‘...and forgive us our sins, as we forgive those who sin against us.’

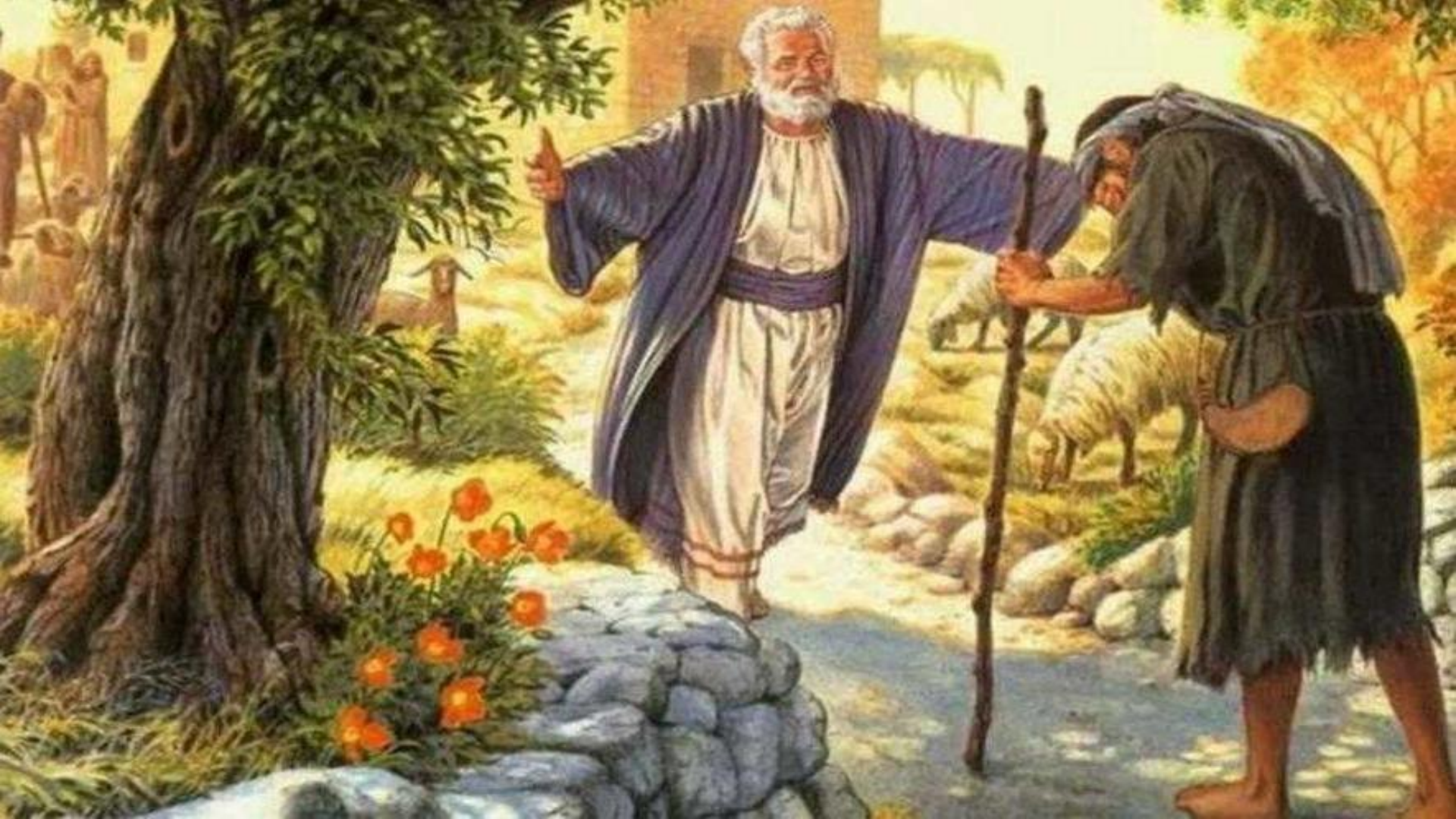


‘...help us to forgive others in order for us to be forgiven too.’
