



Executive Summary

The MICROCASA Quality Assurance Report provides an account of the project activities related to quality assurance implemented within the first half of the project (months 1-18). It also incorporates the feedback the project received from the external quality assurance expert contracted to provide an independent assessment of the project implementation and recommendations for improvements.

MICROCASA quality assurance activities have been described in D4.3 Quality Assurance Strategy document submitted by the consortium in month 6.

The MICROCASA Quality Assurance Report follows the structure of D4.3 and contains the following chapters:

- Chapter one reports on the place and role of the quality assurance activities during the reporting period;
- Chapter two describes in details the dedicated quality assurance activities carried out by the consortium with WP4, Task 4.3;
- Chapter three describes the process of external quality assurance expert selection, the summary of the activities implemented by the expert and the brief summary of the first submitted external QA evaluation report;
- Chapter four provides the summary and general conclusions, as well as recommendations for the second reporting period.
