That I'd lost somewhere, somehow along the way.

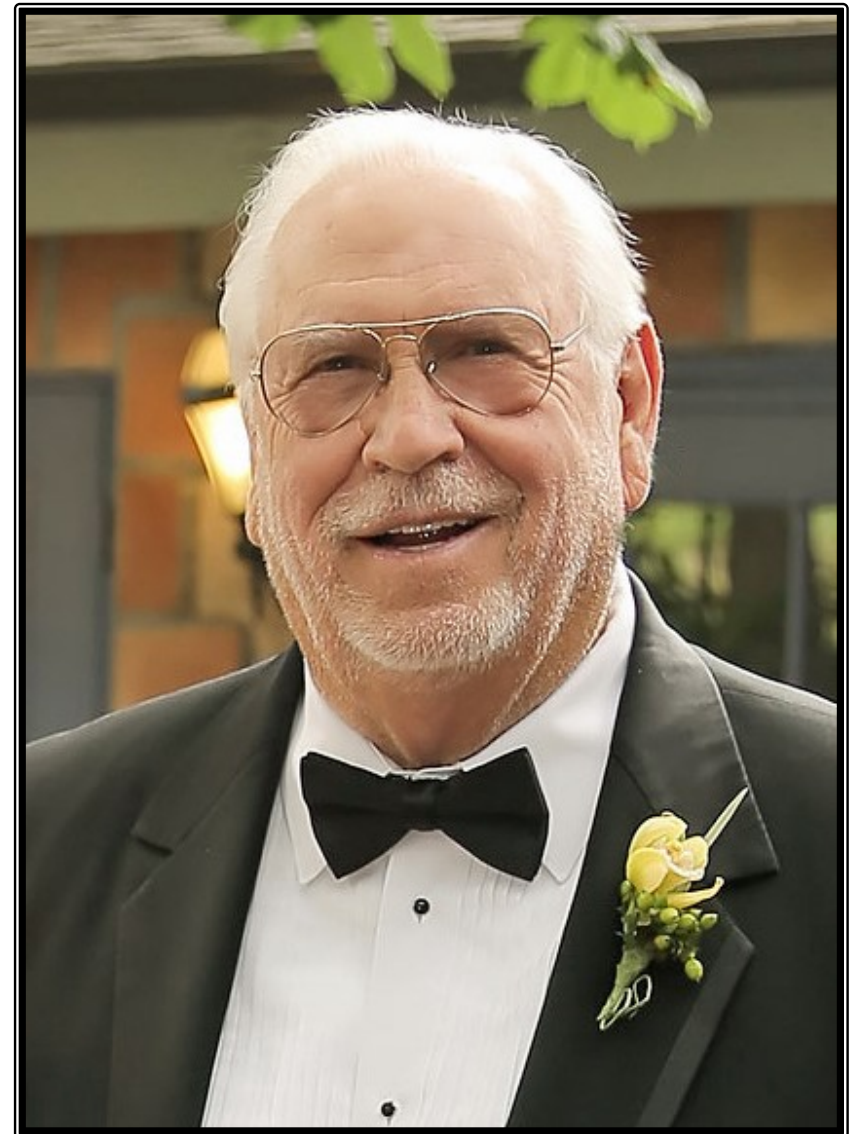

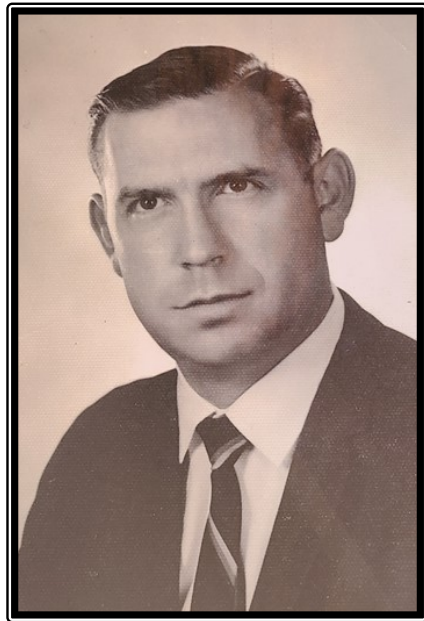
