Cards that make it possible to live beyond your means.

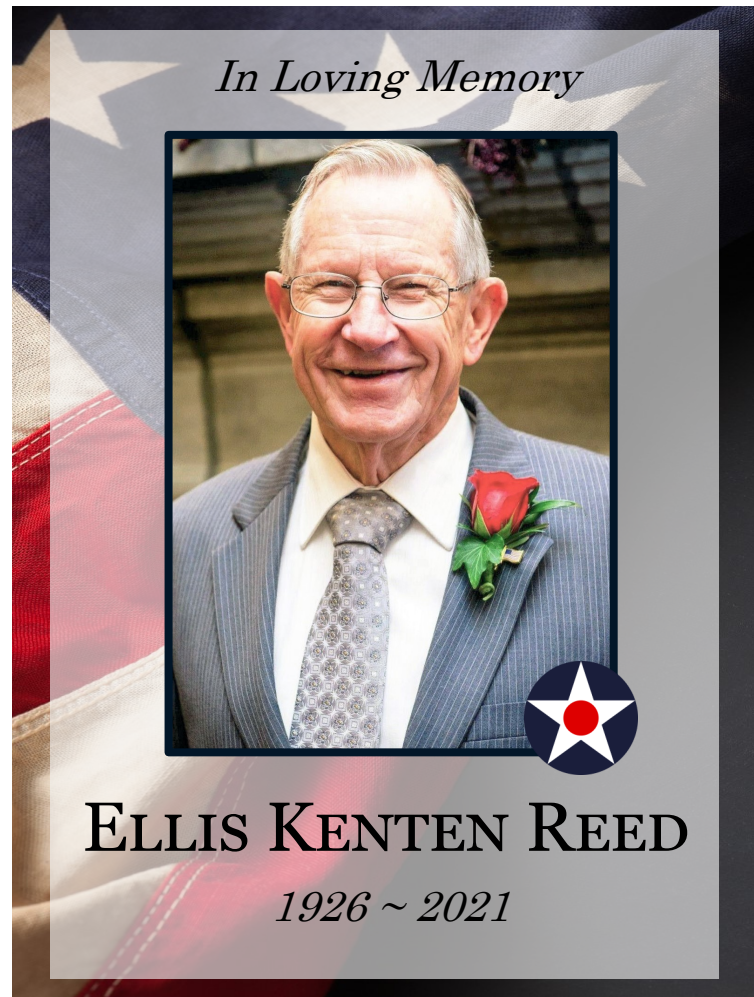
What's the most important card you're ever going to hold?
