


In Loving Memory

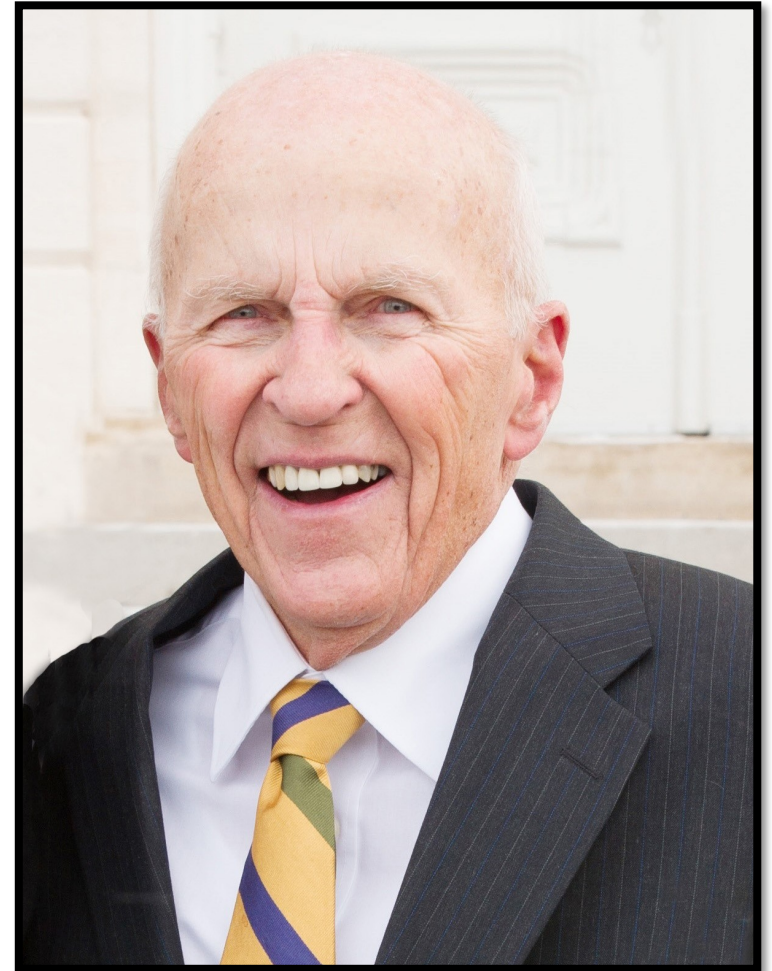
