VISION

MICROCASA is the first international project aimed at sharing the European experiences and building **institutional capacities** in Southeast Asia to co-create, promote and deliver short competence-oriented educational units leading to micro-credentials with the goal of solving various economic and social problems.

Focusing on different aspects of microcredentialing, for instance course content cocreation, educational technology, transparent quality assurance, technologies for issuance and verification of digital micro-credentials, the project builds a comprehensive set of competences and technical capacities in Southeast Asian universities.






PROJECT PARTNERS/MEMBERS

Prof. Dr. Armin Weinberger is head and founder of the EduTech department of Saarland University, Germany. His main research interests are educational technology, technology-enhanced learning, computer-supported collaborative learning, argumentative knowledge construction. cross-cultural education, knowledge convergence, and methodological issues in small group learning. He received the award for good teaching of Bavaria in 2000, the award for Outstanding Journal Article of the AECT in 2005, and the award for top cited article 2007-2011 in Learning and Instruction and has been the most productive author of the ijCSCL from 2010 to 2014.

Armin has founded and coordinated the EARLI SIG Argumentation, Dialogue, and Reasoning from 2016 until 2020, he has coordinated the CSCL community of the ISLS from 2018 to 2022, and he has joined the board of directors of the EARLI in 2020 and has been elected vice-president of EARLI in 2023, taking over the presidency in 2025.

Carlos Delgado Kloos received the Ph.D. degree in Computer Science from the Technische Universität München and in Telecommunications Engineering from the Universidad Politécnica de Madrid. He is Full Professor of Telematics Engineering at the Universidad Carlos III de Madrid, where he is the Director of the GAST research group, Director of the UNESCO Chair on "Scalable Digital Education for All" and Rector's Delegate for Digital Microcredentials. He has carried out research studies at several universities such as Harvard, MIT, Munich, and Passau. His main research interests are in Educational Technology. He has been involved in a large number of research projects and has published more than 500 articles. He has coordinated several MOOCs with over 600,000 registrations and is presently promoting the adoption of digital micro-credentials in Spain through the project CertiDigital (certidigital.es).
