

## Jesus Calls Levi and Eats With Sinners

<sup>13</sup> Once again Jesus went out beside the lake. A large crowd came to him, and he began to teach them. <sup>14</sup> As he walked along, he saw Levi son of Alphaeus sitting at the tax collector's booth. "Follow me," Jesus told him, and Levi got up and followed him.


# The Meaning of Names

- **Jesus** (Joshua) means: Saviour
- **Capernaum** means: The field of Repentance, City of Comfort  
*Known as the "City of Jesus". (Nahum means: comforter)*
- **Levi** means: Joined or Attached
- **Matthew** means: Gift of the LORD
- **Alpheus** means: He who follows
- **Pharisee** means: Separate or Detach


