Oh, my Pa-pa, he always understood

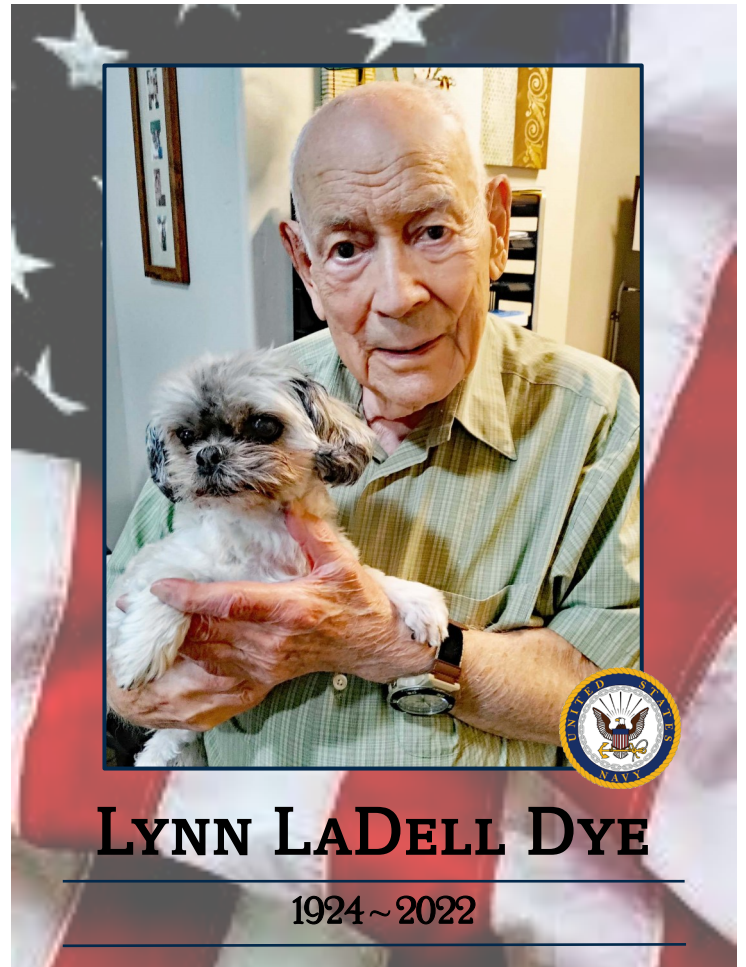
