SERIES HISTORY

- The Cougs finish their last roadtrip at #18/16 UCLA were they look to come up with their first-ever season sweep of the Bruins.
- Last time out against UCLA, the Cougs came up with their biggest upset in program history, knocking off the then #9/7 ranked Bruins, 82-73, in Pullman. In the game, freshman Channele Molina came up with a freshmen record 33 points. Moline, however, was lost for the season two games later when she tore her ACL at Arizona State.
- UCLA has been unbeatable at Pauley Pavilion as the Bruins sport a perfect 13-0 record at home this season. They have won 26-straight at home dating back to last year. Their last loss at home came to #2 South Carolina back on Nov. 22, 2015 in a 68-65.

LAST TIME OUT

- Ten minutes in the middle of the contest proved too much to overcome for Washington State on the road at USC as the Cougs dropped an 80-64 decision to the Trojans at the Galen Center Friday night.
- Stymied with foul trouble in the opening half, the Cougs let their guard down for just 10 minutes in the contest only to see the Trojans capitalize to break open a close contest in the second quarter. Down just three heading into the second frame the Cougs scored the first five points of the new period to take a two-point lead just two minutes in. However, the lead would be the final advantage of the game for WSU as the Cougs went cold, scoring just six points over the final seven minutes of the half.
- In all, the Trojans hit 20-of-27 from the line including 13-of-16 in the fourth quarter thanks to a foul discrepancy that at one point had WSU with 12 fouls to the Trojans' three midway through the third quarter. The foul trouble hit the Cougs' front court the hardest allowing USC to crash the boards early to establish their lead.

MOLINA'S MONSTER NIGHT NETS THE COUGS THE 82-73 UPSET OF NO.7 UCLA

PULLMAN, Wash. - Behind a freshmen record 33 points from Chanelle Molina, the Washington State women's basketball team pulled off the biggest upset in program history on Friday night, downing No. 7 UCLA, 82-73, at Beasley Coliseum. The win for the Cougs (7-8, 2-2 Pac-12) was their second-straight in conference while handing the Bruins (11-3, 2-1 Pac-12) just their third loss of the year.

The Cougars win over the Bruins marked their best win over a top-10 opponent in program history, one-upping their 2014, 70-64, victory over No. 8 Maryland in Puerto Rico at the San Juan Shootout.

For Molina, the freshman could do little wrong on a night to remember as the first-year Cougar tied the Wazzu freshmen record for scoring with a 33-point effort. Molina matched Lia Galdeira's freshmen record set against Minnesota in 2012. Additionally, her 33 points on the night tied for the 10th best scoring game in program history as she became just the third freshman ever to reach the 30-point threshold. The Hawaiian native needed just 20 shots to do her damage in the game as she efficiently went about her business hitting 13-of-20 from the floor. Molina would have her hand in 20 of the Cougars' 34 field goals as she also tallied a career-best seven assists to go with her scoring binge.

With the game on the line it was Molina's back-to-back three-pointers that capped a 10-0 run by the Cougs early in the fourth quarter that tipped the balance to Wazzu. The run put the Cougars up eight just two minutes into the final frame as they would never look back allowing the Bruins to climb within two possessions just once more in the game. With the momentum pushing them the Cougars would not be denied as they pushed their lead to as much as 12 midway through the quarter while scoring a program-high 31 points in the final frame. The 31 was bolstered by 14 from Molina, tying her own program-record for points in a single quarter set earlier in the year at No. 22 Kentucky.

Throughout much of the game the two teams traded punches with the Cougars taking the lead after the first while the Bruins held the lead at the half. In the opening stanza, the Cougs relied on the inside-outside game of senior Ivana Kmetovska and Molina jump out front. While Molina came up with a quick 10 points, it was the rebounding and inside scoring of Kmetovska, including a layup in the final seconds that put WSU up two after 10 minutes. Kmetovska would net six points in the opening quarter as she was on her way to 12 points, one off of her career best of 13.

If the Cougars had one blemish on the night it would be the start of the second quarter when the Cougars missed their first nine shots from the floor and scored just one point through the first 5:30 minutes to allow the Bruins to bully their way to a nine point lead. Despite the cold start to the quarter, the Cougs would not go quietly as WSU regrouped and finished the quarter with eight of the final 12 points scored to cut the halftime deficit to just four.

The third quarter would be a slugfest as the two teams traded baskets and mini-runs with the Cougs closing the gap to just a single point, 52-51, heading into the final quarter.

Overall, Molina sparked the Cougars to their best shooting night of the season as Wazzu hit 34-of-65 (52.3%) from the floor including going 6-of-19 from deep. Three Cougs finished in double-figures with Molina leading the way and junior Pinelopi Pavlopoulou quietly and calmly cashing in for 14 points, one off of her career best. Kmetovska's 12 points were joined by a career-best 11 rebounds for the first double-double of her four-year career. It was the fourth double-double of the season for the Cougars.

The Bruins were led by Jordin Canada who came up with 19 points but needed 22 shots leading to UCLA taking 82 attempts from the floor as a team. UCLA finished the night shooting just 34.1% (28-of-82) from the floor while going 5-for-22 from deep and just 12-for-22 from the line. Monique Billings, the reigning Pac-12 Player of the Week ended her night with 18 points and 12 rebounds while Kennedy Burke added 16 points and eight rebounds.

UP NEXT

- The Cougs close out the regular season at home with two games against Utah and Colorado at Beasley Coliseum.
- The weekend kicks off against Utah Friday night as the two teams meet in front of televised audience on the PAC-12 Network.
- Last time against the Utes, the Cougs pulled off the victory in Salt Lake City, 61-55, two weeks ago, holding off a late charge by Utah.
- WSU remains ahead of both Utah and Colorado in the standings as the teams compete for seeding in the upcoming Pac-12 tournament.

SECOND HALF STRETCH RUN

- With three games to play in the regular season the Cougars have a chance to solidify their standing in the middle of the pack and possibly earn a spot in the WNIT as WSU plays two games against teams looking up at them in the standings.
- The Cougars face just one team above them in the standings, UCLA, a team WSU upset earlier in the year.
- In the first half of the Pac-12 schedule, the Cougars went 3-6 overall despite playing seven games against teams above them in the standings and one team, Cal, who was tied with them at the time.

PAVLOPOULOU TAKES OVER THE REINS

- With injuries up and down the lineup, junior point guard has taken charge of the Cougars over the past eight games, starting for the first time in her three-year career at WSU.
- Making the most of her increased role, Pavlopoulou has taken on the scoring load for the Cougs as she has netted double-figures in five of eight starts.
- In nine starts, the Athens native is averaging 9.9 ppg on 40.2% shooting. Additionally, she is averaging 3.7 apg to go with 3.7 rpg and 2.4 spg.
- For the year, she is averaging 7.3 ppg, 3.1 rpg, 2.9 apg, and 1.9 spg.

INJURIES RAVAGING THE COUGARS

- After a strong start to the season saw the Cougs at 5-2, the injury bug hit the team hard with the losses of the team's top three players, sophomore Borislava Hristova, junior Louise Brown, and most recently freshman sensation Chanelle Molina as well as fellow freshman Cameron Fernandez.
- Prior to injury, Hristova was off to a hot start averaging 14.7 ppg, 11th best in the Pac-12 and had just produced a 25-point effort against #5 Maryland.
- In her third season, Brown had just found her groove as the junior was averaging just under a double-double with 10.3 ppg and 6.9 rpg. She had just scored a career-best 16 against Nebraska before going down injured.
- Molina was averaging 12.8 points on 51.5% shooting having started all 17 games.
- All four players are out indefinitely for the Cougs. Hristova has been out since Dec. 8 while Brown has been out since Dec. 2. Molina will miss the rest of the season while Fernandez is day-to-day with the concussion protocol determining her return.
- In total, the Cougs are missing 42.6 ppg, 12.9 rpg, 6.3 apg, 3.5 spg from their injured players.

MCCLURE SETS A SCHOOL RECORD WITH 7 BLOCKS AGAINST ARIZONA

- Having her own personal block party Sunday afternoon against Arizona, redshirt-sophomore Nike McClure etched her name in the Cougs' record books with a program-record seven blocks versus the Wildcats.
- McClure became the first Cougar to ever reject seven shots in a single contest while nearly doubling her personal record of four coming into the game.
- The Tenino native has recorded a block in nine-straight contests and has posted multiple blocks in 10 contests on the year.

COUGARS CONTINUING THEIR BLOCK PARTY FROM LAST SEASON

- The Cougars broke the WSU single-season record with 120 total blocks during the 2015-16 season.
- WSU averaged 4.0 blocks per game led by redshirt-freshman Nike McClure and true freshman Maria Kostourkova. The freshmen duo headlined the Cougar frontline with 25 and 23 blocks, respectively, fourth- and fifth-most in WSU freshman history.
- WSU enters the game with 111 blocks on the year and are averaging 4.27 bpg, on pace for 128 blocks on the year with at least 4 games to play.
- McClure enters the week with 42 blocks while Kostourkova has posted 35. McClure's 42 ranks 5th all-time in a single season as she looks to become just the third Cougar to ever post 50 blocks in a season. Kostourkova now sits tied for 10th in a single season with her 35 blocks.

KMETOVSKA FINDING HER GROOVE IN HER FINAL GO AROUND

- Playing her final season in the Crimson and Gray, senior Ivana Kmetovska has found her groove in Pac-12 play as the fourth-year forward has scored in double figures in seven of 15 contests. Prior to conference play, Kmetovska hit the double-figure mark just once.
- Kmetovska has scored her career high of 16 three times in Pac-12 play including going for 16 in back-to-back contests against Cal and at Colorado.
- She is averaging 8.7 ppg in Pac-12 play while on the year she is averaging a career-best 8.0 ppg overall.
- Kmetovska scored a career-best 16 points at Colorado in a game the senior was perfect from the field going 8-for-8. She also dished out a career-best four assists in the contest.
- She is shooting 46.8% from the floor on the year.

FORCING THE OPPOSITION INTO MISTAKES

- In their second year under defensive guru Rod Jensen, the Cougs have found their way as one of the nation's top teams in forcing the opposition into mistakes.
- On the year, the Cougs are ranked #42 in the nation in forcing turnovers at 19.5 per game. They have done their work in the passing lanes as WSU ranks #41 in the nation in steals and average 10.1 per game.
- Juniors Pinelopi Pavlopoulou and Caila Hailey are the catalyst at 1.88 spg.
- Thanks to the turnovers, the Cougs have turned it into 501 points as they average 19.3 points per game off of turnovers.

MOLINA TEARS ACL - OUT FOR THE SEASON

- In the midst of one of the best freshmen seasons in program history, freshman sensation Chanelle Molina saw her season come to an end on Jan. 13 when she tore her left ACL at Arizona State.
- Prior to the injury, Molina was averaging 12.8 points on 51.5% shooting after scoring in double-figures in 12-straight games, the second longest streak for a Cougar freshman in program history.
- Her 51.5% shooting ranks as the best average ever for a freshman while ranking 9th best all-time overall. Additionally, she was shooting 43.1% from deep, the best mark of any freshman while ranking tied for third all-time.
- At the helm, Molina averaged a team-best 3.7 assists per game (63 total).
- The freshman was coming off of being named the U.S. Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) National Freshman of the Week while also grabbing back-to-back Pac-12 FOW honors.

ITS RAINING THREES

- Opening the season in front of 2,078 fans, the Cougars put on a show draining 13 three-pointers in their 92-45 victory over LMU. The 13 threes were tied for the second-most in WSU single-game history game. Five different Cougs hit two in the win.
- The Cougs would repeat the feat at Saint Louis with 13 on 24 attempts
- Swedlund leads the team with 48 on the year including 26 in conference play. The Cougs have hit 158 on the year, 7th in the Pac-12.

CLEANING UP THE GLASS

- Setting a school record on the boards to start the season, WSU came up with 64 rebounds in its win over LMU. The Cougars held a 64-36 advantage on the glass in the contest.
- Keeping the play alive, the Cougars came up with a cool 28 offensive rebounds that resulted in 27 second chance points.
- WSU is #56 in the nation in rebounds and average 40.2 rpg actively led by Nike McClure at 5.5 rpg.
- The Cougs lead the Pac-12 in offensive rebounding posting 15.6 rpg on the year. McClure is a big part as she is fifth in the league at 3.3 offensive boards per game. Her 85 offensive rebounds is 6th in the Cougs' single-season top-10.

YOUTH PREVAILS FOR THE COUGARS

- One of the younger teams in the nation the Cougars sport a roster that features 10 underclassmen including five sophomores and five freshmen while boasting just one senior.
- The Cougs top two scorers come in as underclassmen in sophomore Borislava Hristova (14.7 ppg) and freshman Chanelle Molina (12.8 ppg). However, both suffered injuries that cost them their seasons.
- Sophomore Alexys Swedlund leads the team with 48 three-pointers on the year and is averaging 10.2 ppg.
- Newcomers Kayla Washington, pressed into duty as both a 3 and a 4 in the Cougs' offense, is averaging 5.9 ppg and 4.2 rpg but is averaging 8.0 ppg in her last eight contests since switching to her new role.
- Freshmen Cameron Fernandez and Johanna Muzet have seen their roles increase with the injuries to the Cougs' starting lineup. However, Fernandez is currently out with a concussion.
- Sophomore Maria Kostourkova is second in blocks with 35 total while averaging 22.3 minutes per contest.

NOT SO FAST YOUNG GUNS

- Not to be outdone by the young Cougars who are raring to run, the veteran core continues to be a rock from which the team looks to build.
- Guard Caila Hailey has been the Cougs' top perimeter defender and is second on the team with 1.88 steals per game. She has been one of the top rebounders at 4.3 per game while averaging 2.2 offensive boards a game.
- Guard Pinelopi Pavlopoulou picked up her first career start at Arizona and scored 12 points while dishing out five assists. She has taken over the starting PG role with the injury to Molina and scored in double-figures in five of nine starts.
- Junior big Louise Brown averaged 10.4 ppg while grabbing 6.9 rpg before injury while senior Ivana Kmetovska has found her groove in Pac-12 play and has bumped her scoring average to 8.0 ppg.
- Redshirt-sophomore Nike McClure has seen her minutes grow and increased her production as she is averaging 5.5 rpg while grabbing 3.3 offensive rpg. She also has posted 42 blocks on the year to lead the team. She has scored a career-best 11 points in back-to-back contests.

COUGARS' DEPTH BEING TESTED

- Last season, nine Cougar players appeared in all 30 games during the season, and nine players averaged over 10 minutes per game. WSU's bench players outscored the opponent's bench 24 times last season and the Cougar reserves outscored opponent reserves by an average of 12.1 points per game.
- In 26 games this season, 13 players have seen action with the reserves being forced into more action due to injuries to the starting lineup that
- The injuries have left WSU with 9 healthy players over the last 9 games.
- 11 Cougs are averaging at least 10.8 minutes per game. The bench has scored 632 points on the year and has outscored the opposition in 19 games while playing even in two more.

RPI WATCH

- After a tough two games at home last week, the Cougars find themselves all the way down at #88 in the RPI. The Cougs were hovering just outside of the top-50 thanks to a tough schedule in which WSU has taken on nine ranked opponents (including five top-10 teams) and two more receiving votes.
- The Pac-12 enters the week as the nation's top conference once again with six teams in the top-36 in RPI, and four in the top-12 led by Washington coming in at #6.

COUGS UPSET #7 UCLA

- Behind a freshmen record 33 points from Chanelle Molina, the Washington State women's basketball team pulled off the biggest upset in program history on Friday night, downing No. 7 UCLA, 82-73, at Beasley Coliseum.
- The Cougars win over the Bruins marked their best win over a top-10 opponent in program history, one-upping their 2014, 70-64, victory over No. 8 Maryland in Puerto Rico at the San Juan Shootout.

FRESHMEN RECORD GOES TO MOLINA IN 33 PT OUTBURST VS #7 UCLA

- For Chanelle Molina, the freshman could do little wrong on a night to remember as the first-year Cougar tied the Wazzu freshmen record for scoring with a 33-point effort in the Cougs' upset of #7 UCLA.
- Molina matched Lia Galdeira's freshmen record set against Minnesota in 2012. Additionally, her 33 points on the night tied for the 10th best scoring game in program history as she became just the third freshman ever to reach the 30-point threshold.
- The Hawaiian native needed just 20 shots to do her damage in the game as she efficiently went about her business hitting 13-of-20 from the floor. Molina would have her hand in 20 of the Cougars' 34 field goals as she also tallied a career-best seven assists to go with her scoring binge.
- Her 13 made field goals were the most made in a single game by a freshman while ranking tied for 8th overall all-time.

DEFENSIVE DOMINATION IN A GAME FOR THE AGES AGAINST USF

- On Friday, Nov. 18 the Cougs put together one of the best defensive performances in program history and arguably the best since the inclusion of the three-point arc as WSU held San Francisco to just 35 points in a 73-35 victory.
- The 35 points allowed was the second lowest point total for a WSU opponent in nearly 40 seasons tying a total given up by the 1979 Cougars in a 76-35 win over Alaska-Anchorage and one off the 34 points given up to Idaho State in 2014
- Overall, the Cougs held the Dons to just 24.1% shooting in the game and just 13 field goals. WSU forced 35 turnovers on the night which led to 24 points while also blocking six shots.

COUGARS SIGN TWO STANDOUTS TO NLI

- Washington State signed guard Celena Molina and center Taryn Shelley to National Letters of Intent. Molina, a 5-10 guard out of Konawaena High School in Kailua-Kona, Hawaii, is the younger sister of current Cougar freshman guard Chanelle. Entering her senior season, Molina is a two-time All-State and All-Fab 15 selection by the Honolulu Star Advertiser and a three-time All-Big Island Interscholastic Federation selection while helping KHS to state titles the past two seasons.
- Shelley, a 6-3 center out of Shorewood High School in Shorewood, Wash., is a two-time All-Wesco selection and is rated a 3.5 star prospect according to Prospectnation.com. Shelley is coming off an impressive junior campaign where she earned All-Wesco first team honors after leading the team with 13.8 ppg and 7.6 rpg in league play. Shelley averaged 16.3 ppg and 20 rpg during district play last season including a 32-point effort.

Washington State University Head Coach June Daugherty enters her 10th season with the Cougars, having led the charge toward a new era in WSU women's basketball. Just as she had done at each of her two previous stops, Daugherty, who has coached more than 800 career games, has begun turning around the WSU women's program, leading the Cougars to two consecutive WNIT appearances in 2014 and 2015, bringing in top-ranked recruiting classes, improving attendance numbers and overseeing student-athletes who place premiums on academics and community service.

In her ninth season at the helm of the Cougars, Daugherty guided a youthful team to the school's best start since the 1989-90 season. WSU went 9-2 in nonconference play before entering Pac-12 play and the toughest RPI conference in the country. Under Daugherty's leadership, freshman Borislava Hristova earned All-Pac-12 and Pac-12 All-Freshman Team honors, breaking WSU freshman records in 20-point games, total points, scoring average, field goals made, and free throw percentage. The Cougars finished the season with a 14-16 record and a 5-13 record in Pac-12 play, finishing ninth with season sweeps of Colorado and Arizona. Daugherty also oversaw the defensive success of WSU's frontline, which tallied a school-record 120 total blocks. The Cougars picked up a top-25 win over No. 25 USC with a decisive 73-61 victory.

Off the court, the Cougars continued to shine in the classroom with four Pac-12 All-Academic honorable mentions in 2015-16. WSU earned national recognition as part of the NCAA's Public Recognition Awards for the 2013-14 academic year. WSU earned the honor for the second-straight season with a multi-year Academic Progress Rate (APR) score among the top 10 percent of all squads in the country. WSU posted a perfect four-year average score of 1,000 in 2014-15, and was one of 43 women's basketball teams honored for its accomplishments. WSU, along with Stanford, were the only two Pac-12 Conference schools recognized.

Under Daugherty, Washington State has reached the Pac-12 Conference Tournament semifinals two times, 27 student-athletes earned all-academic honors in the last eight years, and five players signed professional contracts to play overseas in the last four summers including Lia Galdeira who was selected No. 19 overall by the Washington Mystics in the 2016 WNBA Draft, the first player drafted in program history.

During the 2014-15 campaign, Daugherty hit a personal milestone, earning her 400th career win as the Cougars defeated Utah Feb. 15. Daugherty continued to build on the success of the previous season, as WSU earned a second-consecutive postseason berth for the first time in school history. The WSU women's basketball program earned national recognition, recording one of the biggest wins in program history with a 70-64 victory over No. 10/8 Maryland, an eventual No. 1 seed and Final Four participant, in Puerto Rico, November 29.

During the 2013-14 season, Daugherty led the Cougars to one of the best campaigns in program history, earning a trip to the WNIT, the program's first postseason appearance since 1991, and posted 17 wins, the most since 1995-96. WSU also notched four wins over ranked teams, including one on the road against No. 10 Nebraska and went on to post nine conference wins for the first time since 1994-95. Guards Lia Galdeira and Tia Presley both earned spots on the All-Pac-12 Team, becoming the first pair of Cougar teammates to earn all-conference honors in the same season in program history. The Cougars received some national recognition late in the year, receiving votes in the Top-25 USA Today Coaches' Poll following their Pac-12 Tournament run, becoming the first WSU team to be mentioned in a poll since the 1990-91 season.

In 2012-13, Daugherty led a team that featured six freshmen and three

sophomores to the Pac-12 Conference Tournament quarterfinals for the second straight season, beating Arizona State in the opening round before falling to top-seeded Stanford. The Cougars improved three spots in the conference standings from a season ago, finishing eighth. WSU produced some notable wins while playing one of the toughest schedules in the country, beating No. 20 Ohio State, posting a road victory over regional rival Gonzaga and sweeping the season series with Arizona State. The Cougars finished the year with a program record for blocks in a season with 114.

Also under Daugherty's guidance in 2012-13, the Cougars backcourt received recognition from the conference as Lia Galdeira, the second-leading freshman scorer in the country and three-time Pac-12 Freshman of the Week winner, earned a number of All-Pac-12 accolades as a freshman after pacing the Cougars in scoring, rebounding, steals and minutes. Sophomore point guard Tia Presley also earned all-conference honors despite being limited to seven conference games due to injury. Daugherty also saw center Carly Noyes cap off her impressive career by becoming the school's all-time leader in blocked shots, games played and career starts.

The 2011-12 campaign saw Daugherty lead the Cougars to one of the most successful seasons in program history while playing one of the toughest schedules in the country (No. 27). WSU posted the most wins since 1995-96, recording 13 overall victories and the second double-digit win season under Daugherty while improving their final RPI by 50 spots from the season prior. The Cougars saved its best for last, beating UCLA the final weekend of the regular season before posting the program's inaugural wins at the conference tournament. WSU knocked off Oregon State and USC in the first two rounds to advance to the nationally-televised semifinal against California held at the Staples Center in Los Angeles.

Additionally, Daugherty led the Cougs to the program's inaugural win over a Big Ten Conference opponent (Wisconsin) and the first win over a Big East Conference opponent (Marquette) in over 20 years. Daugherty's team followed nonconference play by winning its first three games of Pac-12 play for the first time since 1977-78. The 2011-12 Cougars made their mark on the record book as well, posting the most rebounds, the sixth-most points, fourth-most threes, fifth-most assists and second-most assists in WSU single-season history. 2011-12 also saw Daugherty's first WSU recruiting class cap their impressive careers as a pair of 1,000-point scorers exited along with a three-time academic all-conference selection in addition to the three players who received invites to the WNBA combine. Headlining the group was guard Jazmine Perkins who finished her career as a three-time all-conference selection and WSU's all-time leader in games played and the first player in school-history, male or female, with 1,200+ points, 700+ rebounds and 250+ steals.

2010-11 saw the Cougars take another step forward under Daugherty's guidance while playing the No. 27 toughest schedule in the country. WSU posted the most conference wins, the highest scoring average and highest shooting percentage since 2000-01. The Cougars posted their highest finish since the 1997-98, tying for seventh after posting season sweeps over California and Oregon State and beating Oregon and Oregon State on the same weekend to record their first weekend sweep in conference play since 2001.

Daugherty's players have received quite a bit of postseason attention since her arrival on the Palouse. In her first season guard Katie Appleton garnered her first-career all-conference honor after being named All-Pac-10 honorable mention. Guard Kezia Kelly was named Freshman All-Pac-10 honorable mention. April Cook and Jazmine Perkins took home a slew of honors following the 2008-09 season, earning mention on the All-Pac-10 Team and the

Pac-10 All-Freshman Team. Perkins was also named to the Pac-10 All-Defensive Team. In 2009-10, Cook garnered her second-straight honorable mention all-conference honor, and freshmen Carly Noyes and KiKi Moore combined for a number of accolades. Daugherty continued to produce all-conference selections last season as Perkins and Sage Romberg garnered All-Pac-10 honorable mention honors while Romberg was placed on the Pac-10 All-Freshmen team and Ireti Amojor received All-Pac-10 All-Freshmen honorable mention. It marked the third consecutive season that Daugherty had at least one freshman garner all-conference recognition.

Dating back to her years at Washington, Daugherty has placed at least one individual on the All-Pac-10/12 team each year since 1997. A pair of Cougs received All-Pac-12 accolades in 2011-12 as Perkins received all-Pac-12 honorable mention while both Perkins and Carly Noyes earned all-defensive team honorable mention. In 2012-13, Galdeira and Presley received all-conference honorable mention with Galdeira also earning a spot on the all-defensive and all-freshmen teams. This past season, Galdeira and Presley both earned spots on the All-Pac-12 Team, becoming the first pair of Cougar teammates to earn all-conference honors in the same season in program history.

Daugherty, whose career record stands at 387-360 (.518), has more than 20 years of experience working with WNBA-caliber talent. She began her head coaching career at Boise State, where she coached for seven years (1989-96) and compiled a record of 123-74 (73-31 Big Sky Conference). Under her watch, the Broncos not only made the NCAA Tournament for the first time in school history, but achieved their first national ranking and won their first regular season conference title. In 1992, the Broncos won the Big Sky regular season championship, and in 1994 they shared the conference crown with Montana and earned an at-large bid to the NCAA tournament. At the conclusion of the 1993-94 season, Daugherty was named Big Sky Co-Coach of the Year.

After turning things around at Boise State, Daugherty continued her success at Washington, where she coached for 11 seasons. After finishing ninth in the Pac-10 in 2000, Daugherty led the Huskies to their first conference title since 1990, the greatest turnaround in conference history. She led Washington to nine postseason appearances in 11 seasons - six NCAA Tournament appearances and three WNIT appearances - and led the Huskies all the way to the NCAA Women's Basketball Championship Elite Eight in 2001.

Daugherty helped a number of players earn individual honors at Washington, with Giuliana Mendiola becoming the school's first Pac-10 Player of the Year, and four players earning District VIII All-America honors. Home attendance soared under Daugherty's watch at both Boise State and Washington. The Broncos averaged 500 fans per game before Daugherty's arrival. During her tenure, more than 2,000 fans were coming to watch every game, placing Boise State in the nation's top 30 for home attendance in each of her seven seasons. Washington led the Pac-10 in home attendance in both 2002-03 and 2003-04. The team chemistry formed on the basketball court is a direct result of creating a family atmosphere with Daugherty's staff and players. Daugherty creates a home away from home for her basketball family, consisting of coaches, players and support staff. This environment culminated in 16 players combining for 49 selections to the Pac-10 All-Academic Team at Washington, and 30 student-athletes on the Big Sky Conference All-Academic Team at Boise State. In her six seasons at WSU, ten players have combined for 21 All-Academic selections.

Daugherty's basketball family is involved not only in providing everything necessary to achieve academic excellence, but also the means to becoming involved in community service. Daugherty leads by example, speaking at meetings for the Chamber of Commerce, the Kiwanis and for many women's groups. A major advocate for healthy heart awareness, Daugherty was named the Sudden Cardiac Arrest Association's National Coach of the Year in 2008. Since becoming a survivor of sudden cardiac arrest Daugherty has become one of the nation's most visible spokesmen, filming a nationally-aired commercial, speaking at fund-raisers for the Hope Heart Institute and the American Red Cross and helping WSU sponsor the inaugural "Cougs Have Heart" basketball game to raise awareness for heart disease.

Daugherty is a member of the Women's Basketball Coaches' Association and is a former member of its Board of Directors. She is also a member of both the State Farm Coaches' All-America Team and the Russell Athletic/WBCA Coach of the Year selection committees and is currently serving on the WBCA Ethics Board, the WBCA All-America selection committee for Region 8 and is the captain of the Pac-12 coaches committee. Daugherty often serves as a clinician for the NCAA YES Clinic at the Final Four, and she has been active in USA Basketball and was an assistant coach for the West Team at the 1995 Olympic Sports Festival.

Daugherty also places high priority on keeping the top local high school talent at home in the Northwest. In her first season with the Cougars, Washington's 3A State Player of the Year Katie Grad (Auburn-Riverside) and Shadle

Park's all-time leading scorer Lexie Pettersen (Spokane) were each a part of her nationally-ranked recruiting class. Her second recruiting class featured Carly Noyes of Moses Lake, Wash., a three-time conference player of the year at Moses Lake HS. Her 2010 class, two-time Evergreen Conference Most Valuable Player and 2009-10 Seattle Times All-State (all-classifications) honoree Brandi Thomas, of Elma, Wash., went Crimson. This season, Daugherty welcomes Wyoming's two-time Gatorade Player of the Year in Jordan Kelley (Gillette, Wyo.), one of the top-rated low post players out of Canada in 6-3 Shalie Dheensaw (Victoria, B.C.) who has started for the Canadian U17 National Team and speedy three-time all-state selection out of Spokane's Gonzaga Prep Tia Presley (Spokane, Wash.). The 2012 recruiting class featured six players from all over the country including Lia Galderia who was named Hawaii Player of the Year three times.

Several of Daugherty's athletes have gone on to coaching careers at both the high school and collegiate level, including Lisa Fisher, an associate head coach with the Cougars in 2006.

Daugherty served as an assistant coach at Stanford under head coach Tara Vanderveer prior to taking over the Boise State program. She helped guide the Cardinal to one of the finest seasons in school history, finishing the 1989 season with a record of 28-3, an undefeated Pac-10 season and a trip to the NCAA Tournament. Daugherty also had a two-year stint on the Kent State staff as an assistant coach from 1983-85.

Daugherty played collegiate basketball at Ohio State from 1974-78, where she led the Buckeyes to the Big Ten Championship in 1977 and 1978. She is still ranked amongst the school's top 25 in career scoring with 1,137 points. She also ranks fifth in career rebounds (829), is tied for 17th in career field goals made (500) and shares the single-game school record for blocked shots (12 against Michigan State in 1976). At the conclusion of her senior season, she earned first-team All-America honors and was a Wade Trophy finalist the first year the award was presented.

Just prior to the start of the 2001 season, The Ohio State University honored Daugherty with an induction into the OSU Athletic Hall of Fame. Daugherty will be inducted into the Westerville High School in December, 2011.

Following graduation in 1978, Daugherty contributed as both a player and coach on several international teams, including a period as a player and coach for the Union Sportive Vierzon Club based in France.

Daugherty, a native of Columbus, Ohio, is the daughter of Naomi and Jim Brewer and has two brothers, Mark and Neil Brewer, and one sister, Ruth Williams. She and her husband Mike are the parents of twins Doc and Breanne.
