
ORDER TO VACATE CAPIAS



PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT:

Before Me, the undersigned authority personally appeared DAMON BAXLEY ID 4481 w being duly sworn, alleges, on information and belief, that on the 04 day of DECEMBER, 20 18, in MARION COUNTY, FLORIDA the defendant did:

ON 11/27/18, DEPUTY CALVIN BATTS OF THE MARION COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE (MCSO) INITIATED AN INVESTIGATION IN REFERENCE TO MISSING ADULT, LISA M. JEFFREY (W/F DOB 11/5/70); ACCORDING TO LISA'S AUNT, WINIFRED ANN BURK (W/F DOB 2/23/64), LISA HAD BEEN MISSING FOR SEVERAL WEEKS. ACCORDING TO THE STATEMENT OF MS. BURK, LISA LIVED AT THE INCIDENT LOCATION (4001 W. SILVER SPRINGS BLVD, LOT 808, OCALA, MARION COUNTY, FLORIDA) WITH HER HUSBAND, BO PETE JEFFREY (W/M DOB 10/30/1963).

DEPUTY BATTS FOLLOWING UP ON THIS INFORMATION, FOUND PRIOR CALLS-FOR-SERVICE INVOLVING LISA'S DAUGHTER JAMIE CURL, WHO HAD ALSO CALLED MCSO, ATTEMPTING TO REPORT LISA MISSING. DEPUTY BATTS MADE PHONE CONTACT WITH MS. CURL, WHO ADVISED THAT SHE HAD NOT SEEN HER MOTHER SINCE NOVEMBER 5TH, 2018. MS. CURL ALSO ADVISED THAT SHE HAD MADE PLANS TO FLY HER MOTHER TO OKLAHOMA TO VISIT FOR A WEEK, AND TELEPHONED HER MOTHER'S HUSBAND BO JEFFREY TO CHECK IF SHE HAD RECEIVED THE PLANE TICKETS. AT THAT TIME, BO INFORMED MS. BURK THAT HE HAD NOT SEEN LISA SINCE NOVEMBER 6TH, 2018, AND DID NOT SEEM CONCERNED.

DEPUTY BATTS THEN CALLED BO JEFFREY WHO ADVISED THAT HE HAD BEEN MARRIED TO LISA FOR APPROXIMATELY 5 YEARS, AND DISCLOSED THAT SHE HAD A DRUG PROBLEM AND HAD POTENTIALLY STOLEN \$700.00 FROM HIS TRUCK, WHICH HAD BEEN PARKED AT THE INCIDENT LOCATION, AND ALLEGED THAT THERE WERE TWO MISSING DVD PLAYERS, ALONG WITH SOME PERSONAL ITEMS THAT BELONGED TO LISA INCLUDING HER MEDICATIONS. DEPUTY BATTS ADVISED THAT WHILE SPEAKING WITH BO JEFFREY, HE WOULD ANSWER QUESTIONS IN A ROUND-ABOUT FASHION, AND HE APPEARED TO AVOID ANSWERING QUESTIONS.


ON 12/03/2018, A SEARCH WARRANT WAS OBTAINED AND CARRIED OUT ON BO AND LISA'S TRAVEL CAMPER LOCATED AT. LISA'S DECEASED, DECOMPOSING, BODY WAS LOCATED WRAPPED IN PLASTIC, UNDERNEATH A BED INSIDE THE CAMPER. IT APPEARED THAT SHE HAD SEVERE BLUNT FORCE TRAUMA TO HER FACE AREA. THERE WAS BLOOD SPATTER THROUGHOUT THE INTERIOR OF THE CAMPER, SUPPORTING THE POSSIBILITY LISA WAS BATTERED TO DEATH INSIDE THE CAMPER; CONCEALED UNDER THE BED BESIDE LISA'S BODY, THERE WAS A PAIR OF BLOODY BOXING GLOVES.


DETECTIVE A. LEVY ATTENDED THE AUTOPSY AND WAS INFORMED THE VICTIM HAD BLUNT FORCE TRAUMA/HEMORRHAGING THROUGHOUT HER ENTIRE BODY. THERE WAS BRUISING ON THE VICTIM'S HANDS, ARMS, LEGS AND FEET WHICH COULD BE INDICATIVE OF DEFENSIVE INJURIES. HEMORRHAGING WAS PRESENT ON THE VICTIM'S NECK, SIDES, BACK, AND BUTTOCKS. IN ADDITION TO THE HEMORRHAGING, THE VICTIM HAD MULTIPLE BROKEN RIBS ON HER RIGHT SIDE, A LACERATION ON THE BACK OF HER HEAD, AND TEARS TO HER RIGHT EAR.

ON 12/04/2018, DETECTIVE J. LIGHTLE MADE CONTACT WITH BO AT A LOCATION IN PUTNAM COUNTY, FLORIDA. DURING A POST-MIRANDA INTERVIEW, BO ULTIMATELY ADMITTED TO THE FOLLOWING. ON THE EVENING OF LISA'S BIRTHDAY, 11/05/2018, BO ADVISED HE AND LISA BECAME ENGAGED IN A PHYSICAL ALTERCATION AT THE INCIDENT LOCATION, DURING WHICH BO ADVISED HE STRUCK LISA THREE OR FOUR TIMES WITH CLOSED FISTS, IN HER FACE. AFTER THE ALTERCATION ENDED, BO ADVISED HE AND LISA WENT TO BED. BO FURTHER ALLEGED THAT WHEN HE AWOKE THE NEXT MORNING, 11/06/2018, HE FOUND LISA IN THE BATHROOM OF THEIR CAMPER, DECEASED. BO INDICATED HE FELT RESPONSIBLE FOR LISA'S DEATH, SO HE WENT TO A LOCAL STORE, PURCHASED GARBAGE BAGS, USED THE GARBAGE BAGS TO WRAP LISA'S BODY, AND CONCEALED HER BODY UNDERNEATH A BED INSIDE THEIR CAMPER.

BO AND LISA WERE MARRIED FOR FIVE YEARS AND WERE DIVORCED IN OCTOBER OF 2018; HOWEVER, THEY CONTINUED TO LIVE TOGETHER AS FAMILY UNTIL THE TIME OF LISA'S MURDER.
