

Providing the best form of education to our children is at the heart of enabling them and their communities to lead a path out of poverty. Our children gain

both an Islamic and National Curriculum education. Since the start of ERF we've had over 30 students that have

memorised the Qur'an and are now able to have self-sustainable living through teaching the Qur'an to others.

Emaan Relief was privileged to establish the Emaan Relief Foundation (ERF) in Bangladesh. The foundation educates 120 full-time students, of which 45 live on-site. All students are safeguarded, nurtured and have their daily needs taken care of. Out of the 45 boarding students, 16 are orphans and the remaining belong to extremely poor families. These students receive 3 nutritious meals per day, and all their daily needs are met, such as clothes and hygiene which are catered to by 8 ERF staff members.

Through providing a safe environment of learning and living, we tackle child exploitation, instill confidence and empower the children to create a lasting change within their communities.







The Foundation Expansion

Emaan Relief began the Expansion of the Foundation at the start of Ramadan 2021. This expansion, which is due to be completed early 2022, will house **50** of the most **vulnerable and needy children**


including orphans. Through our expansion, more students will also have the opportunity to enrol and look forward to a better future for themselves; as well as a safe and secure place to call their own.






Food Packs

Despite the pandemic continuing to loom over the world, last Ramadan thousands of Muslims enjoyed the blessed month with your support.

Across the Middle East, we distributed food packs in Yemen, Palestine and Syria. Families struggling to fend for themselves were able to enjoy a nutritious iftar.

Iftar Meals & Zakatul Fitr

Over **5,330** hot iftar meals were delivered to those struggling in Somalia, Mauritania, Lebanon and Syria. Alongside this, **4,161kg of rice** were distributed as Zakatul Fitr. This benefited **1,387** needy individuals in Syria.





Your annual sacrifice is much more than just fulfilling your Islamic obligation. Millions of impoverished families look forward to Eid Al-Adha as this is the only time they may be able to enjoy a meal which consists of meat. Your continued generosity ensures that these families are able to celebrate this blessed occasion with joy and loved ones. This year we distributed **161** sheep and 21 cows on your behalf in Yemen, Mozambique and Malawi.

Displacement Across Syria

Restoring Dignity

The continued bombardment of Syria has caused millions to become refugees and internally displaced without a place of safe shelter. Emaan Relief has begun the construction of a village of 70 homes which consists of two bedrooms, a bathroom and kitchen. All of the houses will have clean running water generated from the wells built in the village. The village will also have a mosque which will serve the people as a community center and school. Insha'Allah with the help of Allah (**) we envisage a time where the dignity of the Syrian people will be restored.





In many parts of the world, a large number of people live in the most destitute and underprivileged areas unable to earn a livelihood for themselves and their families. Our zakat project enables them to lift themselves out of poverty by providing them their own business to run. Electric Rickshaws are one of the most reliable and widely used forms of transport in Bangladesh. Through saving the cost of petrol, the owner of this rickshaw is able to create a sustainable income and provide food and education to their families.

Orphans & Widows



After many years of civil war the children and mothers of Yemen have been plunged into what has been described as the worst humanitarian crisis in the world. They have been left to face hunger, disease and endless conflict. The war has left millions of women widowed and children orphaned.

These families have little access to food and basic necessities. Emaan Relief provides monthly food packs to these widows and orphans in order to ease their suffering.

Help us end the shortage of clean water

Clean water is still a luxury for millions around the world. In the Sindh Province of Pakistan, where water is scarce, we have installed **370 water wells: 287 being handpumps, 72 tube wells and 11 solar wells.**

Due to the continued Covid 19 pandemic, clean water has never been more important. The handpumps and tube wells benefit several surrounding households along with their livestock and crops. Our solar wells **help sustain many families** and can be accessed by numerous villages including local farmers.

Emergency Aid

The continuous blockage and bombardment of Gaza has left daily life to be unrecognisable. Most of the Palestinians are now dependent on your generous aid for their survival.





In order to continue our support in Gaza, Emaan Relief alongside 11 other charities and over 20 Mosques raised over £435,000 in aid of the people of Gaza.

Bringing Warmth Throughout Winter



In our winter appeal this year, we were fortunate enough to be able to bring aid to the Syrian and Palestinian refugees struggling in the harsh winter of Lebanon.

Given the economic crisis, which the country has struggled to fight over the past year, we were also fortunate to come to the aid of some of the most needy Lebanese families in Beka Valley, Lebanon.

In every conflict, **children are the**hardest hit and their suffering is one

of the most difficult things to witness. The escalating conflict in Syria, has left **countless children fatherless or parentless** which leaves them prone to poverty and in endless hardship.

This winter, we were able to ease their suffering slightly through the provisions of food packs, heaters, mattresses, blankets, wellingtons, jackets, hats, gloves and scarves. The deteriorating living conditions of the Syrian refugees is one which no human should endure. There is much work to be done.
