I wonder as I wander, out under the sky, how Jesus the Savior did come for to die, for poor ordinary people like you and like I...



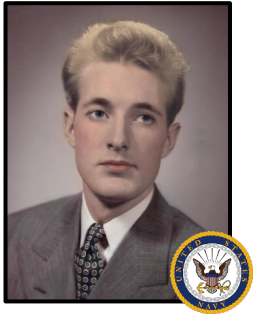
