

Perhaps Love

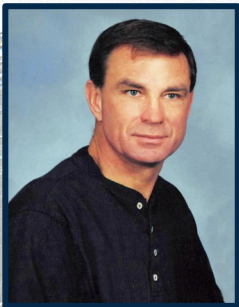
