**DEFENDANT DONNA ADELSON'S UNOPPOSED  
MOTION TO MODIFY TRIAL DATE**

Defendant Donna Adelson, by and through undersigned counsel, respectfully moves this Court for an order moving the trial and pretrial hearing dates up by a couple of weeks, from September 30, 2024 to September 16, 2024. In support of this motion, Mrs. Adelson states as follows:

1. On February 16, 2024, this Court entered an Order Setting Court Proceeding Dates and Procedures, which calls for jury selection and trial to commence on September 30, 2024, with the pretrial hearing occurring on September 12, 2024.

2. This year, the Jewish holidays of Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur – which undersigned counsel observes – fall on October 2-3 and October 11-12, respectively.

3. As a result, Mrs. Adelson respectfully requests that the Court modify the trial date so that it commences two weeks earlier, with the pretrial hearing date adjusted accordingly.

4. However, to the extent the Court's calendar does not permit this adjustment in schedule, undersigned counsel does not want to continue the trial date, and Mrs. Adelson respectfully requests that the September 30, 2024 trial date remain in effect.

5. Undersigned counsel has conferred with counsel for the State, which does not oppose Mrs. Adelson's request.

WHEREFORE, Defendant Donna Adelson hereby respectfully moves the Court for an order moving the trial date from September 30, 2024 to September 16, 2024.
