**NOTICE OF INTENT TO SEEK THE DEATH PENALTY AND OF AGGRAVATING
FACTORS PURSUANT TO SECTION 782.04(1)(b), FLORIDA STATUTES, AND RULE
3.181, FLORIDA RULES OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE**

Pursuant to Section 782.04(1)(b), Florida Statutes, and Rule 3.181 of the Florida Rules of Criminal Procedure, the State gives notice of its intent to seek the death penalty and sets forth the following aggravating factors it intends to prove and has reason to believe it can prove beyond a reasonable doubt:

AS TO COUNTS COUNTS 1, 2, AND 3:

Section 921.141(6), Florida Statutes:

(b) The defendant was previously convicted of another capital felony or of a felony involving the use or threat of violence to the person.

(i) The capital felony was a homicide and was committed in a cold, calculated, and premeditated manner without any pretense of moral or legal justification.
