# **Hybrid Education**

- 1. MOOCs in a blended course:
  - using components of a MOOC
  - using the whole MOOC
- 2. MOOCs as electives
- 3. A series of MOOCs as part of a program, adding an extra project or exam for campus students
- **4.** A MicroMasters: a series of MOOCs plus exam = credits by entering the corresponding campus programme



## Pilot study MOOCs4Credits

- 66 students enrolled
- 29 registered for exam
- 18 showed up
- 15 passed
- →positive: flexibility
- →negative: flexibility

Due to a general lack of time.


I couldn't motivate myself to put in the time to study.
