and nothing seems the same.

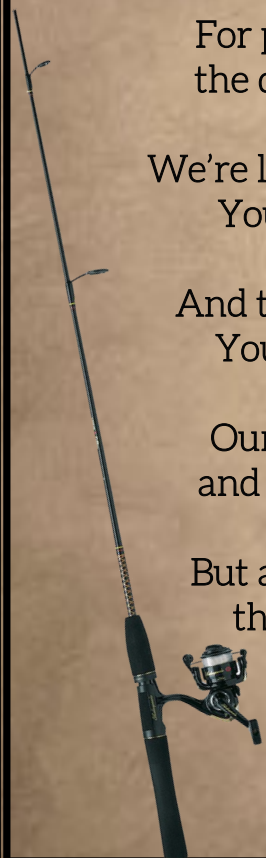
But as God calls us one by one
