He showed me what a real hero is...

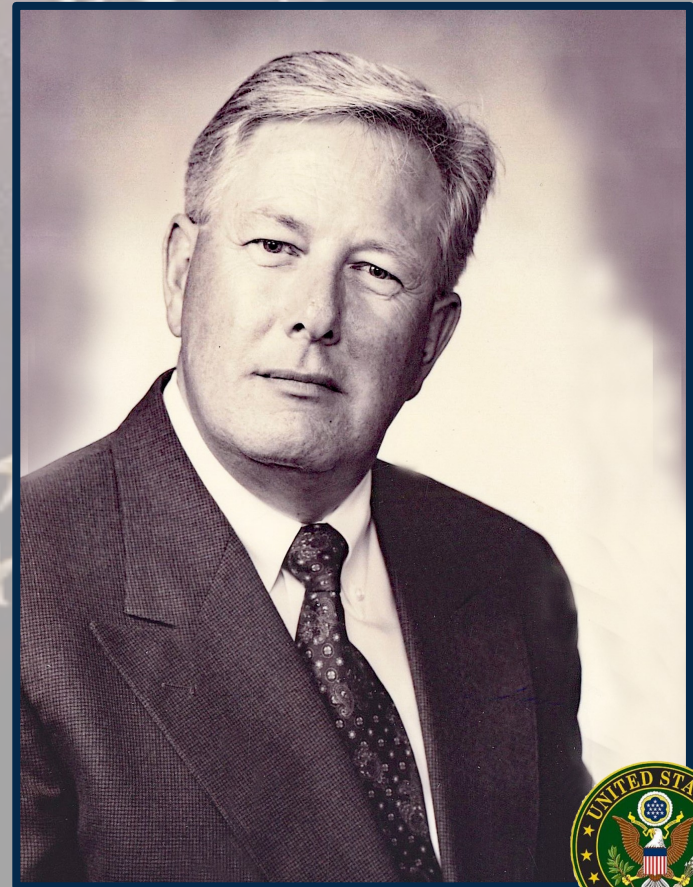
A Hero is someone that forgives the unforgivable.
