#### ADDRESSING MALNUTRITION AND SUPPORTING VULNERABLE COMMUNITIES

Yemen remains at the epicenter of one of the world's most devastating humanitarian crises. Years of relentless conflict have left millions of people struggling to survive amidst food shortages, displacement, and a collapsing healthcare system. Families face unimaginable decisions, such as whether to feed their children or seek lifesaving medical care. Against this backdrop, Emaan Relief has been steadfast in delivering hope and essential aid to the most vulnerable.



Malnutrition, especially among children, is a pervasive threat in Yemen, with millions suffering from severe undernourishment. Emaan Relief's malnutrition treatment program has been a lifeline, providing comprehensive care to

Beyond tackling malnutrition, Emaan Relief has delivered vital resources to families struggling to survive the hardships of war and displacement. This included distributing food packs and bread to families in need, serving hot meals to displaced individuals, and delivering fresh meat to the most vulnerable. Additionally, Emaan Relief ensured access to clean water for 75,000 people through water tankers, and cash assistance programs offered financial support to many families.

BRINGING WARMTH TO VULNERABLE COMMUNITIES IN LEBANON, GAZA, SYRIA AND AFGHANISTAN






