»» OUR MILESTONES



2015

Global Ehsan Relief began its journey in Singapore, launching initial projects focused on orphans, clean water, and emergency relief in Gaza and Syria. Alhamdulillah, we were fortunate to receive strong support from our community as we took our first steps into humanitarian work.

2018

We opened four new offices in Indonesia, Malaysia, Cambodia, and Sri Lanka, to facilitate our on-the-ground operations. This especially helped when Indonesia faced multiple natural disasters that year, and our team was quick to provide urgent relief. We also launched our first Community Involvement Programme (CIP), deploying volunteers to assist in distributions in Aceh and Jordan.

2016

Our operations expanded with our first mission trips to support Syrian refugees and our initial disaster relief project in Indonesia, providing aid to communities affected by earthquakes in Sumatra and Aceh.

2019

A year of new milestones! Key projects were launched, including the School For Orphans in Aceh, now known as Ma'had Ibnu Sina, our flagship centre for orphaned children and students in need. Our CIP expanded to Bangladesh and Türkiye, allowing volunteers to connect with Syrian and Rohingya refugees.

2017

2017 marked one of the worst humanitarian crises in modern times - the persecution and forced expulsion of the Rohingya people from Myanmar. In response to the crisis, we launched urgent appeals and delivered essential aid to Rohingya refugee camps in Bangladesh.

2020

The COVID-19 pandemic brought unprecedented challenges. Many drastic changes were made, including the cancellation of our many planned trips and shifting our collections entirely online. We emerged stronger, with new ideas for raising funds. Community support remained strong, allowing us to continue serving vulnerable groups. It illustrated that even in times of adversity, we can all work together to still make a difference.



2021

We expanded our operations and projects in Singapore, Malaysia, and Indonesia - reaching more beneficiaries across six core projects. Even though travel was still barred, our indispensable partners enabled us to continue implementing our overseas projects. We also hit a new milestone in Ramadan, raising over \$1 million all thanks to our donors' generosity.

2022

With borders reopening, we were able to travel and meet our international beneficiaries again! From Umrah trips for our Orphans to Ramadan and Qurban deployments, it was a joy to resume our work unhindered. In total, over 1 million people benefited from our projects — a record-breaking achievement.

2023

We reached new heights, raising over \$4.5 million with the continued support of our donors. Support surged following major crises, including the Türkiye earthquake in February, and the October attacks in Gaza. With our donors' support, we launched multiple phases of emergency aid, providing both immediate and long-term relief.

2024

Our annual Qurban Relief campaign aims to provide essential aid to communities in need, while helping our donors fulfil the sunnah of Qurban. This year, we extended our efforts to 36 countries. By July, we reached more than 1.6 million beneficiaries worldwide, disbursing more than a million to those in need.

OUR CORE PROJECTS

CARE FOR ORPHANS

Orphans have always been our main core project and attention. Without parental care, many of these children face hardships such as child labour to survive. Our programmes ensure they have access to shelter, food, education, and emotional support, helping them build a brighter future.

ORPHAN SPONSORSHIP

The programme provides monthly financial aid to improve orphans' living conditions, support their education, and organise social activities for them and their families. Our Hifz orphans go through a unique three-year sponsorship, which provides specialised care as they learn, read, and memorise the Qur'an. Afterward, they receive ongoing support to pursue either Islamic or mainstream education.

MA'HAD IBNU SINA

Our integrated Islamic boarding school in Aceh, Indonesia, is dedicated to educating orphaned and underprivileged children. With a focus on nurturing young Muslim scholars with strong moral values, the school prepares them to contribute meaningfully to society and thrive in the modern world.

WIDOW & ORPHANS FOOD AID PACKS

Committed to addressing hunger, we provide food aid to widows and orphaned families across Asia, Africa and the Middle East, offering relief to those affected by poverty.

HOME FOR WIDOWS

This project offers widows and orphaned children in Indonesia, Cambodia, and Sri Lanka safe shelter and support when they have nowhere else to turn. Generous community donations fund the construction of these much-needed homes.

MEALS FOR ORPHANED FAMILIES

We are committed to solving world hunger by providing food aid packs to help widows and orphans that have been affected by poverty across 15 countries throughout Asia, Africa and the Middle East.

UMRAH FOR ORPHANS

Since 2017, we have provided the life-changing opportunity for 346 Palestinian orphans to perform Umrah, giving them a chance to experience the sacred pilgrimage to the Holy Land.

OUR CORE PROJECTS

CARE FOR CLEAN WATER

More than 3 million people, mostly children, lose their lives to diseases from waterborne viruses. In response, Global Ehsan Relief brings clean water to communities by building water wells, ablution spaces, community water wells and more.

WATER WELLS: HANDPUMP, ELECTRIC & HYBRID

We build a range of water wells, from handpump and electric to hybrid models, carefully selecting the best option to suit each community's needs. Our commitment to improving water access has led us to construct 5,821 wells in rural communities over the years, providing clean water to thousands of families.

COMMUNITY WATER WELLS & SOLAR WATER STATIONS

Our community water wells and solar water stations are designed to provide a reliable and sustainable water source for entire villages. These initiatives deliver clean water daily, benefiting hundreds of individuals in need and improving the quality of life for entire communities.

ABLUTION PLACE

More than just a facility for prayer, an ablution place also ensures reliable access to clean water for everyone in the community. Thanks to the generous support of our donors, we have built 482 ablution facilities at mosques in Cambodia and Sri Lanka, promoting hygiene and convenience for local worshippers.

CLEAN WATER SUPPLY

In Gaza, where conflict has disrupted essential services, our mission remains to provide every resident with access to clean, safe drinking water. Through carefully planned projects, we aim to reach homes, hospitals, mosques, and schools with dependable water resources that support daily life.



OUR CORE PROJECTS

CARE FOR HUNGER

According to the World Health Organization, approximately 783 million people worldwide face hunger every day. Limited access to affordable, nutritious food has made food insecurity a pressing global issue. In response, we are committed to providing hunger relief aid on a global scale.

Through our various programmes, we have distributed over 126,000 Food Aid Packs, served 314,000 hot meals, and provided more than one million loaves of bread to impoverished families in need.

CARE FOR EDUCATION

While many children have the chance to pursue their dreams, over 244 million children worldwide are denied access to education. Financial hardship is one of the primary barriers keeping these disadvantaged children from even entering school.

Our mission is to empower these children through education, helping to transform their futures. We do this by providing essential school supplies and improving access to quality learning environments. Our efforts include establishing and supporting educational centres across several regions:

- School In A Bus in Beqaa Camp, Lebanon
- Mobile School in Jordan

OUR CORE PROJECTS

CARE FOR REFUGEES

With over 120 million refugees worldwide lacking shelter and basic necessities like food, clean water, medicine, and hygiene essentials, the hardships they face are immense, especially during harsh winter months.

Our Care for Refugees program is dedicated to alleviating this suffering by providing essential aid to Syrian and Palestinian refugees, as well as Rohingya refugees in Bangladesh.

Thanks to the continuous generosity of our community, we can extend meaningful support to those in desperate need.

GER is here to help – by providing shelter, resources, and support to rebuild lives.



HYGIENE KITS

Often overlooked, hygiene kits are one of the daily necessities. These basic items allow refugees to live day-to-day with minimal items.

FOOD AID PACKS

With your support, we deliver food aid packs to nourish starving children, widows, and the elderly, ensuring they have the sustenance they need.

COOKED MEALS

In addition to food aid packs, we distribute cooked meals to refugees, offering immediate relief to those without access to affordable, nutritious food.

CLEAN WATER SUPPLY

Our clean water initiatives are designed to offer sustainable, 24-hour access to safe drinking water, improving health and quality of life for refugees in impoverished areas.

WINTER RELIEF SETS

To combat the cold, we supply winter relief kits that include warm clothing, heating supplies, and hygiene essentials, offering refugees protection during the harsh winter.

TEMPORARY SHELTERS

To help restore safety, self-sufficiency, and dignity, we provide temporary shelters for refugees, creating a secure space where they can rebuild.



OUR CORE PROJECTS

GLOBAL WAQF PROJECTS

Waqf (endowment) is a charitable contribution in the form of cash or property to be used in line with Islamic shariah. It's a great way to provide long-term solutions for communities in need while also ensuring endless rewards for their akhira (Hereafter).

Donors can help Muslims around the world while ensuring a good Hereafter for themselves. We provide underprivileged Muslims, including the visually impaired in Indonesia, access to the words of Allah S.W.T. through our Qur'an and Qur'an Braille projects.

Additionally, we collect funds to aid needy communities by building mosques, schools, and providing them with clean water via water wells and ablution places.



QUR'AN

Through this project, Global Ehsan Relief provides free copies of the Qur'an to these Muslims in need. To date, more than 27,000 copies have been distributed across Asia, Africa, and the Middle East.

QUR'AN BRAILLE (TRADITIONAL & DIGITAL)

There are more than 2 million visually impaired Muslims in Indonesia, many of whom live in poverty. More than 2,000 visually impaired Muslims have benefited from this project.

BUILD A MOSQUE

To date, our donors have helped us build more than 70 mosques for underprivileged communities in Asia, Africa, and the Middle East, benefiting thousands of Muslims in need.

MADRASAH (SCHOOL)

With this initiative, we aim to build schools in less-developed areas to make sure every child has the chance to learn. So far, our efforts have led to the establishment of 3 new schools in rural Cambodia, with more to come.

SEASONAL PROJECTS

QURBAN RELIEF

Qurban, a significant practice in Islam, holds a special place. Despite global food production, 811 million people continue to face daily hunger. Eid-ul Adha serves as a rare occasion for many to consume meat. Our annual Qurban project aims to aid these individuals in need.

EHSAN RAMADHAN

Ramadhan has always been a special month in the Islamic calendar. Apart from observing our conduct and fasting, we also know that the Prophet ﷺ was more generous in Ramadhan than other months. Hence every year we ramp up our programmes during this blessed month, encouraging the Muslim community to join in and reap more rewards together.



EMERGENCY RESPONSE

ON-GOING EMERGENCY APPEAL

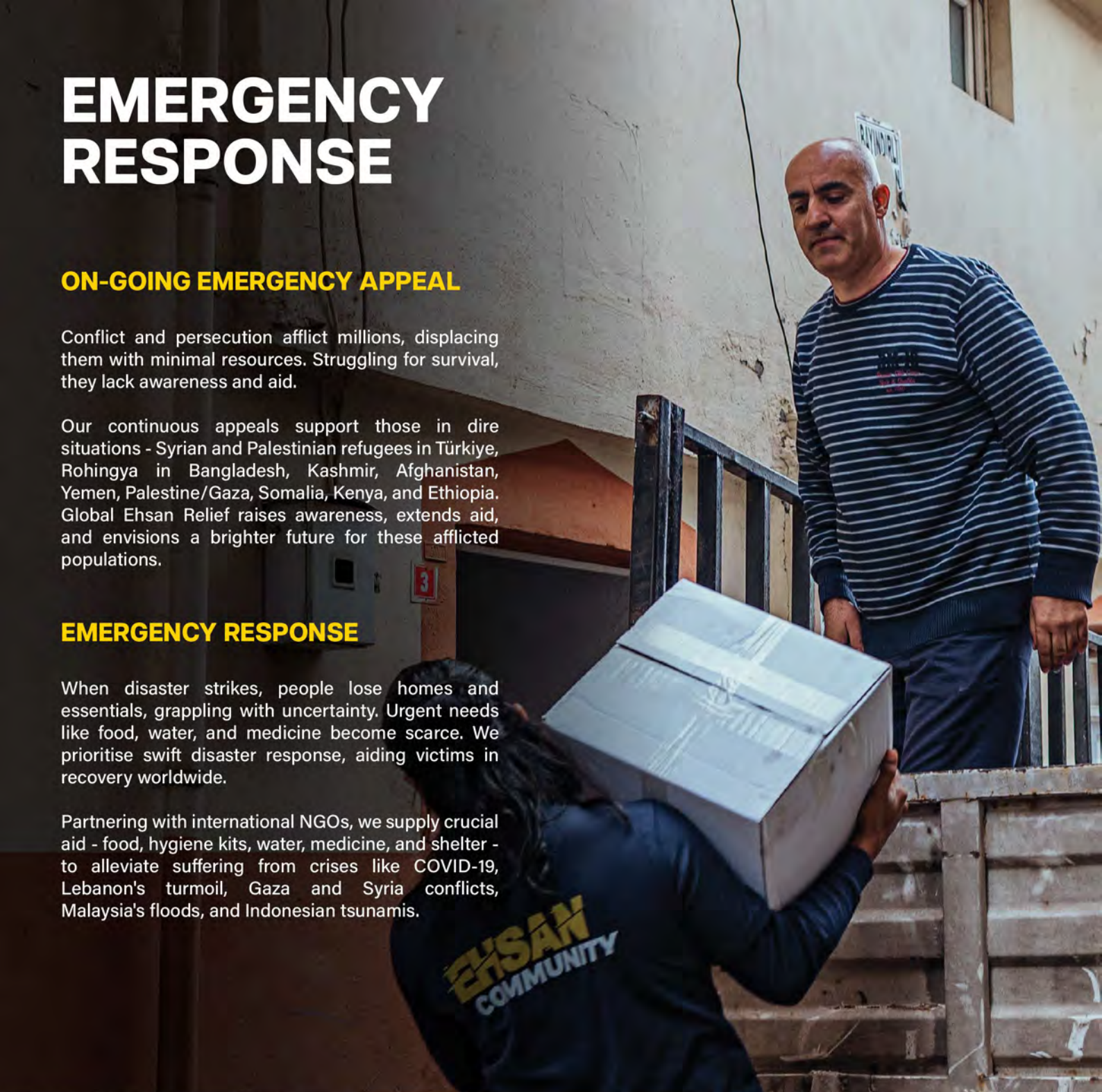
Conflict and persecution afflict millions, displacing them with minimal resources. Struggling for survival, they lack awareness and aid.

Our continuous appeals support those in dire situations - Syrian and Palestinian refugees in Türkiye, Rohingya in Bangladesh, Kashmir, Afghanistan, Yemen, Palestine/Gaza, Somalia, Kenya, and Ethiopia. Global Ehsan Relief raises awareness, extends aid, and envisions a brighter future for these afflicted populations.

EMERGENCY RESPONSE

When disaster strikes, people lose homes and essentials, grappling with uncertainty. Urgent needs like food, water, and medicine become scarce. We prioritise swift disaster response, aiding victims in recovery worldwide.

Partnering with international NGOs, we supply crucial aid - food, hygiene kits, water, medicine, and shelter - to alleviate suffering from crises like COVID-19, Lebanon's turmoil, Gaza and Syria conflicts, Malaysia's floods, and Indonesian tsunamis.





HIGHLIGHTS

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT PROGRAMME

Global Ehsan Relief not only partners with international organisations but also involves dedicated individuals in first-hand humanitarian efforts. Through our Community Involvement Programmes, members of the GER community can join trips to countries like Indonesia, Cambodia, Jordan, Lebanon, Türkiye and more.

This initiative provides a chance to directly contribute to helping those in need. More than ten successful Community Involvement Programmes have been conducted, each lasting about seven days.

Activities include packing and distributing Food Aid, renovating places of worship, teaching English, and spending time with vulnerable groups.

Participants find this experience humbling and impactful. Their own fundraising efforts before the trips add a personal touch to their mission of providing assistance.

From Food Aid distribution to uplifting events for orphans and renovating mosques, we empower individuals to fundraise and witness the direct positive change their donations bring.

SPECIAL PROJECT MA'HAD IBNU SINA

With the Ma'had Ibnu Sina, we are able to provide the orphans with a stable home, quality education, and the structured support they need to grow. The school was first built after the earthquake and tsunami struck Aceh, Indonesia in 2004, to educate poor orphans and underprivileged children who had lost a parent or both parents.

Over the years, Ma'had Ibnu Sina has grown from its humble beginnings into our very own full-fledged school — a place built with sincerity, care and dedication. What started as a safe refuge for children in crisis has now expanded into a thriving institution, home to more than 100 students, the majority of whom are orphans.

Following the school motto — Science, Adab, Amal, Taqwa — we remain committed to continuing the mandate of its founders: to nurture young Muslim scholars with noble morals and the ability to contribute and thrive in the modern world. This is the beginning of a better life for them, and we will continue to stand by their side every step of the way.
