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### ***JOB PROFILE***

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#### **Main purpose of the job**

We are seeking a bright, approachable, practical and business-friendly environmentalist to join a growing team of technical sustainability experts working with retailers, restaurants and other companies to develop and implement net zero and wider sustainability strategies. The range of projects includes the development of sustainable product offers; calculating corporate carbon footprints; setting science-based reduction targets; and developing bespoke sustainability strategies.

#### **Scope of job**

The candidate will be part of the delivery team and will work mainly on projects within our Sustainable Business team, working with major brands to develop and implement their net zero and sustainability strategies. A significant part of the role will be handling detailed performance data, and providing analysis and guidance on how to do better.

The wide range of tasks include:

- Calculating carbon footprints: checking primary company data to calculate emissions; developing methodologies for estimating emissions with little or no primary data available; analysing emission 'hotspots'.

- Science-based targets and net-zero strategies: researching carbon reduction solutions; modelling of company emissions to set science-based carbon reduction targets and make projections.
- Sustainability reporting: helping to develop and define KPIs and supporting guidance text on data collection, verification of data, and working with external auditors; analysing sustainability performance and reporting data; supporting with development of external reports.
- Supporting the development and implementation of sustainability action plans, environmental impact reduction strategies and business model innovation.
- Organising and administering meetings of key project stakeholders.

We are looking for someone who is flexible and will enjoy supporting a variety of work requirements. The role may involve occasional UK-based travel.

You will work across our project delivery team and be line-managed by one of our project managers. You will be highly numerate, analytical and organised, able to work with minimal supervision and comfortable managing stakeholder relationships within specific areas of project delivery.
