When you perform Qurbani, you show your submission, appreciation, and generosity towards Allah (SWT). It helps you get closer to Him and assists the underprivileged at the same time. For countless families all across the globe, Qurbani is not just a practice; it is the only occasion in which they can savor meat. Your donation will provide them with nourishment and help them celebrate Eid in happiness.

In performing Qurbani, we learn that all our possessions belong to Allah (SWT) and that one of His trusts upon us is to take care of the needy people.



## WHAT SETS US APART

- » **Your Qurbani is carried out as a sacred trust (Amanah),** with care taken to honour your intention and fulfil your obligation correctly.
- » **With over 40 years of experience,** Al Mustafa Welfare Trust has built a strong global network to deliver aid reliably and at scale.
- » **Priority is given to those most in need,** including orphans, widows, refugees, and families living below the poverty line.
- » **Operational presence in hard-to-reach and crisis-affected areas** ensures your Qurbani reaches those often left behind.
- » **Animals are sourced locally,** supporting farmers, reducing costs, and strengthening local economies.
- » **Your Qurbani not only provides food but also improves nutrition,** restores dignity, and brings joy to families during Eid.
- » **Meat is processed hygienically and distributed promptly** to ensure freshness and maximum benefit to recipients.

## GEOGRAPHIC COVERAGE

Palestine (Gaza), Lebanon, Yemen and Syria (Refugees)

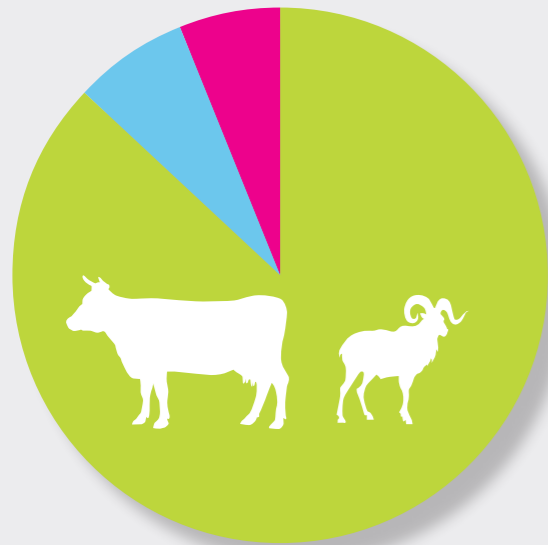


### Africa

Djibouti, Somalia, Niger, The Gambia, Kenya, Sudan and Tanzania

Final country allocations will be based on need assessments, donor preferences, and field capacity.

## SITE SELECTION DISTRIBUTION AND MANAGEMENT

In order to facilitate Qurbani distribution in an efficient and secure manner, all Qurbani distribution sites have been strategically chosen by the field team.

- 1 Distribution sites are selected keeping in view their accessibility for the local population, such that the needy families can easily visit distribution centers without any difficulty.
- 2 The site is then checked for its security and organization to accommodate distribution of food items.
- 3 Appropriate facilities are made available at each location to handle a large number of beneficiaries.
- 4 Appropriate facilities are also provided to ensure hygienic conditions and proper storage of meat if needed.
- 5 Shelters are also provided in case of tough climatic or difficult conditions.

## UNDERSTANDING HOW YOUR QURBANI WORKS

**From your decision to make your sacrifice until it reaches a needy family, we will ensure that everything is done with utmost dignity and respect for you and your sacrifice.**

- 1 **You Choose Your Qurbani**  
Choose from our list of countries or give to the most needed Qurbani fund. This allows us to distribute your sacrifice where it is most needed.
- 2 **Local Procurement of Animals**  
Our local teams purchase animals within the community, helping the farmers, while meeting all the Islamic regulations.
- 3 **Your Sacrifice Is Performed**  
Your sacrifice is carried out in your name, in full accordance with Shariah, during the blessed days of Eid al-Adha.
- 4 **Your Qurbani Is Distributed**  
The meat is prepared and then distributed to needy families that include orphaned children, widowed women, refugee families, and poverty-stricken individuals.
- 5 **Your Lasting Contribution**  
This may be the only source of fresh meat for these families throughout the year.

## BENEFICIARY

## SELECTION

**Al Mustafa Welfare Trust ensures that Qurbani meat reaches those who need it most through a careful and needs-based selection process.**

Our local teams, who have deep knowledge of their communities, identify and prioritise the most vulnerable households. Beneficiaries are selected based on financial hardship and limited access to food, with particular focus on:

- » Orphans and child-headed households
- » Widows and elderly individuals without support
- » Refugees and internally displaced families
- » Low-income households living below the poverty line

To maintain dignity and organisation, beneficiaries are informed in advance about the distribution time, location, and the quantity of meat they will receive.

This structured approach ensures that your Qurbani is delivered fairly, respectfully, and reaches those who truly need it most

## WHY YOUR QURBANI MAKES A DIFFERENCE

Across the globe, many people still struggle with hunger and lack of proper nutrition.

Approximately 1 out of 9 individuals worldwide lack food security, while close to 3 million children annually lose their lives due to malnutrition. In most cases, impoverished families are unable to purchase healthy food, particularly meat.

Qurbani helps fill this void by delivering fresh meat to those in need, thereby ensuring they receive proteins and other nutrients that promote healthy diets. To many of these families, meat may only be eaten once or twice a year, as they cannot afford to buy it frequently.



### Case Study Sophia Ali's Story

Sophia Ali Kulisa lives in Kuruso, a remote village far from the nearest city. Like many families in her community, daily life is a quiet struggle, food and clean water are scarce, and most families survive by making charcoal and selling firewood. The little food they can afford is rarely balanced, and fresh meat is something they taste only once a year.

During last Eid al-Adha, Al Mustafa Welfare Trust's local team arrived in Kuruso to distribute Qurbani meat to the village. For Sophia, for the children, and for every family who gathered that day, it was more than a nutritious meal, it was a celebration.

"Today is a joyful day," Sophia said, smiling. "Children and everyone in the village came to receive and eat the meat. You have brought us so much joy. May God bless you and bring more in the future."
