## The Day of Jesus Christ

Wednesday Online Bible Study 4/29/20

#### **Introduction:**

- We will further study the meaning of "the day of Jesus Christ" in Philippians 1:6.
- Philippians 1:6-6 And I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at **the day** of Jesus Christ.
- Two other verses in Philippians have the similar phrase "day of Christ."
  - O Philippians 1:9-10 <sup>9</sup> And it is my prayer that your love may abound more and more, with knowledge and all discernment, <sup>10</sup> so that you may approve what is excellent, and so be pure and blameless for **the day** of Christ.
  - O Philippians 2:14-16 <sup>14</sup> Do all things without grumbling or disputing, <sup>15</sup> that you may be blameless and innocent, children of God without blemish in the midst of a crooked and twisted generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world, <sup>16</sup> holding fast to the word of life, so that in **the day** of Christ I may be proud that I did not run in vain or labor in vain.

# The Day:

- 1 Corinthians 3:12-13 <sup>12</sup> Now if anyone builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw— <sup>13</sup> each one's work will become manifest, for the Day will disclose it, because it will be revealed by fire, and the fire will test what sort of work each one has done.
- 1 Corinthians 5:5-5 you are to deliver this man to Satan for the destruction of the flesh, so that his spirit may be saved in **the day** of the Lord.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:2,3,9 2 For you yourselves are fully aware that **the day** of the Lord will come like a thief in the night. 3 While people are saying, "There is peace and security," then sudden destruction will come upon them as labor pains come upon a pregnant woman, and they will not escape... 9 For God has not destined us for wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ.
- Hebrews  $10:24-25 {}^{24}$  And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works,  ${}^{25}$  not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see **the Day** drawing near.
- 1 Peter  $2:12 {}^{12}$  Keep your conduct among the Gentiles honorable, so that when they speak against you as evildoers, they may see your good deeds and glorify God on **the day** of visitation.
- 2 Peter  $3.7 {}^{7}$  But by the same word the heavens and earth that now exist are stored up for fire, being kept until **the day** of judgment and destruction of the ungodly.
- 2 Peter 3:10-13 <sup>10</sup> But **the day** of the Lord will come like a thief, and then the heavens will pass away with a roar, and the heavenly bodies will be burned up and dissolved, and the earth and the works that are done on it will be exposed. <sup>11</sup> Since all these things are thus to be dissolved, what sort of people ought you to be in lives of holiness and godliness, <sup>12</sup> waiting for and hastening the coming of **the day** of God, because of which

the heavens will be set on fire and dissolved, and the heavenly bodies will melt as they burn! <sup>13</sup> But according to his promise we are waiting for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells.

# That Day:

- Romans  $2:16 {}^{16}$  on **that day** when, according to my gospel, God judges the secrets of men by Christ Jesus.
- 2 Thessalonians 1:9-10 <sup>9</sup> They will suffer the punishment of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of his might, <sup>10</sup> when he comes on **that day** to be glorified in his saints, and to be marveled at among all who have believed, because our testimony to you was believed.
- 2 Thessalonians 2:1-3 Now concerning the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our being gathered together to him, we ask you, brothers, <sup>2</sup> not to be quickly shaken in mind or alarmed, either by a spirit or a spoken word, or a letter seeming to be from us, to the effect that **the day** of the Lord has come. <sup>3</sup> Let no one deceive you in any way. For **that day** will not come, unless the rebellion comes first, and the man of lawlessness is revealed, the son of destruction.
- 2 Timothy 4:8-8 Henceforth there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, will award to me on **that day**, and not only to me but also to all who have loved his appearing.

# **Last Day:**

- John  $6:40 {}^{40}$  For this is the will of my Father, that everyone who looks on the Son and believes in him should have eternal life, and I will raise him up on the **last day**."
- John 12:47-48 <sup>47</sup> If anyone hears my words and does not keep them, I do not judge him; for I did not come to judge the world but to save the world. <sup>48</sup> The one who rejects me and does not receive my words has a judge; the word that I have spoken will judge him on the **last day**.

### Hour:

• John  $5:28-29 - {}^{28}$  Do not marvel at this, for **an hour** is coming when all who are in the tombs will hear his voice  ${}^{29}$  and come out, those who have done good to the resurrection of life, and those who have done evil to the resurrection of judgment.

#### **Conclusion:**

- The day of Jesus Christ will be a day of judgment for all humanity. *1 Corinthians 3:12-13; Romans 2:16*
- The day of Jesus Christ will be a day of judgement of the ungodly. John 12:47-48; 1 Thessalonians 5:2-3; 2 Thessalonians 1:9; 2 Peter 3:7
- The day of Jesus Christ will be a day of vindication and salvation of the godly.

  1 Corinthians 5:5; 1 Thessalonians 5:9; 2 Thessalonians 2:1-3; Hebrews 10:24-25; 1

  Peter 2:12
- The day of Jesus Christ will be a day of rewards for the godly.

Philippians 1:9-10; 2 Timothy 4:8

- The day of Jesus Christ will be a day when believers will marvel.
  - 2 Thessalonians 1:10
- The day of Jesus Christ will be a day of resurrection of all bodies, some to the new earth, and some to judgment.

John 5:28-29; John 6:40

- The day of Jesus Christ will be a day of destruction of the old earth and the establishment of the new earth.
  - 2 Peter 3:10-13
- The day of Jesus Christ will be a day of ultimate and final sanctification. *Philippians 1:6; Philippians 2:14-16*
