CORE PROJECTS Care For Orphans

Orphans are at the heart of what we do at Global Ehsan Relief. Orphaned children, especially in lower-income communities, are vulnerable to many issues such as hunger and poverty.

Our sponsorship program is a vital lifeline for these children, providing them with food, clothing, and most importantly education. To date, we have sponsored 1242 orphans in Asia and Africa, ensuring that they have the opportunity to flourish as they grow.

In January, we also brought 25 Palestinian orphans on a special trip to Makkah and Madinah. This annual Umrah for Orphans program aims to give children in need a once-in-a-lifetime chance to perform Umrah and visit the holy mosques.

CORE PROJECTSCare For Hunger

Every day, more than 800 million people worldwide go to bed hungry. Conflict, climate change, and COVID-19 have all wreaked havoc on the poorest areas of the world, causing world hunger to rise dramatically.

As part of our work at Global Ehsan Relief, we distribute food aid packs and cooked meals to needy communities around the world, giving them a respite from endless days of hunger. To date, we have distributed food aid packs and cooked meals to 1000 beneficiaries in rural Myanmar.

CORE PROJECTSCare For Clean Water

Clean water is a basic human right, and essential to life. Yet millions of people, including children, still die every year from waterborne diseases - all because they don't have a source of clean drinking water.

One of our core missions is to provide these vulnerable communities with a sustainable source of clean drinking water that can last for years. Since 2015, our donors have helped us build more than 4000 water wells, ablution places, and community wells, with 189 new ones added in the first quarter of this year.

GLOBAL WAQF PROJECT Build A Mosque

Waqf is a form of sadaqah jariyah - an ongoing charity that benefits the recipient for years to come, and ensures endless rewards for the donor. Examples of waqf include donating land to be used for the community, or building a school or mosque.

In the first quarter of 2023, we built three new mosques in rural Cambodia and Pakistan, giving the Muslim community there a place to worship together.

GLOBAL WAQF PROJECT Qur'an Distribution

In the blessed month of Ramadhan, our offices distributed 2,400 Qur'an sets to underprivileged Muslims who would otherwise never have the opportunity to read the words of Allah S.W.T. For instance in Cambodia, 200 Qur'an sets were distributed to students in Abubakar Islamic High School, with the hopes of enriching their religious education. The school is located in the Kampong Chhnang province and is an estimated 50 kilometers from Phnom Penh City. The school has around 200 students currently studying there.

Our Waqf Qur'an sets have also benefitted the communities in Indonesia. For orphaned children in Biara Timu Village, North Aceh, these orphans are studying the Qur'an without having proper Qur'an sets. The villagers there are unable to afford new Qur'an books however the limited resources does not decrease the interest and spirit of the children in learning the Qur'an.

Alhamdulillah with our Waqf Qur'an sets, these orphaned children and students are able to study and learn with ease.


GLOBAL EMERGENCY RESPONSE

Earthquake Appeal

Part of GER's work is responding to crises and emergencies around the globe by providing immediate assistance to help victims cope with the aftermath of the disasters. In the early hours of 6 February, a magnitude 7.8 earthquake struck Turkiye and Syria, destroying buildings and killing more than 59,000 people. Thousands more were left injured and stranded in the harsh winter cold.

We worked with partners on the ground to supply emergency aid in 3 phases to the survivors, helping them through the long process of recovery and rebuilding. In the immediate aftermath, we distributed urgent needs such as hot meals, winter clothes, blankets, and shelters to protect them from the harsh winter. Our second phase included more items needed to sustain the survivors as rebuilding efforts continued. We gave out out hot meals, winter clothing, blankets, and other essentials during the first phase of distributions.







GLOBAL EMERGENCY RESPONSE

Flood Relief

Monsoon season took a toll on Johor, Malaysia this year, with huge floods displacing more than 40,000 people. The survivors were left without access to food or shelter. We raised funds to supply them with the most urgent needs in the aftermath; food aid packs, hygiene kits, and baby needs such as diapers and milk.

Our Global Ehsan Relief Malaysia team went on the ground to provide urgent relief to affected flood victims at Parit Haji Abdul Rahman, Batu Pahat. As many as 200 Blankets, 110 Food Aid Packs and Hygiene Kits as well as 61 milk formulas for children were distributed.

The items had provided tremendous relief to the victims who had suffered so much in a short span of time.

MISSION TRIPS

UMRAH FOR ORPHANS

In January, we brought 25 of our sponsored orphans from Jerusalem on a special trip to Makkah and Madinah. For these children, the thought of performing Umrah has only ever been a dream that could never come true. Our annual Umrah for Orphans program aims to make that dream a reality for these orphans who have been through so much. It is our hope that this Umrah trip will not only be a life-changing experience for them, but also give them a chance to heal from their trauma and deepen their connection to Allah S.W.T.

TÜRKIYE & SYRIA EARTHQUAKE EMERGENCY APPEAL - 2ND PHASE

In late February, we sent out a team to meet our partners on the ground in Türkiye and Syria for our second phase of distributions. The survivors of the devastating magnitude 7.8 earthquake that struck earlier that month were still in desperate need of essential supplies as they recovered.

With such widespread destruction, rebuilding efforts would take time to complete. With that in mind, we raised funds for long-term aid that would sustain the survivors as they toughed out the recovery process. Our teams not only distributed cooked meals, but also food aid packs to last a month. We also provided shelter kits, coal burners, and winter clothes to help the survivors brave the harsh winter cold. More than 25,000 people benefited from this second phase of aid.

RAMADHAN DEPLOYMENT (BANDUNG & ACEH)

During the blessed month of Ramadhan, we sent out a team to Aceh, Indonesia for a round of distributions over the course of a few days. They visited a school for visually impaired students to give out 250 Quran Braille sets, as well as a learning center where they distributed 200 sets of Quran. For these students, being able to read and learn the words of Allah S.W.T. is a gift beyond compare. The team also had the opportunity to meet some of our sponsored orphans for a special Iftar meal together. They gave out goodie bags for the children to enjoy, as well as monetary aid for their guardians to ease their burdens.

RAMADHAN DEPLOYMENT (TÜRKIYE EARTHQUAKE EMERGENCY APPEAL - 3RD PHASE)

Part of our Ramadhan efforts also included sending aid to the survivors of the devastating Türkiye-Syria earthquake. With the coming of Ramadhan, we deployed teams for our 3rd round of distributions in the affected areas. We gave out much-needed Iftar and Sahur meals and food aid packs to the survivors, ensuring that they would have enough food to sustain themselves throughout the holy month.

More than 20,000 people in Turkiye and Syria benefited from our donors' generosity, and were able to perform their ibadah throughout Ramadhan with less worry. Our partners also helped give out special Eid gifts for more than 500 children in Türkiye and Syria, giving them a spark of joy to celebrate Eid despite their difficult circumstances.

RAMADHAN FOOD AID PACKS

Alhamdulillah, we managed to reach out to more people than ever in Ramadhan this year. The blessed month was filled with activities for all of our offices around the world. At the start of Ramadhan, our offices distributed 1,900 food aid packs across 6 countries, benefiting 9,500 people. The food aid packs contained essential groceries to last the beneficiaries throughout the holy month.

These Food Aid Packs were given to vulnerable families including widows and orphans, the elderly as well as those living in rural communities. For instance during our Ramadhan Food Aid Pack distribution at Pleret, Bantul, Yogyakarta Indonesia, the villagers shared how this had been the first time they received such a Food Aid Pack and were tremendously grateful for it. **More details on our Ramadhan activities can be found in our detailed Ramadhan report.**


SINGAPORE OFFICE

Earlier this year in January, our team of staff from Global Ehsan Relief along with our Palestinian refugee orphans successfully completed their Umrah, and it is indescribable how our team felt while observing their journey. It was truly a special Umrah trip for the orphans, with pure joy and tears filling their faces throughout the journey, making it a meaningful spiritual experience.

For 13-year-old Abdallah, he lives with his grandmother Mdm Maryam, aunts and three other siblings. Abdallah's father passed away four years ago as a result of falling down at a construction site. When Abdallah's youngest brother, Laith was only 7 months old, their mother left the family without any reason and has never contacted them, till this day.

In a heartfelt moment, Abdallah shared how he had intended to perform Umrah for his late father, and cannot wait to see the Kaabah in real life, as well as being excited to see the clock tower as well! He dreams of being a lawyer one day, insyaAllah.

"I want to perform Umrah for my late father. And I'll pray for my late grandfather and also my grandmother," Abdallah shared with us.

We humbly thank you for giving them the gift of a lifetime, an Umrah like no other.





Mdm Fatimah, 62-years-old, is an elderly grandmother who moved from Kampong Cham to the Mondulkiri province, Cambodia. She and her husband take care of her niece, who is an orphan - the couple does not have any children of their own. To earn a living, Mdm Fatimah and her family grow cashew and pepper, where they earn between \$5 USD to \$10 USD each day, depending on the crop yield and the market price.

When our Global Ehsan Relief Cambodia team visited Mdm Fatimah, she shared how the water shortage is a big concern for her family as well as the rest of the villagers living in the Trapaeng P'e Village. For Mdm Fatimah, she had a dug water well at home, however the depth has made it difficult for the family to draw water from the well using a bucket winch. In addition, the water in the well often dries out during the dry season, hence her niece had to draw water from a distant pond instead.

However, the lives of the villages changed for the better with the installation of a Community Water Well by our Global Ehsan Relief Cambodia team.

When we asked how the Community Water Well had impacted her and the people in her village, Mdm Fatimah said: "Now that we have access to clean water through a Community Water Well right next to our home, we can save precious time. We no longer have to carry water from the dug well or spend our time and energy collecting water from far, distant sources. We can now use the time to cultivate crops and keep livestock in any season, without worrying about running out of water."

"I am pleased that there is a Community Water Well so near to my home. It is quite simple to use and I can get water for my everyday needs just by turning on the faucet. To the donors, may Allah S.W.T extend your life and bless you and your family," Mdm Fatimah prayed.



This is Hamidah, a widowed mother with three daughters. The family used to live in Jindires, Syria. However the house was heavily damaged, forcing the family to move out. Hamidah had nowhere to go but to live with her relatives who are in the camp. Currently, she is staying with the said relative. She added that even her relatives' life situation is bad so she and her family's presence are just a burden for her relatives. Because they did not get to take anything from their house to flee from the earthquake, they basically own nothing. She is very grateful to all who have sent the aid and donations and stresses that she really needs a shelter of their own to stay with her daughters.
