## **Orphans Sponsorship**

These orphans are schooled in an Islamic based institute. Tahfiz is part of their curriculum, aside from learning the basic subjects such as English, Mathematics, and their native language.

The orphans that we are sponsoring are from different maahad, thus while some orphans attend a regular school with Tahfiz being the extra curriculum, some orphans stay in an Islamic boarding school, spending most of their adolescence there.

As of 2019, we have sponsored more than 310 Tahfiz and Non-tahfiz orphans; 190 of which are Tahfiz while 120 are Non-tahfiz.

Apart from education, your contributions have benefitted them by providing food, clothing and shelter. **Our target in 2020 is to sponsor 500 orphans.** 







# CARE FOR HUNGER



### **Food Aid Distribution**

1,355 beneficiaries benefited from the distribution of Food Aid Sets. In Cambodia, 14 families also received women prayer garment sets along with Food Aid Sets to provide them with assistance after a fire incident.

## Food Bank (Gerobak Rezki)

A project whereby cooked food is packed in meal boxes, and distributed to orphans and children from low-income families for lunch or dinner, in various locations such as orphanages, mosques, maahads or villages.

In October, our Indonesia team carried out Food Bank at Penyantun Islam Orphanage, providing cooked meals to **65 children**. They had another session in November to help provide meals to **60 children** from Dayah Raudhatul Qur'an. In December, the team visited Desa Lhoong Aceh Besar to provide **54 children** with cooked meals.



### **Food Car**

GER Indonesia came up with a brilliant idea - converting a car and making it equipped to pack, deliver and serve food.

In October, they served a variety of food to 100 orphans from Media Kasih Orphanage, Seutui, Banda Aceh.



### Meals On Wheels

We bring together the community in this weekend project where volunteers will pack and deliver a complete set meal to recipients - the elderly and disabled.

In November, 250 families benefited from the 500 packs of cooked meals.



### #JomFeedBack

This project allows the public to contribute food items or donate \$50 worth of Food Hampers.

These hampers are distributed to the needy families. In December, our Singapore team helped distribute to 50 families living in rental estates in Yishun.

# **CARE FOR EDUCATION**







100 sets of school supplies were distributed to the poor students and orphans in rural areas. This project was supported by Shawal Group Australia.

The distribution was done in Angkor Kroch village, Takeo Province, Cambodia. The set includes stationery, books and more.

As part of Singapore's projects, Back To School is conducted annually in December before school starts. The team implemented this project in hopes of lightening parents' burdens in sustaining their children's education.

In conjunction with our #JomFeedBack program, we distributed 50 School Sets to children at Yishun estate. With the donations collected, we purchased sets of school essentials such as a school bag, writing materials, notebooks, colouring materials and a water bottle.



# **GLOBAL WAKAF PROJECTS**



Recently, our team discovered that most of the schools in Aceh with visually impaired students were sharing only 1 Braille Qur'an to teach all the students. As such, our team in Indonesia helped to distribute 66 Braille Our'ans at those schools in Aceh.

51 Braille Qur'ans were distributed in 5 different schools in Aceh Utara, Pidie, Pidie Jaya, Bireun and Aceh Timur, with another 50 being distributed to the most needy students in Jamboo Aye.

The community around the masjid was also provided with 50 sets of Qur'an as it is not otherwise accessible.

If you have been to the rural parts of Cambodia and Sri Lanka, you will know how difficult it is to get clean water. Thank you for bringing a huge relief to these people.

From your support and contributions, water wells and ablution places were completed there recently, easing the hardship for dozens of families.

A small mosque, **Riyadushalihin Mosque** has been built in O-Ampil village, Santok district, Kompong Thom province, Cambodia. It can accommodate about 50 people.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> mosque, **Hajjah Jorah Mosque**, was constructed in Fenusi Village, Tanga, Tanzania - which can accommodate around 150-200 people.

It is the perfect gift if you have made wakaf on behalf of your loved ones or deceased parents. You will get endless rewards and du'as from the beneficiaries.


#### Gaza

#### Care For Homeless

This project reaches out to the homeless people in Singapore who spend their nights sleeping on the streets, under the void decks, by the staircases and in dark alleys. At least 60 volunteers, both with vehicles and without joined us as we walked the streets of Singapore on a quest to lend a helping hand to the homeless.

We packed and distributed welfare kits island-wide. **100 homeless people** in Singapore benefitted from this project as they received brand new essential kits for their daily use. The items in the welfare kit included a bag, cooked food, bottled water, hygiene kits and more.



## Home Aid

How blessed we are to have a roof over our heads and a nicely furnished house. Some do not have the financial means to live that way. In Singapore, we managed to refurbish a house together with our volunteers. The beneficiary is a grandfather who lives with his daughter and 1-year old grandchild.

They are from a low-income family living in a rental home. The refurbishment of the house included paint works, cleaning, removal of damaged items and furniture, and replacement and arrangement of new ones.

Other contributions included a month's supply of diapers and milk powder, a refrigerator, and a washing machine.

# **MISSION TRIPS**













### Bangladesh (Rohingya Refugees)

Global Ehsan Relief Singapore, together with our partners from Islamic Help organised a 7- day Community Involvement Programme (CIP) to Cox Bazaar, Bangladesh, to encourage fellow Singaporeans to volunteer abroad and have the opportunity to reach out to the Rohingya Refugees in Bangladesh through different projects and activities.

9 participants from Singapore raised funds and joined the distribution of water, food aid packs, winter & hygiene kits, school bags, preparation of cooked meals, and also building shelters.

#### Turkey (Syrian Refugees)

Global Ehsan Relief Singapore with the help of our partners at Hayrat Foundation, organised a 7- day Community Involvement Programme (CIP) in Sanliurfa, Turkey, in December.

We provided aid to the Syrian refugees in Turkey in preparation for the Winter season.

3 volunteers from Singapore and 2 volunteers from Malaysia joined us on this mission to help these refugees.
