

Broken Chain

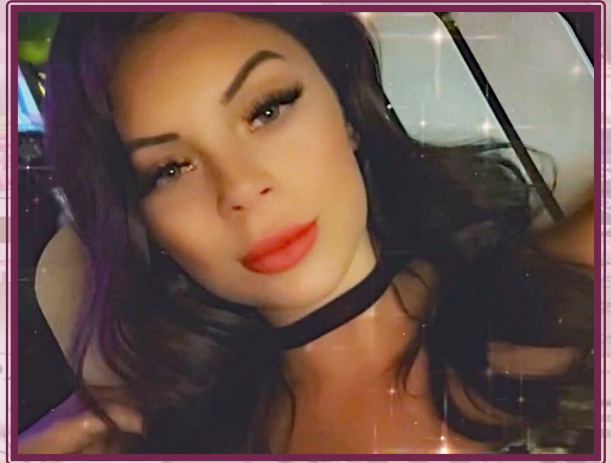
We little knew that morning
