Alerts and Triggered Emails (Push Notifications)

We will also configure a sample employee / admin notification.

Welcome Email draft:

Receipt draft:

Add any additional messaging you'd like on the receipt.

By default, all of the order information will be included.

If you do not want a receipt, please note that here instead.

Payment failed / account overdue notice:

Add any additional messaging you'd like on the email sent to members when a payment is unsuccessful. By default, a sentence telling them that their account is overdue as well as a link to allow them to update their billing information is included.

If you do not want an account overdue notice, please note that here instead.
