

Outstanding Ethnic Minority Student Award Scheme 2023 Nomination Guideline

Background

Ethnic minority/ Non-Chinese speaking students may encounter more learning challenges compared to their Chinese counterparts due to cultural differences, language barrier and life adaption in Hong Kong. While students are striving to make progress in various aspects, there seems to have limited recognitions towards their efforts paid. In view of that, LINK Centre is going to organize the Outstanding Ethnic Minority Student Award Scheme 2023 (Award Scheme), to appreciate and celebrate the distinctive achievements of Hong Kong's outstanding ethnic minority students. 10 primary school students and 10 secondary school students achieving outstanding performances in various aspects will be selected for this Award. These bright students will be role models to bring inspirations and encouragements towards other ethnic minorities.

Objectives

- To recognize outstanding ethnic minority students who have distinctive achievements.
- To enhance ethnic minorities' motivation in school learning and social integration.
- To promote a positive attitude towards overcoming challenges among ethnic minorities in Hong Kong.

Eligibility

The scheme is only open for school nominations. All ethnic minorities (non-Chinese residents) who are studying in primary / secondary school, and have the right of abode in Hong Kong can be nominated for this Award by school principal or teachers.

- Top 10 Outstanding Secondary School Students (10 students from S1-S6) will receive a trophy, a certificate and a gift.
- All students being nominated by the school will receive a Merit Certificate.

Panel of Judges

LINK Centre will invite academic professionals and representatives from the community as judges for this Award Scheme. The judges will conduct assessment and select the winners according to the assessment criteria being mentioned.

Principal or teachers from primary schools and secondary schools can nominate students for this Award. There is **no** quota limit on the school nominations.
