This year, 1246 orphaned children were given a chance at a brighter future thanks to our donors' ongoing support.

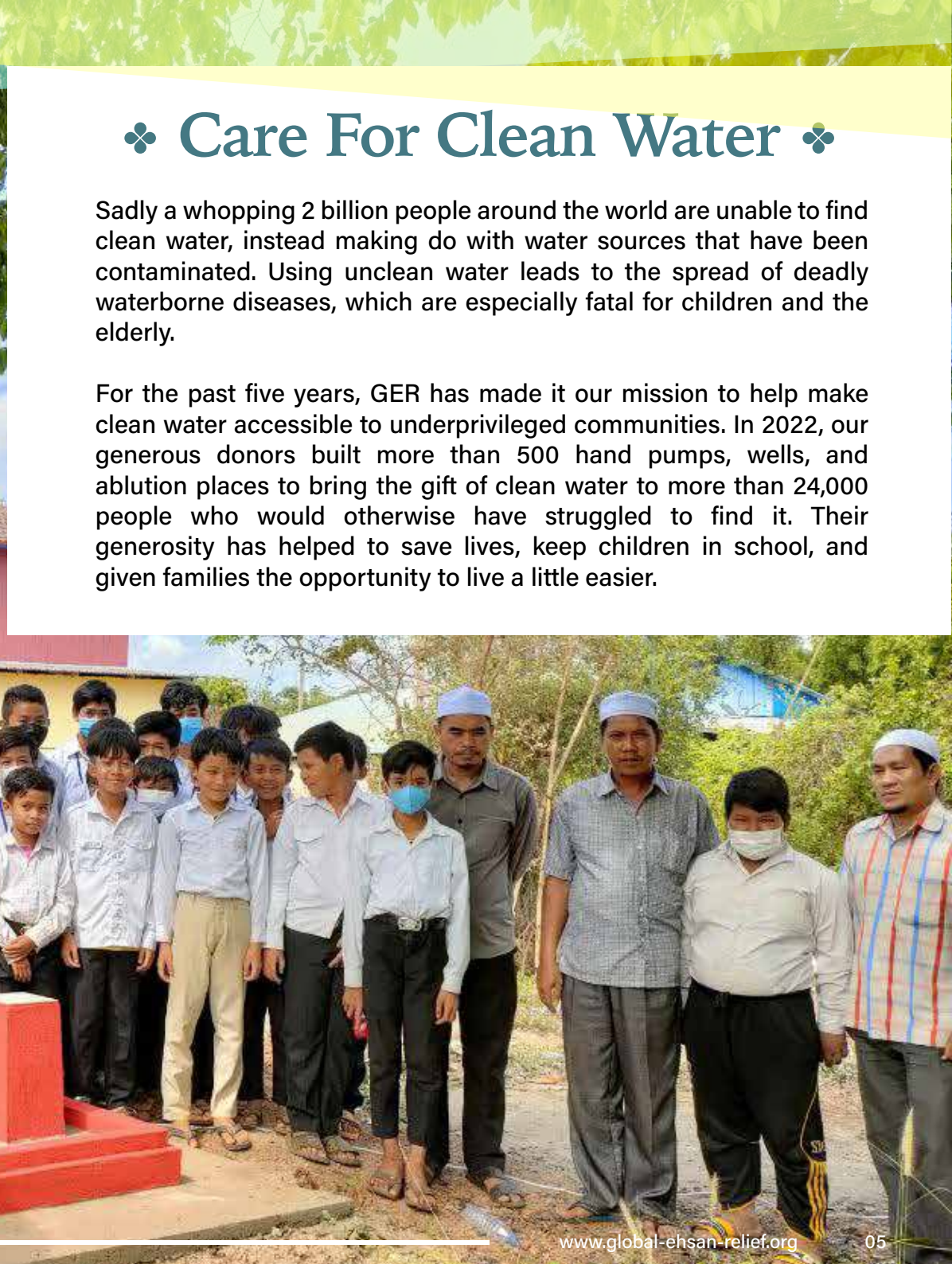

## ❖ Care For Clean Water ❖

Sadly a whopping 2 billion people around the world are unable to find clean water, instead making do with water sources that have been contaminated. Using unclean water leads to the spread of deadly waterborne diseases, which are especially fatal for children and the elderly.

For the past five years, GER has made it our mission to help make clean water accessible to underprivileged communities. In 2022, our generous donors built more than 500 hand pumps, wells, and ablution places to bring the gift of clean water to more than 24,000 people who would otherwise have struggled to find it. Their generosity has helped to save lives, keep children in school, and given families the opportunity to live a little easier.

## ❖ Global Waqf Projects ❖

The Messenger of Allah said: “When a human being dies, all one’s deeds cease, save three: a Sadaqah Jariyah, knowledge [one leaves behind] from which others benefit, and a righteous child who prays for one” (Muslim).

This year, our generous donors helped build mosques and brought the gift of the Quran to children who otherwise would never have the chance to read it. Their waqf contributions made an impact on thousands of lives and in shaa Allah will bring them endless blessings in the Hereafter.



# BUILD A MOSQUE PROJECT

Mosques are essential for every Muslim community around the world. They serve as places of education, worship, and community.

Sadly, many Muslims simply do not have access to a local mosque. Some rural communities have never had the funds to build one, and the long journey to the nearest mosque is difficult, even impossible for the sick and elderly.

Alhamdulillah over the past three years, we have helped build 40 mosques around the world. In 2022, our donors helped to build 14 more mosques for needy Muslim communities in Asia, Africa, and the Middle East.

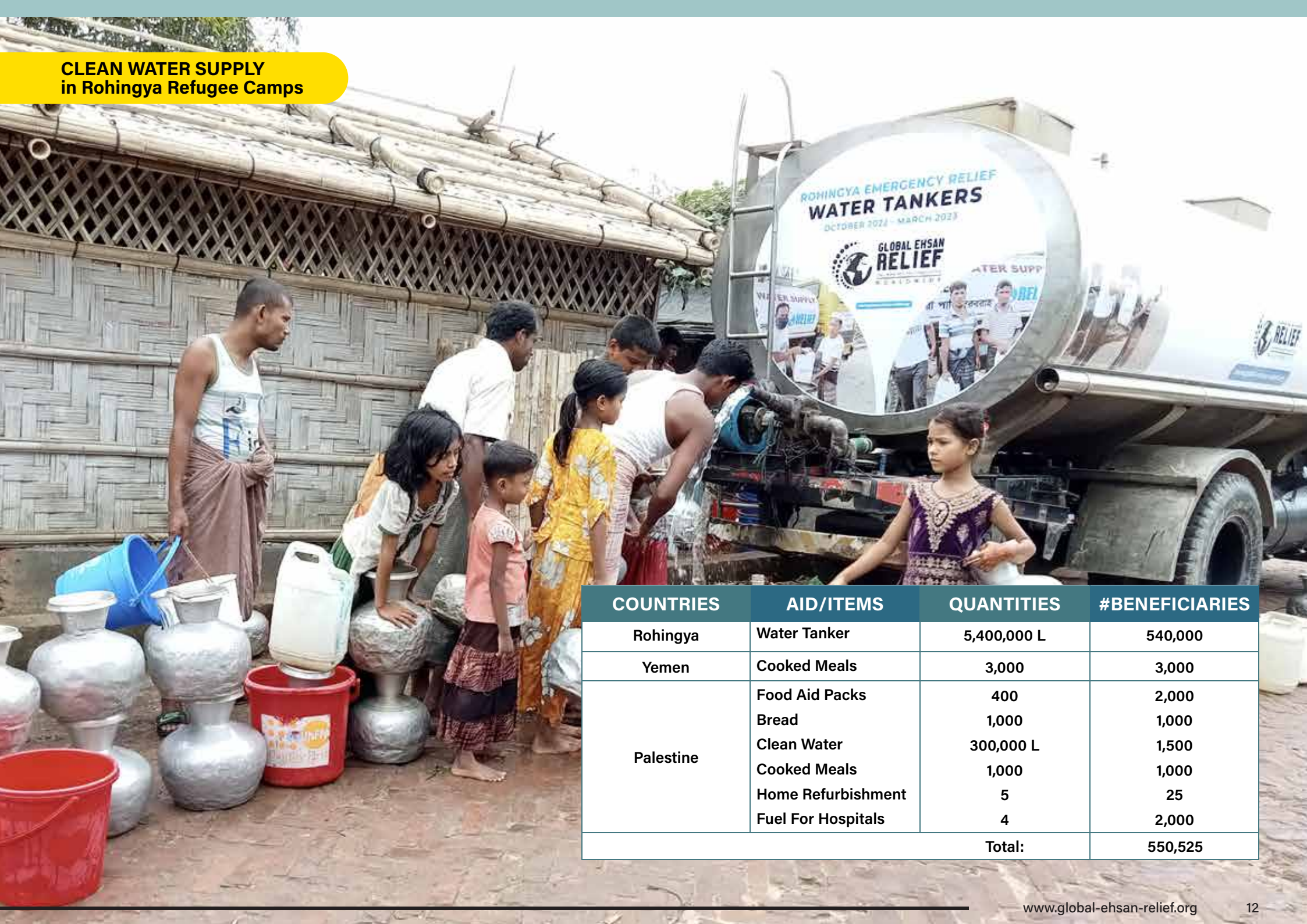


## ❖ Global Emergency Appeal ❖

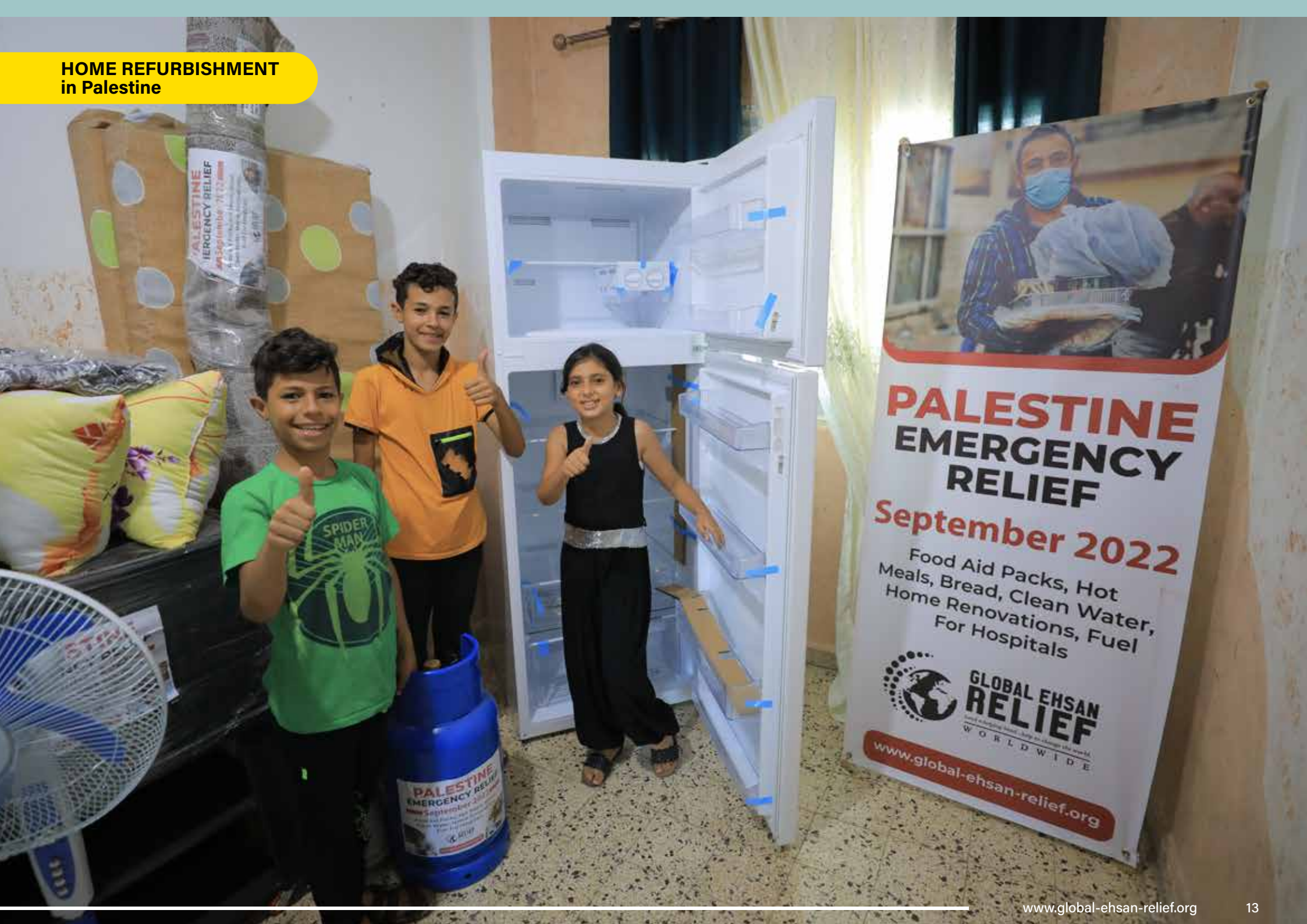

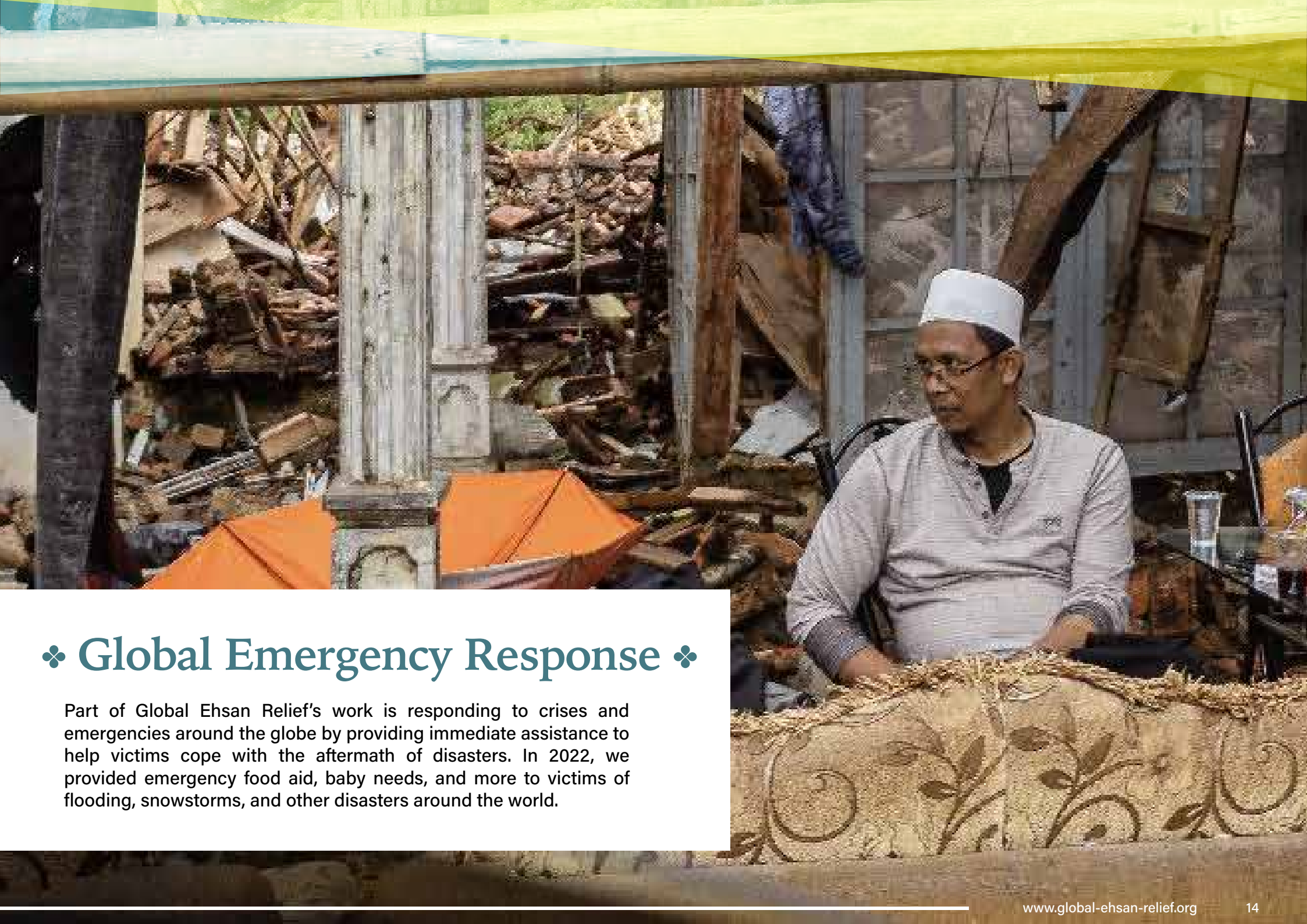

# FLOOD RELIEF IN ASIA

Flooding is a common occurrence in countries like Malaysia and Indonesia. Both countries were ravaged by floods this year, leaving thousands displaced and without access to sustenance. Bangladesh was also affected, with the Rohingya refugees feeling the worst of the effects.

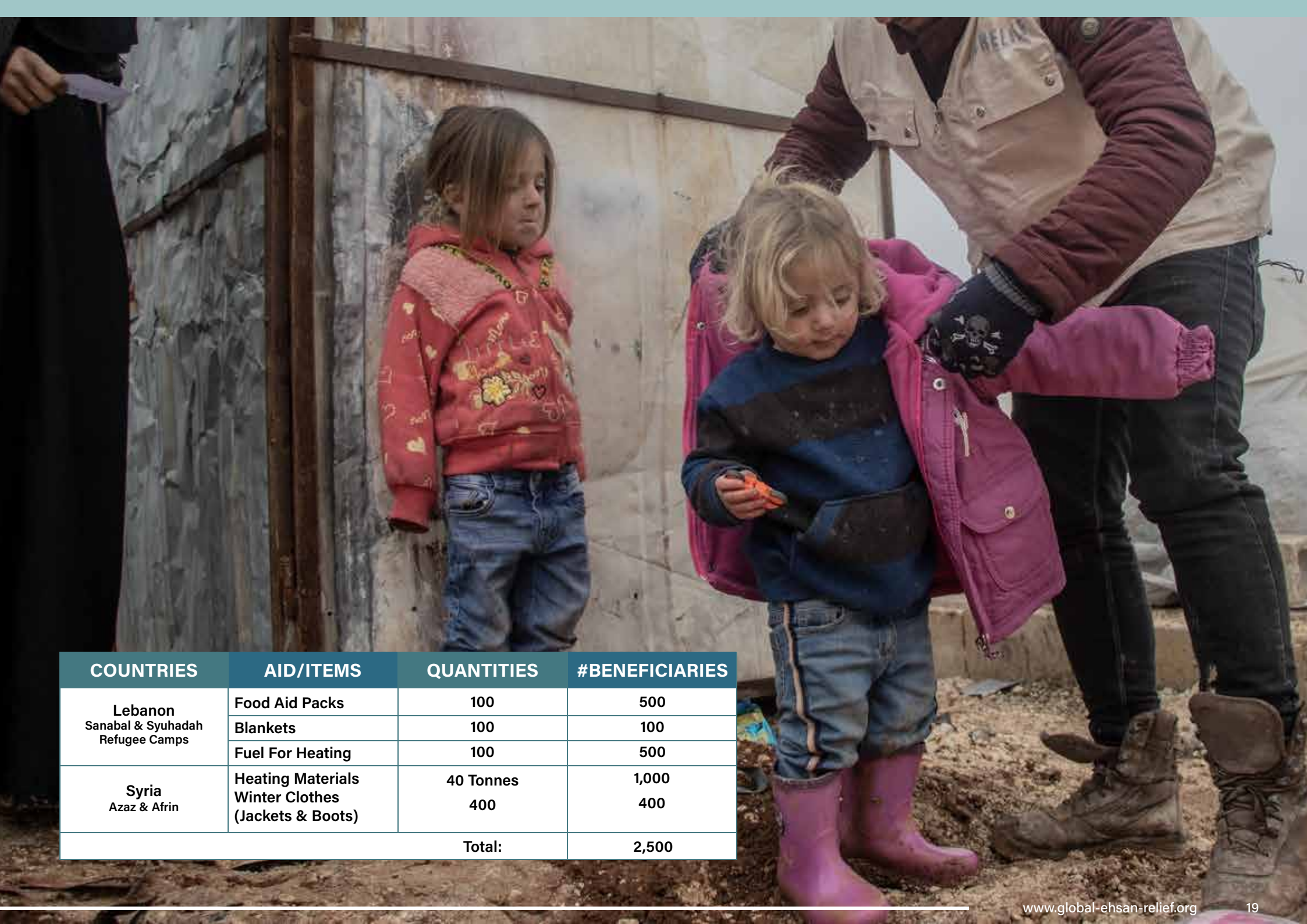

# SRI LANKA

Due to the increasing economic and political turmoil of Sri Lanka, millions of its citizens suffer from food inflation and insecurity, chronic shortages of cooking gas and petrol, power cuts and many other challenges.

With your donations, our team on the ground were able to provide emergency aid in the form of cooked meals, milk powder and essential food aid packs.

For instance in the Kuchchaveli Division, 200 families received food aid packs to last them a month. Our teams then distributed 1,000 hot meals to the villagers in Allai Nagar, Pala Thoppur and Alim Naga. Thanks to your support, these families will have sufficient food in their time of desperate need.

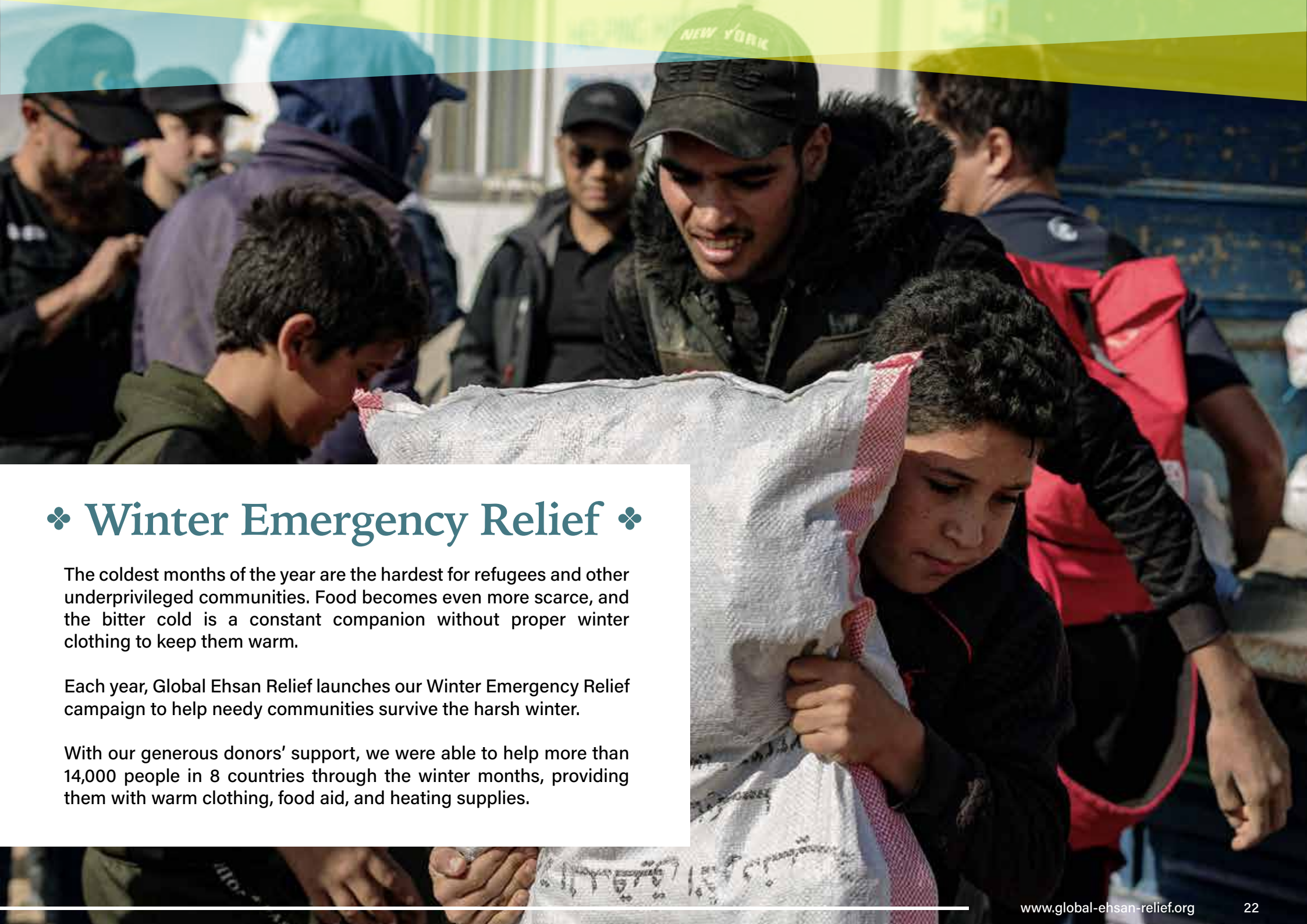
# PAKISTAN

The immediate causes of the floods in Pakistan were heavier than usual monsoon rains and melting glaciers that followed a severe heat wave.

It had severe consequences, including damage to infrastructure and homes, displacement of communities, and loss of life. In response, Global Ehsan Relief carried out distribution in 4 phases - in September and November.

The coldest months of the year are the hardest for refugees and other underprivileged communities. Food becomes even more scarce, and the bitter cold is a constant companion without proper winter clothing to keep them warm.

Each year, Global Ehsan Relief launches our Winter Emergency Relief campaign to help needy communities survive the harsh winter.

With our generous donors' support, we were able to help more than 14,000 people in 8 countries through the winter months, providing them with warm clothing, food aid, and heating supplies.

# CAMBODIA

Our first deployment of the year was to Cambodia in February. Our team from Singapore - including our CEO, Basheer Ahmad - witnessed the opening and handing over of GER's 14th mosque there, distributed food aid packs and praying tools, and carried out our signature Kindness Day programme with sweets, chocolates and ice-cream.

The team also had the pleasure of visiting our third madrasah - Ma'Had Al-Ehsan. It is our first madrasah built as a community, meaning it was built with the support of over 200 donors. Ma'Had Al-Ehsan will provide education to an estimated 70 students in the remote village of Phnom Pi.

Most importantly, they oversaw the planning and implementation of one of our core projects - Care for Clean Water. From the initial planning stages to the digging and use of the water wells, the team saw first hand the urgent need for more sources of water for the remote villages they visited.

## SRI LANKA

In September, three staff members from GER Singapore made a trip to Sri Lanka to oversee the implementation of our “Build a Home for Widows” project.

The aim of the project is to provide better living spaces for impoverished widows and orphaned families. complete with a kitchen, bathroom, and bedrooms.

The team also distributed food aid packs to the poor and needy as well as cooked meals to the congregants of a local mosque.

They also had the opportunity to meet the families that benefited from our Waqf Water Wells and Ablution Place projects that have been ongoing in Sri Lanka.

## PAKISTAN

As part of our Pakistan Emergency Response, 3 of our team members from Singapore were deployed to Sindh Province to oversee the distributions there.

Together with the members of GER Pakistan, they distributed food aid, water, hygiene kits, as well as winter kits to the victims of the devastating floods.

Apart from delivering the aid, they also managed to meet a few of the affected families. Many of them were not only robbed of their homes and belongings, but also left without jobs as the places they worked at had been destroyed.

Alhamdulillah, through our donors’ ongoing generosity, we can ensure they are not forgotten and receive the help they need to rebuild.

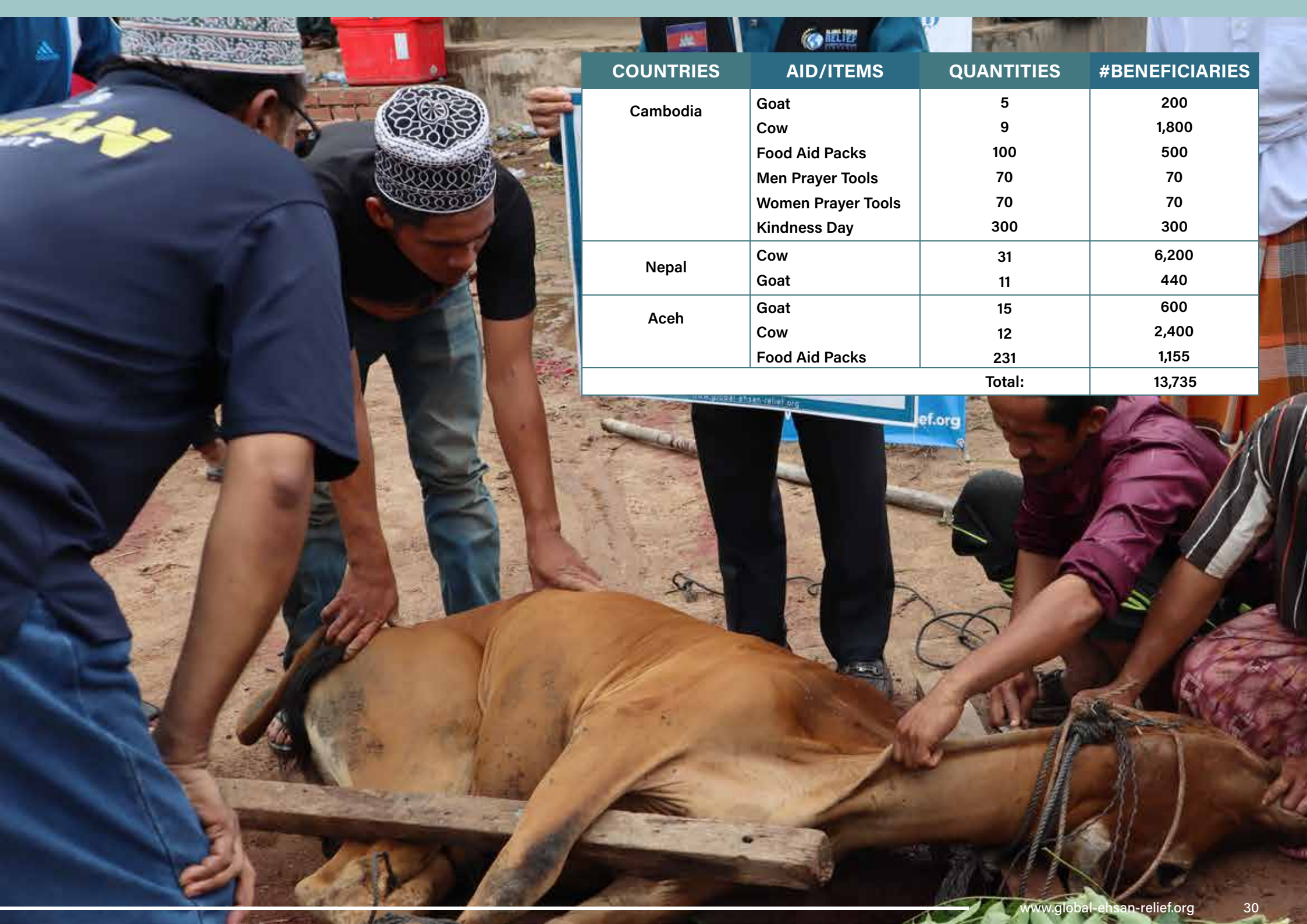


# QURBAN DEPLOYMENT

Alhamdulillah, the trip not only had a hugely positive impact on the staff, but also benefited more than 2000 people in need and created special memories for our beloved orphans.

## JORDAN, LEBANON & TURKEY

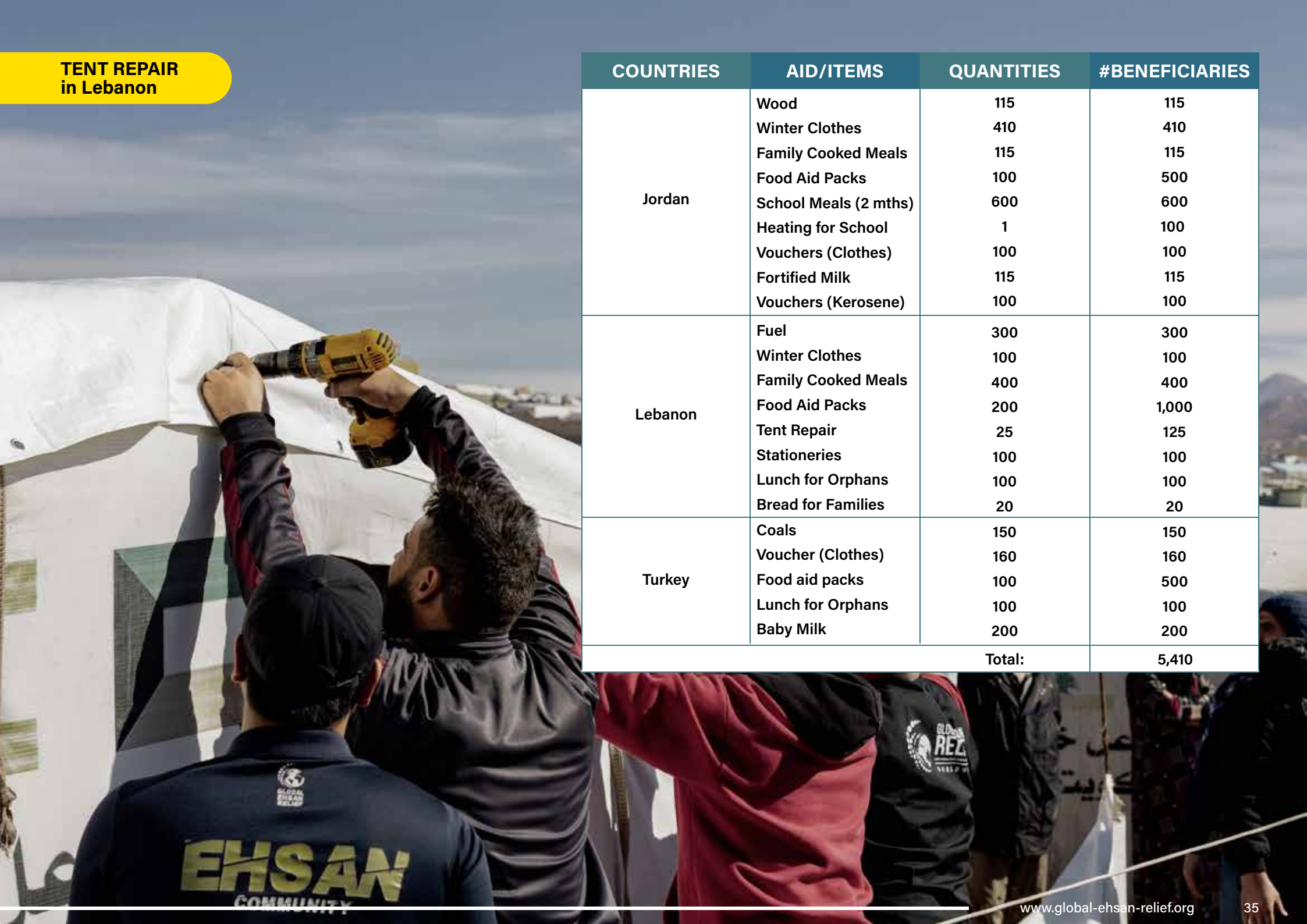

There they had the opportunity to visit refugee camps and meet with the Syrian refugees who have been there for many years. It was an eye opening experience to see just how harsh the conditions in these camps can be, especially during winter.

Throughout the 2-week trip, the team distributed food aid, cooked meals, winter clothes, and heating materials to more than 5000 refugees and people in need, making this winter a warmer and happier one for them.

# QURBAN

Alhamdulillah, our Qurban Relief 2022 was also a huge success - all thanks to our GER community.

With their help, we were able to share the blessings of Eid ul-Adha with more than 289,000 beneficiaries in 35 countries worldwide, all across Asia, the Middle East and Africa.

Part of our efforts included Qurban Packages that allowed donors to give food aid on top of their Qurban contributions to the beneficiaries. We especially focused on providing these Qurban aid packages to orphan families and refugees.

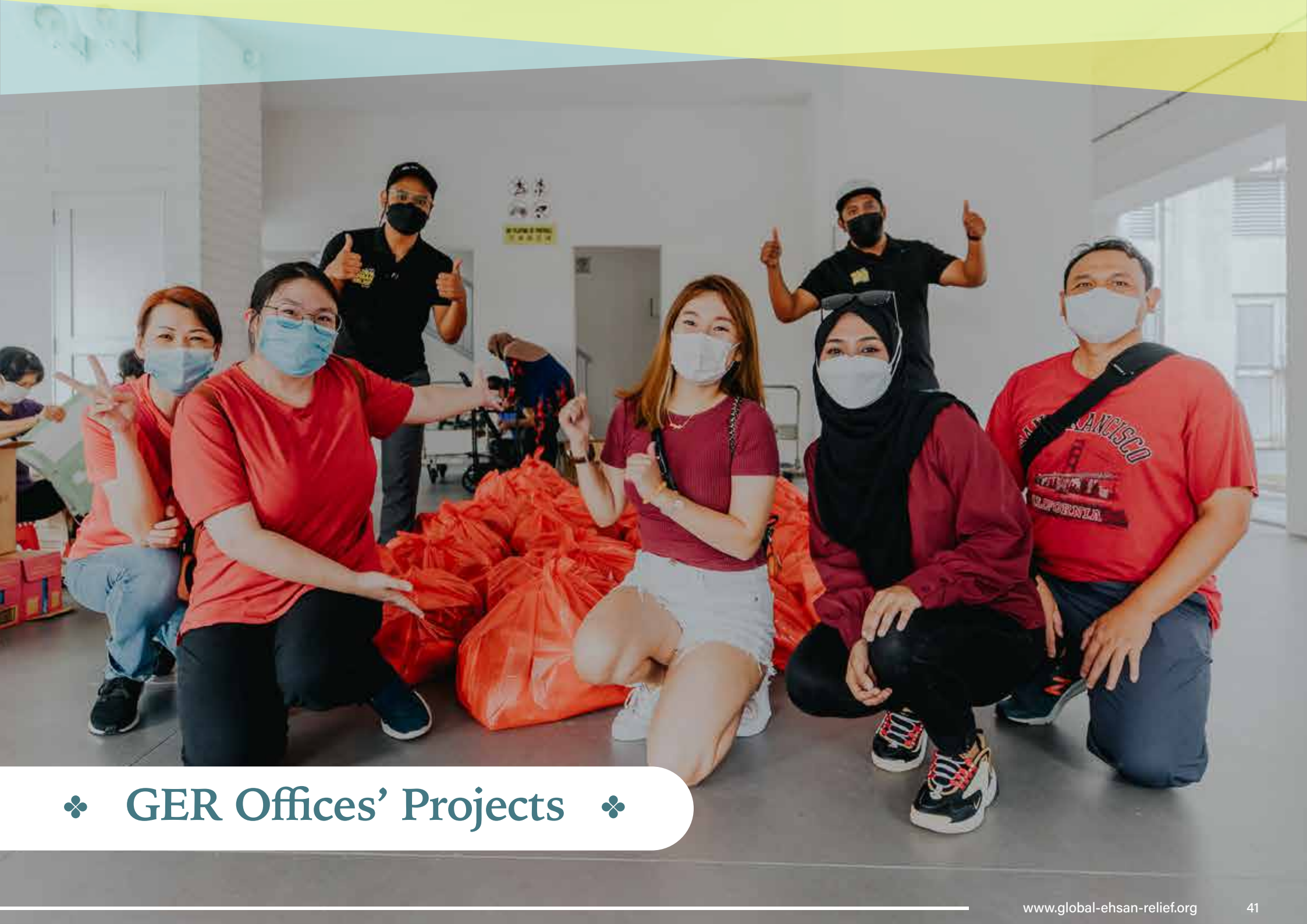

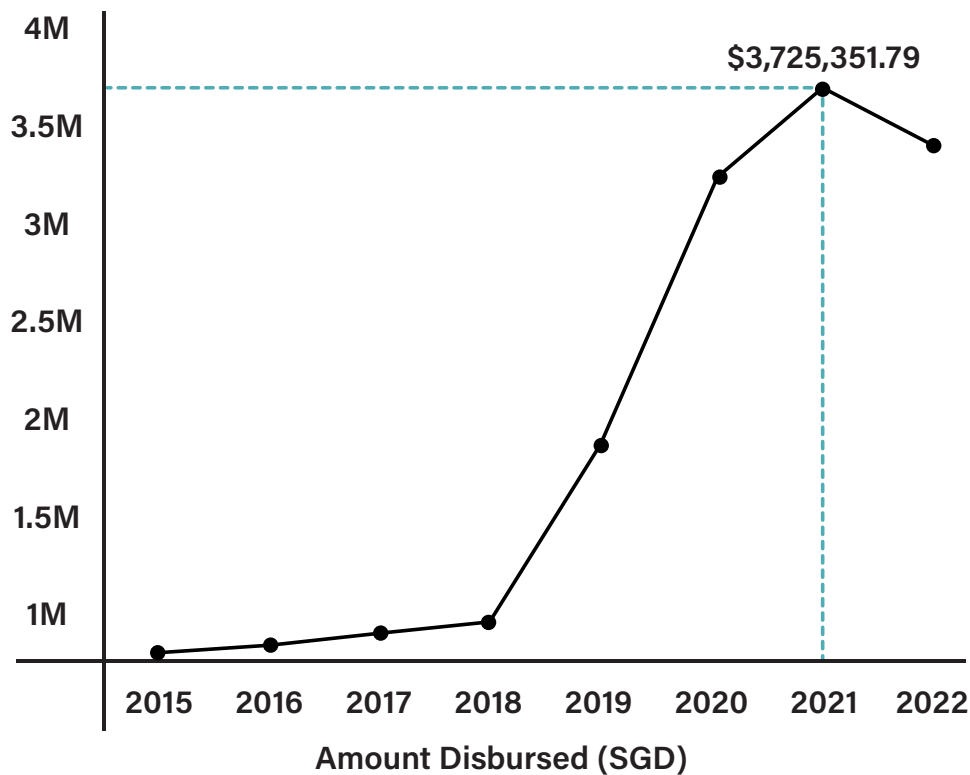

GER are incredibly grateful for the generosity of our donors. It allows us to serve humanity in a variety of ways, from providing essential services to those in need, to funding our young generation's education.

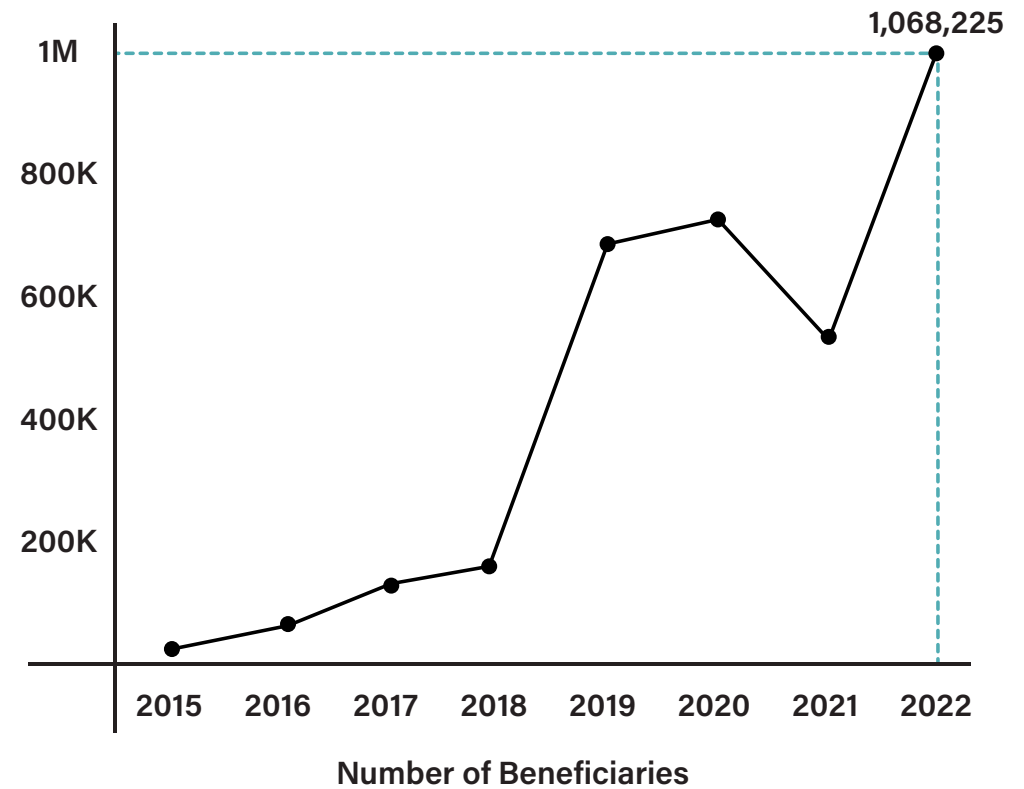
The selflessness of our donors is truly inspiring and we cannot thank them enough for their support and for their willingness to invest in making the world a better place for all.

## CARE FOR ORPHANS

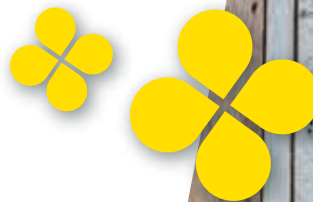
Fatimah was widowed years ago, when her 9-year-old daughter Askia was still a baby.

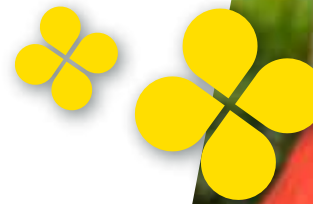

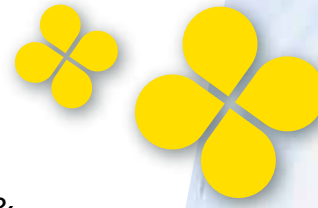
