GAEL SPOTLIGHT

• Saint Mary's finished out their non-conference slate with an 11-2 record, and have opened WCC play with a four straight wins to move to 15-2, their best start since they opened 24-2 in the 2017-18 season that saw the Gaels win a program record 30 games. The 11 wins in non-conference play were the most since the Gaels went 11-4 in 2022-23, while the two losses were the fewest in non-con since 2020-21, when they went 9-2. Throughout the campaign, the Gaels have received votes in at least one of the AP or Coaches Polls every single week, and are currently ranked fourth in the College Insider Mid-Major Top-25, 23rd in the NET, 26th in Bart Torvik and 28th in KenPom.

• The Gaels were picked to finish second in the WCC in the 2025-26 preseason coaches poll. Saint Mary's won the WCC Regular Season title outright for the second consecutive year in 2024-25, the first time they've done so in program history. The Gaels won the conference by a hefty three game margin, their largest margin ever, besting their 2 game conference regular season title margin from the 1958-59 and 1988-89 seasons. Saint Mary's was also picked to finish in 2nd place in the 2024-25 WCC Preseason poll, despite winning both the regular season and tournament titles in 2023-24.

• Mikey Lewis, Paulius Murauskas and Harry Wessels were all named to the preseason All-WCC team. Murauskas won the 2025 WCC Newcomer of the Year award, the first Gaels since Joe Rahon in 2016 to win the award, and the fifth ever Gael to earn the distinction. Lewis was just the second ever Gael to win WCC Sixth Man of the Year last year, joining the likes of Tommy Kuhse. Wessels had a breakout season in 2024-25, seeing career marks in scoring, rebounding, shot blocking and minutes played a year ago, coming off the bench at the five. The three preseason all-conference honorees were the most of any team in the West Coast Conference.

• The Gaels made the NCAA Tournament for the fourth consecutive seasons in 2024-25, extending their program record streak. On top of this, Saint Mary's has been a single digit seed in each of the last four tournaments. Saint Mary's is one of only 17 schools to receive a single digit seed in each of the last four NCAA Tournaments, and is one of only five schools to do so while not coming out of a Power 5 (now Power 4) conference (Gonzaga, Creighton, Marquette, and UConn). Early projections show the Gaels once again in single digit seed territory for the 2026 NCAA Tournament.

About Saint Mary's

» The Gaels hold highest highest winning percentage (.776) and are tied for the most NCAA Tournament appearances (6) of any NCAA Division I men's basketball program in the state of California since the 2015-16 season.

» Saint Mary's currently has the fifth best win percentage (.776) of any Div. I team in the nation since 2015-16.

» SMC has a 115-32 record (.782) winning percentage against non-conference opponents in regular season games since 2015-16.

» Since 2015-16, SMC has posted a 135-30 (.818) overall record in West Coast Conference play.

» Saint Mary's has been selected for postseason (11 NCAA, 7 NIT) in each of the last 18 seasons, the fourth-longest active streak in the NCAA behind Kansas, Michigan State, and Gonzaga.

» Saint Mary's has finished t-2nd or higher in the WCC in 18 of the last 22 seasons and has won 25 or more games 15 times in the last 22 seasons.

» The Gaels went 30-6 in the regular season of 2017-18, marking the most single-season wins in program history.

» The Gaels graduated three veterans from last year's roster, Augustas Marciulionis, Mitchell Saxen and Luke Barrett, the first ever players in Saint Mary's history to appear in four NCAA Tournaments. Marciulionis went onto sign an Exhibit 10 deal with the Lakers and made his G-League debut 11/8/25. Saxen signed with Nanterre 92 in France, making his pro debut on 9/30/25. Barrett joined Arka Gdynia in Poland, making his debut on 10/5/25.

MASTERS OF EFFICIENCY

Per KenPom, Saint Mary's is one of just 27 teams in the country, and one of just six non-power four schools, to rank in the top-50 in both offensive and defensive efficiency. Joining the likes of Gonzaga, UConn, Villanova, St Johns and Utah State in the non-P-4 ranks, Saint Mary's eyes their fourth ever chance to finish a season in the top-50 in both offensive and defensive efficiency under Coach Bennett's tutelage, also doing so in 2016-17, 2022-23 and 2023-24, all NCAA Tournament seasons.

DEFENDING HOME COURT

The Gaels have won 10 straight at home to open the 2025-26 campaign. That comes on the back of nine straight wins at home to close out the 2024-25 season, bringing the Gaels to 19 wins in a row at home. That ties the Gaels for their second longest home winning streak in program history, and ties them for the sixth longest active home winning streak in DI College Basketball. The program's longest home winning streak ranged across three seasons, when the Gaels won 23 in a row inside UCU Pavilion ranging from the 2020-21 season to the 2022-23 campaign.

ROAD WARRIORS

Since the 2022-23 campaign, the Saint Mary's Gaels boast an extremely impressive 27-3 (0.900) record in true road contests. In that time period, only Houston (29-3) has a better road record. In this stretch, the Gaels have enjoyed many quality wins away from the friendly confines, including wins over Colorado State in Fort Collins, Utah in Salt Lake City and twice over Gonzaga in Spokane. While it is a small sample size, the Gaels are shooting 50% from

the field in their three road contests in 2025-26, and are averaging just nine turnovers per game on the road, both better than their season average.

STAYING HOT FROM THE STRIPE

The Gaels have proven to be the best free throw shooting team in the country this year, shooting at an 80.7% clip (Leading the NCAA) while shooting nearly 23 per game on average. Six different Gaels are shooting at least 80% from the stripe this season; Tony Duckett (94.1%), Joshua Dent (93.3%), Rory Hawke (92.9%), Mikey Lewis (92.7%), Liam Campbell (87.5%) and Paulius Murauskas (82.2%). Murauskas has been to the stripe a WCC high 129 times (2nd in the Nation), and has converted 106 of those attempts (Most in the Nation) to shoot at an 82.2% clip. These numbers are even more impressive when figuring that the Gaels shot just 69.5% from the stripe last year. The best free throw percentage from a team in program history came in the 2017-18 season, when the Gaels shot 76.9%. While it is still early, this year's squad could challenge that record, as they already have broken the consecutive free throw make record, knocking down 30 in a row between their St. Thomas and Chattanooga contests.

A STAR ON THE RISE

In 25 seasons at the helm of the Saint Mary's Men's Basketball program, Head Coach Randy Bennett has started just 19 true freshmen during his tenure. On December 19, 2025, Dillan Shaw joined that list of young upstart Gael starters, drawing his first collegiate start against Florida Atlantic. Shaw joins a list that includes program standouts Daniel Kickert, Diamon Simpson, Omar

Samhan, Patty Mills, Matthew Dellavedova and Augustas Marciulionis. Hailing from Northridge, California, and ranked as the highest ever recruit to sign with Saint Mary's (89th in the CO '25 according to 247Sports), Shaw has done a bit of everything for the Gaels, averaging 8 PPG and 5 RPG (most of any Gael Guard), while shooting 45% from three and tallying 24 assists, 18 steals and 10 blocks.

LEADING THE WCC EARLY

Saint Mary's is one of just three teams in the country to have both their conference's leading scorer and rebounder on their roster this season, joining Fairfield out of the MAAC and NC Central out of the MEAC. Averaging 19.1 points per game, Paulius Murauskas currently stands as the WCC's leading scorer, while Andrew McKeever, ripping down 9.1 boards per game, is the WCC's leading rebounder. Murauskas also leads the WCC in field goal attempts and free throws made and attempted, while McKeever has seen his rebound total soar due to his efforts on the offensive glass, leading the WCC in that category as well. Rounding out the group of individual leaders in the WCC for the Gaels, Josh Dent leads the way, averaging 34:59 played per game. Saint Mary's leads the West Coast Conference in five different statistical categories through the first four contests of conference play as a team. SMC leads the conference in free throws made per game (18.4), free throw percentage (80.7%, Leading the NCAA), scoring defense (63.9 PPG), rebound margin (+11.4) and three point percentage (37.2%). These categories all demonstrate the Gaels physicality on both ends of the ball, drawing fouls and knocking down threes offensively, and making life tough on opposing offenses on the other end.

FRESHMAN PHENOMS (AGAIN!)

Since the introduction of the WCC Freshman of the Week Award in the 2021-22 season, no team has ever had multiple winners of this award in back-to-back season...until now. After both Andrew McKeever and Mikey Lewis earned this distinction multiple times a year ago, both Dillan Shaw and Liam Campbell have gotten the nod this season. With Shaw earning the honor last week, Saint Mary's joined Pepperdine as the only other WCC school with five different student-athletes to earn WCC Freshman of the Week honors.

NON-CON IN REVIEW

The Gaels put together a solid non-conference showing in the lead in to WCC play, going 11-2, including four quad two victories. Saint Mary's opened the year a perfect 8-0, their best start since 2013-14, with signature wins over Wichita State and Virginia Tech in the Battle 4 Atlantis. Their first stumble came against Vanderbilt, a team that is still undefeated heading into the final week of 2025, in the Battle 4 Atlantis Championship, but SMC responded with a win in their lone true road contest of non-con, going to Davidson, N.C. and knocking off the Wildcats. Finishing off a stretch of five straight contests away from UCU Pavilion, the Gaels fell in a narrow one point contest in Idaho Falls to Boise State, but closed out the non-con slate on a high with a pair of wins at home against Florida Atlantic and Northern Iowa. The 11 wins in non-conference play mark the most for the Gaels since 2022-23, while the two losses are the fewest since 2020-21.

ROOMMATES AND BACK-COURT MATES LEARN-ING FROM ONE ANOTHER

Roommates and starting backcourt mates Joshua Dent and Mikey Lewis have really demonstrated their chemistry on the court this season, and have helped one another expand their games. Lewis, typically a scoring first guard, has seen his assist numbers drastically increase in year two, ranking second on the team with 43, behind only starting point guard Dent, and also ranks second on the team with an ast-to-to ratio of 2.05. Dent, who leads the Gaels with both 86 assists and a 2.15 ast-to-to, has seen his scoring ability increase in year two, taking a page out of Mikey's book, averaging 12.4 points per contest and knocking down 2 threes, both good for third on the team. Both in the Gaels program for their second year together, the growth has been clear to see from year one to year two with these two outstanding guards.

A NEW PROGRAM RECORD

The Gaels made their final 10 free throws in their opening night contest against St. Thomas, and followed that up by making their first 20 against Chattanooga in game two. The 30 consecutive makes breaks a record that has stood for 45 years for most consecutive made free throws made by a Saint Mary's team, as the Gaels made 26 in a row over a two game stretch against USF and Gonzaga in January of 1980.

UNPRECEDENTED OFFENSIVE START

Saint Mary's put up 80+ points in six

straight contests to open a season for the first time in program history. The previous record of four straight 80+ performances to open a year came all the way back to open the 1977-78 campaign, the final season that the Gaels played in Madigan Gymnasium, a year before McKeon (now UCU) Pavilion was opened. The Gaels also scored 70+ in each of their first 10 contests, falling one short of the record for 70+ point contests to start a year, 11 straight back in the 2017-18 campaign. Saint Mary's shot 50% or better from the field in three straight to open the season, doing so for the first time since December of 2020, and shot 50% or better from three in back-to-back contests (Chattanooga and Ohio) for the first time since December of 2019. Since the start of conference play, the Gaels are shooting 52% from the field, shooting 50% or better in three of four contests. Most notably, against Chattanooga, SMC shot 57.8% from the field, 50% from three and 93.1% from the stripe. It was just the third time in the past decade that the Gaels shot 50% or better from the field and from three, while also shooting 90% or better from the stripe, with the other two times coming against Northern Kentucky (12/21/23) and Alabama Birmingham (11/27/15).

CROY AND PAVELY INKED ON SIGNING DAY

Just off to a stellar start in the 2025-26 campaign, Saint Mary's has already begun building their 2026-27 roster, as both point guard JRob Croy and big man Flynn Pavely signed their commitment letters to Saint Mary's on National Signing Day (Nov. 12). Hailing from Riverside, Croy is a 6-6 point guard out of Riverside Poly High School. He led his prep team to a league title and a trip to the DII CIF State Regional Semifinals last year, while helping his AAU squad, Team CPSA, to the 2025 Pima Pro16 17U League Title this summer. He is the son of former Saint Mary's Assistant and current Cal Baptist Head Coach Rick Croy. Pavely stands at 6-11 and will be the 26th Gael out of the Nation of Australia. A Centre of Excellence product, along with greats like Mills, Dellavedova and Ducas as well as all three Aussie Gaels currently on the roster, Pavely helped guide his team to the a runner-up finish in the NBL1 East regular season and a trip to the NBL1 East semifinals.

PRESEASON RECOGNITION

The West Coast Conference has announced their preseason all-conference team and coaches poll. The Gaels have been picked to finish second in the

WCC for the second straight season, despite winning at least a share of the conference title in each of the last three years. The Gaels also have the most preseason All-WCC selections, with Mikey Lewis, Paulius Murauskas and Harry Wessels all appearing on the preseason all-conference list.

Last year's WCC Sixth Man of the Year, Mikey Lewis is one of just two underclassmen to earn a spot on the preseason all-conference team, joining San Francisco's Tyrone Riley IV. The Oakland native brought a pop of energy off the bench in every game for the Gaels, averaging 8.2 points per contest, and burying a team-high 58 three pointers at a team-best 37.4% clip. While Lewis had some standout performances in his freshman campaign, arguably his largest came in the Gaels WCC Regular Season Title clinching victory in Spokane, when he buried 5-7 three point attempts against the Zags, scoring a team-high 18 points in 18 minutes in the victory.

Back for year two with the Gaels, Paulius Murauskas makes his way onto the preseason all-conference team after being named last year's WCC Newcomer of the Year. The Arizona Wildcat turned Saint Mary's Gael took the WCC by storm last season, leading the conference with 13 double-doubles, making him the first Gael to record double digit double-doubles since Jock Landale. Six of those double-doubles came in conference play, including a 30 point, 10 rebounds onslaught against Washington State, in which Murauskas became the first Gaels since Logan Johnson in 2023 to score 30 in a game.

Coming off of a breakout campaign, big man Harry Wessels rounds out the group of preseason all-conference honorees. The Boddington, West Australia native saw career marks in scoring, rebounding, shot blocking and minutes played a year ago, coming off the bench at the five. Wessels biggest moment of his junior campaign came in Moraga when the Gaels played host to Gonzaga. On for a fouled out Mitchell Saxen, Wessels knocked down a pair of free throws with less than a minute to go to push the Gaels ahead 60-58, followed by the game clinching block on the ensuing Zag possession, as Saint Mary's would go onto win 62-58.

Bennett is second all-time among WCC coaches in career league wins and has a 562-222 (.717) record while compiling a 270-95 (.740) mark in WCC regular-season competition. Bennett became the winningest coach at SMC when the Gaels defeated East Tennessee State in the semifinals of the Rainbow Classic on December 21, 2007, passing James Weaver (110-67), who held the record for 47 years.

He has led SMC to at least the semifinals of the WCC Tournament in 22 of his past 23 seasons, and 14 championship game appearances. His side captured WCC Tournament titles in 2010, 2012, 2019, and 2024.

In addition to team accomplishments, Bennett has had 57 players earn All-WCC recognition, with 46 first or second team and 11 honorable mention selections.

He coached Mickey McConnell, Matthew Dellavedova, Jock Landale and Augustas Marciulionis to WCC Player of the Year honors. In 2011, he served as an assistant coach for the USA team that competed in the FIBA U19 World Championship in Latvia.

Randy Bennett, Saint Mary's Head Coach

A seven-time West Coast Conference Coach of the Year (2025, 2024, 2023, 2022, 2016, 2011, 2008) and 2010 Sporting News WCC Coach of the Year, Randy Bennett, took over as the head men's basketball coach prior to the 2001-02 season. The winner of the last four straight WCC Coach of the year honors, Bennett now is tied for the second longest streak for that award in conference history.

On Nov. 10, 2017, Saint Mary's and head coach Randy Bennett announced the signing of a new 10-year contract that will keep Bennett in charge of the program through the 2026-27 season. In 2024-25, Bennett led the Gaels to their 18th straight postseason appearance and a number-seven seed in the NCAA Tournament, their fourth straight single digit seed.

Now entering his 25th season, he is the school's all-time wins leader, guided SMC to 19 post-season appearances (12 NCAA and 7 NIT), led the Gaels to their first post-season victory since 1959 and had a player drafted (Patrick Mills, 2009) by the NBA for the first time since 1984. Gael alum Jock Landale is currently playing in the NBA, while Augustas Marciulionis is currently on an exhibit 10 deal with the

BIG WINS OVER LAST FEW SEASONS

Bennett earned his 500th win at Saint Mary's on Feb. 2, 2023 in a home win over San Francisco. For reference, Bennett won his 400th career game as head coach, all with Saint Mary's, on Dec. 19, 2018 versus Bucknell.

Bennett has also been the head coach of the only two wins in SMC history over the No. 1 team in the country: the 2019 WCC Championship game over Gonzaga, and the home finale of the 2021-22 season, also over Gonzaga.

BENNETT HAS LASTING POWER

With a few high-profile coaches retiring this past summer, Randy Bennett is now the fifth-longest tenured head coach with one program amongst active coaches in the NCAA.

Greg Kampe leads the list, having led Oakland since the 1984-5 season. Mark Few is the only active WCC coach who has held a longer tenure with his current team (started in 1999-2000).
