wells provide a reliable and eco-friendly solution.

Together, we are working towards creating a sustainable future, where access to clean water is no longer a luxury but a fundamental right for all.

Lack of access to safe and clean water poses a critical issue for communities in Togo. Despite annual rainfall, Togo battles a water crisis due to uneven distribution, pollution, and climate change. Rural areas often rely on contaminated surface water, while urban zones face growing demand and unsuitable infrastructure. This scarcity affects the health and livelihoods of those most in need.







In our effort and commitment to address this pressing concern, we intend to continue installing more wells and extending the reach of safe water access to additional communities in need. On February 6th, 2023, a devastating earthquake measuring 7.8 in magnitude struck Turkey and Syria, leaving a path of unimaginable destruction and profound loss. The aftermath of this tragic event was marked by an overwhelming toll, with Turkey losing over 48,400 and Syria losing 7.200 lives.







We were compelled to take action in response to this catastrophic event. We organized an urgent emergency response, providing a lifeline of sustenance and solace to the survivors.





PAKISTAN VILLAGE

As we entered 2022, Pakistan was already grappling with a severe humanitarian crisis, with 38 million people living in conditions of food insecurity. During this period, the nation experienced devastating flooding and landslides. The destruction extended from homes to crops, orchards, and livestock, exacerbating the scarcity of already limited resources. The provinces of Baluchistan, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, and Sindh were particularly hard-hit due to their pre-existing levels of poverty.





swiftly responded to the crisis, providing vital humanitarian aid to the worst-affected communities. Emgan Relief has undertaken a significant initiative to address the long-term needs of the affected communities. Our construction of a village in Pakistan, designed to provide sustainable support and resources, is nearing completion and is scheduled to open in February 2024. This endeavour represents our commitment to not only respond to immediate crises but also to contribute to the lasting recovery and resilience of communities facing ongoing challenges.
