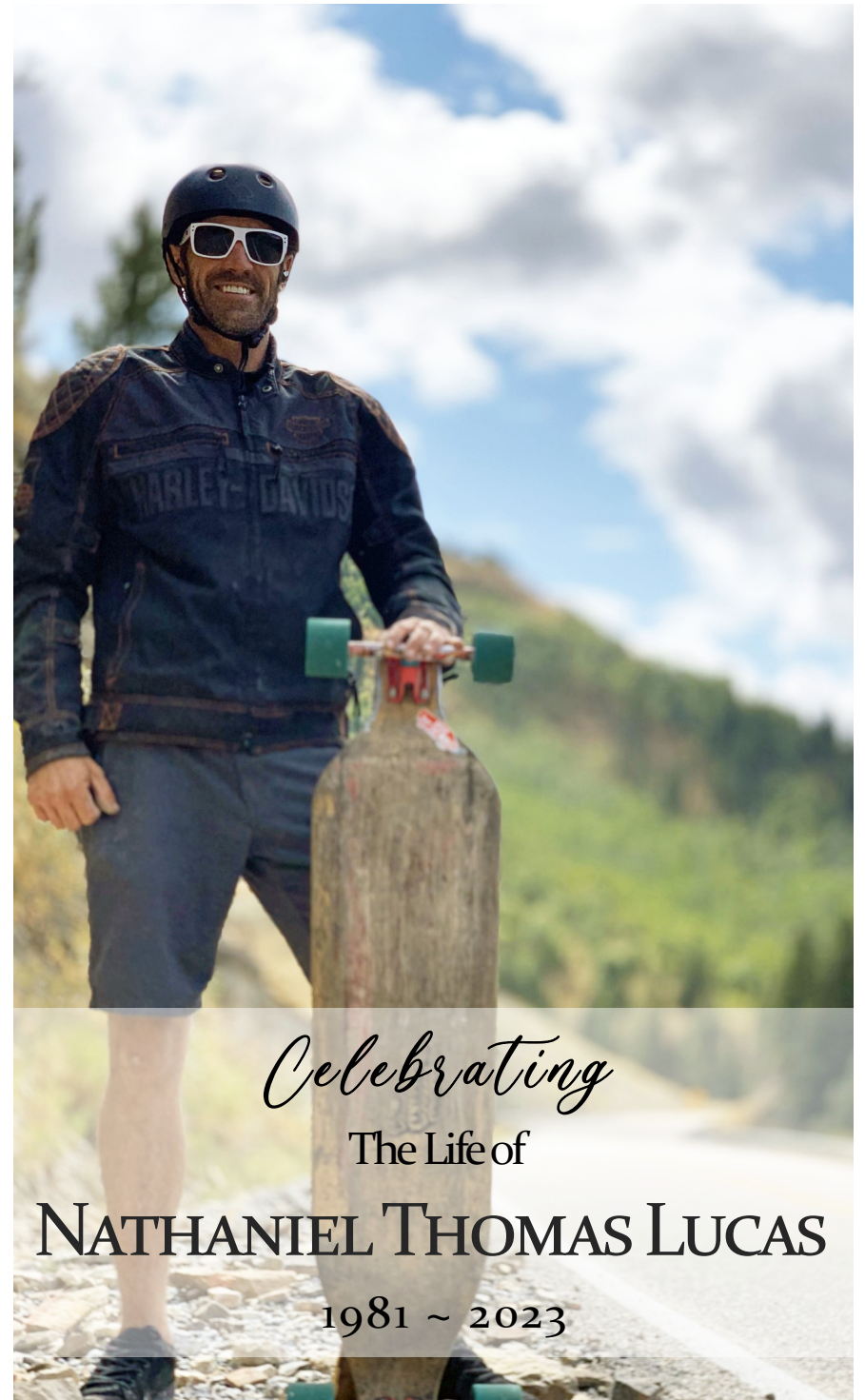




The nautical star symbolizes protection,
