Our Orphan Sponsorship program allows orphans to grow in a safe place and attain as much knowledge possible to be a successful individual in the near future.

To date, we have a total of 617 orphan sponsored under our care.

- 385 Hifz Orphans
- 232 Non-Hifz Orphans

Our orphans are from Aceh, Cambodia, Bangladesh, India, Gaza, Palestine, Senegal, Gambia and Sri Lanka.

Sponsorships will enable each orphan to receive good healthcare support, nutritious meals, quality education and a loving home.

Hifz orphans will get special hifz Quran classes that are led by experienced Qur'an teachers.

Soon, Global Ehsan Relief will embark a program to sponsor more orphans from Rohingya, Syria and Yemen, insyaAllah.

1. MOSQUE CONSTRUCTION

3 mosques were recently completed during this period. One is located in Tanzania (Ar-Rahmah Mosque) and the remaining two are located in Cambodia (Al-Huda and An-Nur Mosque). These mosques can accommodate at least 200 people each for congregational prayers.

2. MOSQUE REFURBISHMENT

In August, our GER Indonesian team oversaw the completion of our 5th refurbished mosque in Aceh. Masjid Riyadussalihin is located in Matang Jurong village, Aceh Utara. Now, the refurbished mosque has new features, facilities and Quran for the jemaah's use and can accommodate up to 400 people. Previously, the locals had to walk 5km to the nearest mosque to perform their daily and jumaah prayers.







3. COMMUNITY WATER WELLS

GER's newest project will benefit 1,550 people. A total of 31 community water wells were built in Takeo province, Cambodia. Each community water well can benefit 10-15 families or 50 people per well. Lasting up to a decade or more, this new source of clean and safe drinking water will provide for various uses among the community there.





4. WATER WELLS - HANDPUMPS

A total of 167 water handpumps were constructed during this quarter.

97 in Cambodia

35 in Pakistan

35 in Bangladesh.

Each water well can benefit 1-3 families, providing them with clean drinking water for the next 10 years or more. Water changes everything.

5. ABLUTION PLACE

Alhamdulillah, a total of 31 ablution places were built during this period. 16 in Cambodia 15 in Sri Lanka.

Each ablution place is located near a mosque, benefitting approximately 500 people daily for their daily prayers and Quran recitations.







6. WAQAF QUR'AN

In August 2020, 375 of the Holy Qur'an were distributed in Aceh, Indonesia. The distribution was held at 12 different locations in TPA (Taman Pendidikan Alquran), TPA Sabilunnajah, Taqarrub Mosque, Pesantren Darul Huffadz, TPA Al Akbar, which are in Aceh Tenggara, Indonesia. Each person received their own mushaf or copy or the Qur'an. They were distributed to the poorest community and students at various mosques, Islamic boarding schools and Quranic centres.

7. WAQAF QURAN BRAILLE DIGITAL

35 units of Digital Qur'an Braille were distributed to a special school for the disabled in August. In September 2020, another 68 units were distributed to the visually impaired. This distribution was held in Bandung, West Java. 59 units were given out to the students in SLBN A Pajajaran Bandung, a special school for people with disabilities, and another 9 to individuals with disabilities. Total, 103 sets were distributed during this period.

Ehsan Maternity Ward Mlalo, Tanga, Tanzania

Meanwhile, in northeastern Tanzania in the remote village of Tanga - the construction of the Mlalo Health Centre maternity ward was completed. The population in Lushoto are among the poorest in Africa - with 80% of them living on less than \$50 a month. This means they are unable to seek medical attention as and when they require. And due to insufficient funding, construction of the maternity ward was ceased. Over the years, these factors resulted in high mortality rates for women and children.

Alhamdulillah, thanks to your donations, the ward managed to be completed! The ward can now serve 45 patients a day. This totals up to 16,200 patients a year who can receive the care and treatment they need for free. It is our hope that this maternity ward will benefit generations of mothers and children to come.

1. YEMEN

Yemen is facing one of the worst humanitarian crisis with 23 million of the population facing famine and hunger. What GER has done to provide aid and assistance in this period:

- 350 food aid sets were distributed in Almudhaffar District, Alnoor neighbourhood.
- Another 200 food aid packs were distributed in South of Taiz City in Meshrakh district.
- 400 sets of baby milk and children's food were distributed in Al Mesrakh District, Taiz.
- 200 families in Taiz received hygiene kits.
- 10,000 liters of water is supplied daily, for 1 year at an IDP camp.

2. LEBANON

On the 4th of August 2020, the city of Beirut in Lebanon was devastated by a massive explosion that occurred at the Port of Beirut. The blast had caused massive destruction to nearby areas, destroying homes, leaving at least 6,500 injured, and 204 dead. The first round of aid to Lebanon was the distribution of 1,000 Emergency Packs. Items include bread, food, water, cutlery and hygiene kits.

It was held at Karantina area, Ashrafiyeh, Mar Mkhayel and Speers in Lebanon, which are all near the harbour. The second round of aid was the distribution of 500 meals per day for five days which occurred in the Karantina area in Beirut.









3. GAZA

GER continues to help the impoverished population of Gaza facing a severe blockade.

- 300 freshly baked bread for 300 families.
- 300 monthly food aid sets were distributed to the most needy families in Gaza City.
- 200 families also received a grocery baskets containing vegetable, poultry and dairy products.
- 300 families have received hygiene kits helping them cope with Covid 19 outbreak.
- 100 families were equipped with a 500 litre water tank, and monthly top-up of 1,000 liters of water for one year.

4. PAKISTAN

In early September 2020, monsoon floods inundated Pakistan's cities. It is said that this year, Pakistan has seen the most intense monsoon rain in years, washing away homes and contaminating clean water. This made it difficult for families to even prepare a meal for themselves. Alhamdulillah, a total of 1,000 hot meals for and 500 sets of clothes were distributed in Karachi, Pakistan. These were mainly for those affected and had their homes and belongings destroyed.





5. BANGLADESH

Bangladesh, too, has been hit by a critical situation since June 2020, as monsoon floods follow a super-cyclone. More than 9 million people were affected. On top of poverty and COVID-19, the flood made conditions worse in Bangladesh. With the help of our partners on the ground, 400 food aid packs were distributed in Nilphamari District, Dimla Village. Each food aid pack can last a family of 5-7 for a month. It consists of rice, cooking oil, vegetables, condiments and other basic essentials.





6. SYRIA

50 concrete shelters were built and completed for the Syrian refugees in Idlib. Each shelter can accommodate a family of 5-7 people and would greatly help them with the harsh winter months coming ahead.

1. QURBAN

This year's Qurban programme was our largest ever, alhamdulillah. A total of 4,295 animals were sacrificed and their meat distributed to poor Muslims families in 33 different countries across Asia, Africa, Middle East, and the Balkans.

290,150 beneficiaries benefitted from your generosity. Thanks to you, the blessings of Eid reached the poor, the orphaned and the displaced. For many of them, it was the first time that they were able to enjoy meat this year!

2. EID MEALS

We also provided Eid meals to celebrate the festivities. 300 orphaned families in Gaza City received meals to share among themselves. 800 meals were also provided during iftar on the Day of Arafah, to break their fast with nutritious meals.

In Cox's Bazar, Bangladesh, 10,000 biryani meals were distributed over three days of Eid for the Rohingya refugees, particularly the widows and orphans. Our team in Singapore was also busy during the morning of Eid, distributing 894 meals to the less fortunate, the elderly, and migrant workers living in quarantined dormitories.

3. EID GIFTS

Your contributions also made children in Gaza happy! 100 orphaned children celebrated Eid with smiles and laughter upon choosing and receiving their brand new toys to play with. Your donations of meals and gifts have made their Eid a joyful one.

1. FOOD AID

50 emergency food aid sets were distributed in Tropeng Ropov village, Tek Chhou district, Kampot province after a storm had affected their homes and they found themselves struggling to find food.

200 food aid sets were distributed to rural villages in Aceh, Indonesia including those in Aceh Jaya, Aceh Barat, Subussalam, and Singkil. This food assistance allowed a family of 5-6 to have food to eat for at least a month.

Malaysian residents have been facing a prolonged lockdown that has affected their livelihood.

GER Malaysia has distributed 104 food aid sets for beneficiaries in Johor Bahru, as well as those in rural areas of Sabah and Sarawak.

Meanwhile, 50 food hampers were provided for low-income households who are currently facing food insecurity.







2. MEALS

On top of food aid sets, hot meals were also distributed to the most needy and hungry in our **Share A Meal** program.

440 meals were distributed in Indonesia, mainly to orphans and poor families including those in Matang Jurong village in Aceh Utara, and Manyak Payet village, among others.

These meals were distributed as part of their Food Car programme as well as their Arisan Akhirat Gerobak Rezeki project - a monthly donation programme where donors can contribute meals to the poorest communities in Indonesia.

The Share A Meal project in Singapore also saw the distribution of 100 biryani meals to less fortunate families. The beneficiaries live in one and two-room rental flats in Toa Payoh, many of whom are elderly people who rely on others to bring them food.

1. CARE FOR THE DISABLED

In August, 3 wheelchairs were provided to 3 beneficiaries who have difficulty walking. 2 wheelchairs were provided for recently diagnosed cancer patients.

2. EHSAN HARDSHIP FUND

During this quarter, 6 families received aid from this fund. Each family received a \$200 cash handout as well as a groceries voucher worth \$50. This one-time financial assistance hope to ease their financial burdens.

3. EHSAN BABY CARE

GER SG provides one care package for one baby which includes diapers and baby milk powder. From July to September, 42 babies received this care package.









4. CARE FOR THE ELDERLY

13 elderly persons received a care package in July through September. The care package includes elderly diapers, groceries, and supermarket vouchers.

5. CARE FOR SINGLE MOTHERS

We provide aid for 5 single mothers, with a groceries hamper consisting of pantry items as well as fresh ingredients for cooking. On top of that, they also receive a \$100 cash handout.

6. HOME AID

This Home Aid project aims to refurbish the homes of beneficiaries whose homes are in a state of disrepair. In September, 1 home was successfully refurbished due to the efforts of the GER SG team and volunteers.

KINDNESS DAY

Our Singapore team distributed 970 ice creams in July to September. The Kindness Day event in August was a collaborative effort between GER SG and MIJ Special Education Hub, a school for individuals with special needs.

The students made 150 chocolate hearts themselves that were then distributed along with the ice cream. Meanwhile. our Malaysia team distributed 300 ice creams in Mydin Mutiara Rini Mall in Johor Bahru - spreading joy and smiles to anyone who crosses their paths.

PRAYER TOOLS

During the official reopening of Riyadussalihin Mosque, GER ID also distributed 100 sets of male and female praying tools. 50 sarongs and 50 telekongs can now be utilised by the congregants of the mosque. 3 rolls of praying mats were also donated to the mosque so that they may perform their prayers in ease and comfort.
