#### **VISION**


Our vision is the alleviation of poverty, the enabling of education, and the provision of basic amenities for all.

Global Ehsan Relief's Board of Trustees is comprised of members of the Muslim community, and their role in governance encompasses many duties and responsibilities. These include making personal visits to field offices and partner organisations from time to time.

In order to evaluate GER's projects, they ensure our effectiveness in solving problems or aiding those in need, and that they remain true to the humanitarian spirit and the teachings of Islam.



Our first year of operations! Alhamdulillah, we were fortunate to receive support from our local community early on as we launched our first projects. We started out with just a few appeals, focusing on orphans, clean water, and emergency relief in Gaza and Syria.

#### 2016

In 2016, we built on our existing projects and began expanding into more areas. We went on our first mission trips overseas to provide aid for Syrian refugees, and also launched our first disaster relief project in Indonesia after devastating earthquakes struck Sumatra and Aceh. This was also the year we had our first Charity Dinner event in Singapore with renowned Qasidah group Madeehul Mustafa!

#### 2017

2017 marked one of the worst humanitarian crises in modern times; the persecution and forced expulsion of the Rohingya people from Myanmar. We launched appeals to provide them with basic essentials, and visited the refugee camps in Bangladesh to distribute the items to them. We also garnered support for our first ever Umrah for Orphans program, which brought 30 orphaned children on a once-in-a-lifetime trip to the Holy Land.

#### 2018

In 2018, after much planning, we opened 4 branches in Indonesia, Malaysia, Cambodia, and Sri Lanka to facilitate easier on-the-ground operations. This especially helped when Indonesia was struck with multiple earthquakes and tsunamis. Our team embarked on its first disaster relief trip there to distribute aid. We also launched our first CIP programs, deploying volunteers to Aceh and Jordan to assist with distributions and community work.

#### 2019

A year of new milestones, lots of trips, and establishment of key projects. This was the year we launched the IOC in Aceh - which would later become Maahad Ibnu Sina, our flagship center for orphaned and needy children in Indonesia.

Our CIP program expanded to include Bangladesh and Turkey, giving volunteers the opportunity to meet Syrian and Rohingya refugees and learn more about their plight.

#### 2020

Like most of the world, the pandemic hit us hard this year. Many drastic changes were made, including the cancellation of our many planned trips and shifting our collections entirely online.

It was a year of uncertainty and worry, but we emerged stronger and with new ideas for raising funds and continuing to help the most vulnerable members of our community. The continued support and generosity of our donors showed us that even in times of adversity, we can work together to make a difference.

#### 2021

2021 was the year we really expanded our work in Singapore, reaching out to more beneficiaries across our 6 core projects. Even though travel was still barred, our indispensable partners such as Onsur and Islamic Relief enabled us to continue implementing our overseas projects.

We also hit a new milestone in Ramadhan, raising over \$1 million all thanks to our donors' generosity!

# CARE FOR ORPHANS

Orphans have always been one of the most vulnerable demographics. More than 140 million children worldwide are orphaned due to reasons such as war or natural disasters.

Without their parents' care, many are forced into child labour or worse in order to survive. These children need shelter, food, and financial support for their education.

#### **ORPHAN SPONSORSHIP**

The programme provides orphans with monthly funding for all their needs. As of now, we have sponsored 1112, whereby 706 of these children are Hifz students.

#### **UMRAH FOR ORPHANS**

This program gives these orphaned children the chance of a lifetime to make the sacred pilgrimage to Makkah. Since 2017, we have brought 216 orphans from Palestine and Jordan for Umrah.

#### **HOME FOR WIDOWS**

In developing areas, single-parent families, especially widows, lack opportunities to grow. This project ensures widows and orphans worldwide can receive support when they have nowhere else to turn.

#### **ORPHAN HOMES**

Our Orphan Home Projects is a place of refuge to prevent further exploitation and provide the childhood they deserve. Currently, we have built an Orphan Home in Johor Bahru, Malaysia and are in the process to build one in Cambodia, Indonesia and Sri Lanka.

#### **MAAHAD IBNU SINA**

It is an integrated Islamic boarding school in Aceh, Indonesia, with the purpose of educating poor orphans and underprivileged children victims, who had lost a parent. We are determined to continue the mandate of its founders to form young Muslim scholars with noble morals and the ability to contribute and strive in the modern world.

## WIDOW AND ORPHANS FOOD AID PACKS

Many families are dependent on external aid to feed their children each month and we hope to reach as many people in need as we can.

#### **MEALS FOR ORPHAN**

We are committed to solving world hunger by providing food aid packs to help widows and orphans that have been affected by poverty across 15 countries throughout Asia and Africa.



# CARE FOR CLEAN WATER

2.7 billion people find water scarce for at least one month of the entire year.

Clean water is a basic necessity in life; however due to poor infrastructure and investment, an astonishing number of communities do not have access to it.

About 2 million people, mostly children, die from diarrheal diseases contracted from water-borne viruses every year. As such, Global Ehsan worked on providing **8.5 million litres of clean water supply.** 

#### **ANNUAL WATER SUPPLY (GAZA)**

Since 2015, the conflict in Gaza has destroyed the region, disrupting one of the most basic needs of survival - water.

Our mission is to bring clean drinking water to each person living in the Gaza Strip. We aim to provide a long-term, sustainable solution that could provide 24-hour access not only to residents but to hospitals, masjids and schools.

#### **WATER TRUCKING**

The water is supplied from mobile water trucks which then goes around each house twice a year in Gaza, Yemen and Rohingya Refugee Camps in Bangladesh. In Yemen, our partner determines the wells that are under the 'UNICEF WASH Cluster', monitoring where water is chlorinated.

# CARE **FOR REFUGEES**

According to the UN High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR), at the end of 2018, 70.8 million people around the world were forcibly displaced from their homes due to constant conflict, violence, or persecution.

This marks the highest levels of displacement seen on record so far. These people have no shelter, and desperately need food, clean water, medicine, and basic hygiene tools. During winter, they face even harsher difficulties without adequate winter clothing.

Our Care for Refugees program aims to help alleviate the suffering these people face. We have raised funds to provide aid for refugees from Syria and Palestine, as well as the Rohingya refugees in Bangladesh. Your contributions have enabled us to provide them with.

#### **HYGIENE KITS**

Often overlooked, hygiene kits are one of the daily necessities. These basic items allow refugees to live day-to-day with minimal items.

#### WINTER RELIEF SETS

We provide much-needed relief through essential Winter Relief Sets which includes winter clothing, heating aid and hygiene kits.

#### **FOOD AID PACKS**

To date, your support has enabled us to send aid to starving children, helpless widows, and vulnerable elderlies.

#### **COOKED MEALS**

On top of food aid packs, we strive to distribute cooked meals as they do not have access to affordable, nutritious food.

#### **TEMPORARY SHELTERS**

We aim to elevate the lives of these struggling individuals by restoring their personal security, self-sufficiency and dignity.

#### **CLEAN WATER SUPPLY**

We aim to provide a long-term, sustainable solution that could provide 24-hour access to clean water to those living in impoverished conditions.





# GLOBAL WAKAF PROJECTS

Wakaf (endowment) is a voluntary charitable contribution in the form of cash or property to be used in line with Islamic shariah.

It has enormous benefits both for the community and the donors themselves, as anything given for wakaf will yield rewards for the donor as long as it is in use.

Donors can help Muslims around the world while ensuring a good Hereafter for themselves. We provide underprivileged Muslims, including the visually impaired in Indonesia, access to the words of Allah with our Quran and Braille Quran programs.

Additionally, we collect funds to aid needy communities by building mosques, schools, and providing them with clean water via water wells and ablution places.

#### **WAKAF WATER WELLS**

We have completed **3,227 Water Wells** in Cambodia, Sri Lanka, Myanmar, Bangladesh, Pakistan since inception.

#### **WAKAF COMMUNITY WATER WELLS**

Wakaf Community Water Wells was a recent project started in 2020 in Cambodia. Since then, we have provided the villagers with **168 wells**.

#### **WAKAF ABLUTION PLACES**

With the endless support from our donors, we constructed **320 Ablution Places** for mosques in Cambodia and Sri Lanka.



#### **WAKAF QUR'AN**

Global Ehsan Relief embarked on this project to distribute the Quran to the poor and neglected areas. We have successfully delivered over **18,000 Qur'an to 11 countries** in Asia, Middle East and Africa.

#### **WAKAF DIGITAL BRAILLE QURAN**

With our Wakaf Digital Braille Qur'an, we are hoping to make reading and learning of the Qur'an accessible to all in Indonesia. As of 2015, we have provided 1,179 Digital Braille Qur'an to the visually impaired.

#### **WAKAF MADRASAH / SCHOOLS**

To date, Global Ehsan Relief has built **3 schools** in Cambodia. The schools provide opportunities for the children to receive education in a functioning classroom.

#### **WAKAF MASJID**

One of Global Ehsan Relief's efforts to provide for the needy is through our project, Wakaf Masjid, whereby we help construct new mosques in several countries in Asia, Middle East and Africa. **33 mosques** have been built over 7 years.

# SEASONAL PROJECTS RAMADHAN

Ramadhan has always been a special month in the Islamic calendar. Every year, we ramp up our programmes during this blessed month, encouraging the Muslim community to join in and reap more rewards together.

#### **FOOD AID PACKS**

These grocery packs are distributed a week before Ramadhan begins, so that the recipients are equipped to prepare for their daily iftar and sahur meals at home. Since 2016, we have distributed **16,183 food aid packs in over 30 different countries**, including those in Asia, Africa, and the Middle East. The refugees of Syria, Rohingya, and those internally displaced in Yemen and Gaza are not forgotten either.

#### **IFTAR MEALS**

We also strive to provide daily iftar meals to the poor, needy, orphans, widows, and refugees around the world. Since 2017, we have distributed **66,936 meals**. More than 60,000 people in less fortunate circumstances had the luxury of breaking their fast with wholesome meals, among their loved ones.

#### **EID GIFTS**

As an expression of our gratitude to Allah, we have provided Eid gifts to the needy and especially the orphans in Indonesia, Gaza, Sri Lanka, Syria, and more. A total of **2,218 gifts were donated** to beneficiaries in six countries. May the gifts benefit them and bring them happiness on the day of Eid.

#### **ZAKAT MONIES**

Zakat is one of the five pillars of Islam. Muslims whose savings meet or exceed certain values are obliged to give 2.5% of their annual savings to the poor and needy for the welfare of the Muslim community.

In 2016, 50 beneficiaries in Indonesia received alms from the zakat collected and in 2021, **3,285 people** in Indonesia and Gaza received zakat monies.



## SEASONAL PROJECTS

# **QURBAN**

Another special time of the year is the Qurban season. The act of performing Qurban is highly recommended in Islam.

Around the world, more than enough food is produced to feed the global population — but over 811 million people still face hunger every single day.

For many of them, Eidul Adha is one of the few times a year they get to eat meat. Global Ehsan Relief launched its annual Qurban project with the aim of providing aid to these people in need.

In 2020, we launched a special Prophetic Qurban campaign, encouraging people to do an extra Qurban on behalf of the Ummah after fulfilling theirown, as the Prophet (S.A.W.) himself did. The campaign was a success, with many of you welcoming the challenge.

On top of fulfilling Qurbani obligations, we introduce a new bundle - Humanitarian Package. This allows donors to send humanitarian aid together with their fresh Qurban meat donations. These packages were made specially for orphans in Aceh, Indonesia, refugees in Syria, and supplement the COVID-19 Emergency Appeal in India.

Since 2015, **almost a million people have benefited** from Global Ehsan Relief's Qurban projects, thanks to our generous donors!















## **EMERGENCY PROJECTS**

#### **DISASTER RESPONSE**

Natural disasters are a terrifying and traumatizing experience for the victims caught in them. In the worst cases, people lose their entire home and belongings, leaving them stranded and uncertain of where and how to start rebuilding. On top of that, food, water and medicine, which are the most urgent needs, become scarce. We make it a priority to respond to disasters promptly and help the victims on the long path to recovery.

So far, we have provided aid to Palu, Banten, and Lombok in Indonesia, which were all devastated by earthquakes and tsunamis. We collected funds for food aid sets, drinking water, medicine, and shelters.

#### **ON-GOING EMERGENCY APPEAL**

Conflict, famine, and persecution are very real problems in some countries. Millions of people are affected, often ending up displaced or struggling to survive with extremely limited resources. They receive very little help, especially because many are unaware of the severity of their situation. We have ongoing appeals to raise funds for Kashmir, Yemen, and the Rohingya people.

These people are on the brink of starvation, stranded without a home, and in desperate need of food, medical aid, water and shelter. As of now, we have distributed **800 Food Aid Sets, 500 Winter Kits and 20 Water Trucks**. We strive to raise awareness about the severe conditions these people face, and will continue to provide aid supplies for them in the hope that their struggle will be eased, and one day end completely.

# COMMUNITY **INVOLVEMENT PROGRAM**

Other than implementing projects with our partners, Global Ehsan Relief wishes to bring dedicated individuals out to have first-hand experience in providing humanitarian aid.

To date, a total of 7 CIPs have been carried out, namely in Yogyakarta and Aceh (Indonesia), Jordan, Bangladesh, and Turkey, with 10 participants each time.

With an average of 7 days per trip, many activities were completed including packing and distributing food aid sets, mosque/home refurbishment, teaching English, spending time with orphans and elderly, and others.

Participants have said it to be a humbling experience to serve the poor, needy, orphans and widows in various countries.

What made it more special was their efforts to fundraise themselves before departing to deliver others' contributions.

# HIGHLIGHTS MATERNITY WING

# MLALO LUSHOTO DISTRICT HOSPITAL TANZANIA

Mlalo Health Centre is situated at the center of the Lushoto District and due to its geographical position, it serves as many as 50,000 people in the district, as well as nearby districts.

Lushoto District lies in the North-Eastern point of Tanga-Tanzania and is one of the poorer areas of Tanzania and is among the top three districts with high HIV/AIDS prevalence, maternal and early child death rate.

Furthermore, Tanzania is considered to be one of the world's poorest countries, ranking 151 out of 188 on the Human Development Index in 2017. Before its construction, the nearest referral hospital was a 3 to 4 hours drive off road, constituting a life threatening situation to expecting mothers.

The construction of the Mlalo Maternity Ward aims to provide a facility for local mothers to deliver their babies, with modern necessary and emergency equipment available to reduce the maternal and reproductive problems in Mlalo Community.

With the help of Global Ehsan Relief, the Mlalo Health Centre Maternity Ward was completed in 2020. An average of 45 women and children will get free services everyday, and annually 16,500 men and children will benefit and get life-saving treatment and care from the project.





# HIGHLIGHTS IBNU SINA INTEGRATED BOARDING SCHOOL

Traditional orphanages do not equip orphans with in-demand skills. After the age of 18, many orphans have no idea how to be self-sufficient.

With the integrated boarding school, we are able to provide the orphans with a better home, academic studies with national certificates, Tahfiz programs, and in-demand skills.

#### **ORPHAN STORY**

Soleh was scared and worried he could no continue his education after his father passed away in 2020. His mother became the sole breadwinner of the family. Since then, the family's life has been challenging. Along with his three other siblings, the family of four are living in a wooden, tiny house with no valuable assets.

However, there was a glimmer of hope for the family this year. Thankfully since July 2021, Soleh has managed to continue his studies at Ma'had Ibnu Sina Global Ehsan Relief, after passing the basic exam held by the school in June.

"Alhamdulillah, I was told by the headmaster in my elementary school that Mahad ISGER will be giving a free education for orphans. My mom was over the moon when I passed the exam. It meant the world to us. Thank you donors for your support."

The sponsorship allows Soleh to have a paid education at the school, on top of giving him access to quality education, a place to stay, nutritious food and a sense of security that children like him need. By getting proper education, it is hoped that Soleh will be able to change the plight and condition of his family in the near future.


