*I wish that his hands had been placed on my head,*

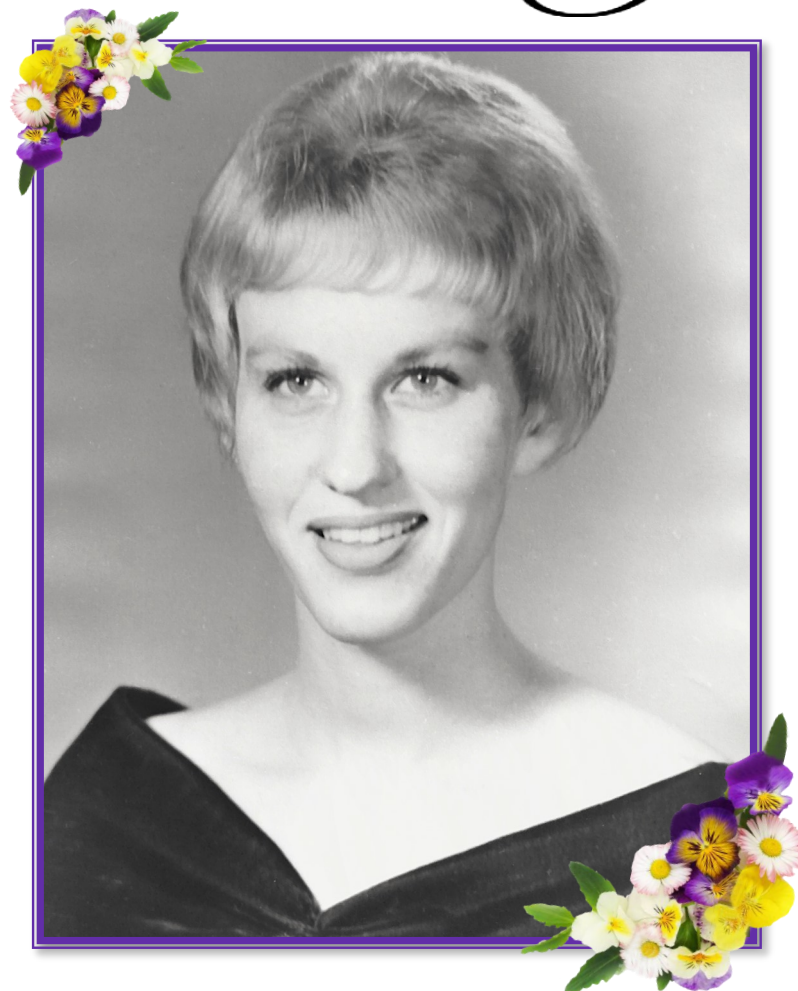
