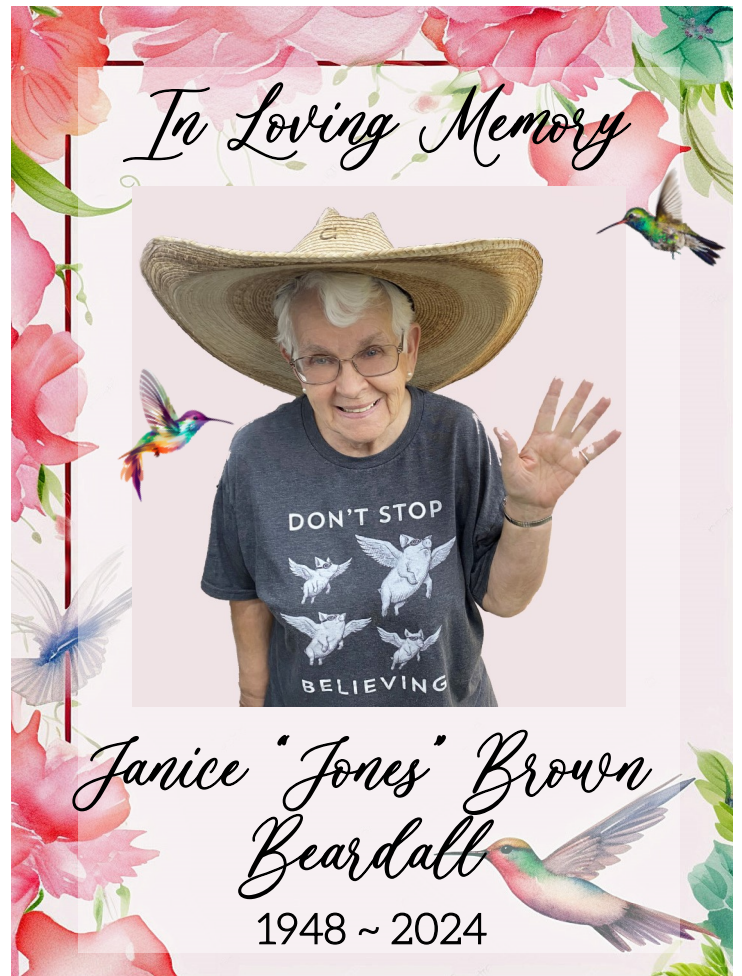


How could this day be upon us so soon
