

Mabel Rice's Fruitcake
As made by Denece Rice Anderson

- 2- 16 oz cans pitted dark cherries
- 1- 16 oz can pineapple tidbits
- 1- 16 oz pkg raisins
- 1 cup unsweetened applesauce
- 3 cups fruit juice (use juice from cherries and pineapple, plus unsweetened juice to make 3 cups)

1-1/2 cups sugar

Mix above ingredients in a large heavy saucepan. Bring to a boil and boil rapidly for 10 minutes. Remove from the heat and add:

1/2 pound butter

Let cool until just warm and add:

3 tsp baking soda

1 tsp cinnamon

1 tsp nutmeg

1/2 tsp ground cloves

1 tsp vanilla

Mix thoroughly, then add:

2 mashed ripe bananas

1-1/2 cups chopped walnuts

Then add:

4 cups flour

...a little at a time until dough is stiff.

Divide the dough into 3 loaf pans and bake at 350 degrees for 1 hour.

These cakes will keep for months in the freezer and quite a long time in the refrigerator. They can be soaked in wine or brandy. Do not leave out of the refrigerator over three days. Cakes will spoil if left in a warm environment very long.
